## NATIONAL GRANGE

Originally known as the National Grange of Husbandry, the organization was founded at Washington in 1867 by Oliver Hudson Kelley of Itasca, Minnesota, and six associates. Although it was fraternal and educational in purpose, it quickly became active in an effort to improve the economic lot of the farm population.

Officials of the National Grange had their own idea of what their commemorative stamp should look like. They gave the Post Office Department two sketches by Brooke Todd featuring the organizations sheaf of wheat emblem with a large field in the background and other farm buildings in the rear.



The stamp advisory committee indicated that they avoid emblems as much as possible, since they seldom make good stamps and stated they prefer to find a more general or symbolic theme for the subject.



The scene below was volunteered by Richard Clark, designer of the 6¢ Franklin D. Roosevelt regular issue stamp. His design was that of a modern tractor in an upper panel with large lettering filling the lower half of the horizontal stamp. The committee did not show any particular interest in this design.

A horizontal effort with an American flag and sheaf of wheat submitted in two separate versions, one being more practical from a printing standpoint. Both designs were similar in content.



The POD had enough trouble with flag designs even when unfurled and flying in the breeze and was unlikely to accept any design with anything lying on or in front of a flag.



A 19th century plowing scene fell considerably short of the mark, but it did have an intriguing background like a worn paper scroll which eventually appeared in the final design of this issue.



Two other designs, one vertical and the other horizontal were based on an old print of an outdoor Grange meeting in the 1870's or 1880's.



All key elements the designers were looking for were found in a steel engraving appearing in "A Handbook of Early Ads"

A scroll which appears as a worn poster.  
The farmer in the field cleaning his scythe.  
The large Playbill lettering from the Grange sketches.  
The grist mill and corn stalk in the background.



Based on these features the final design was drawn and approved.
