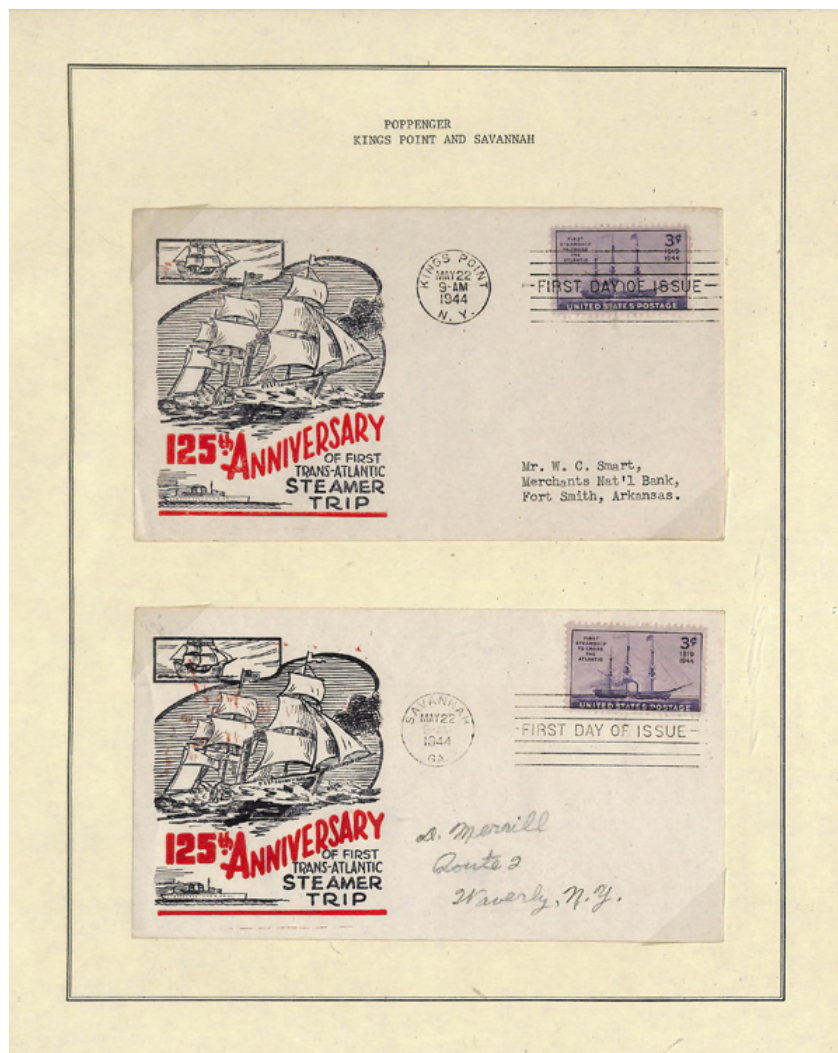

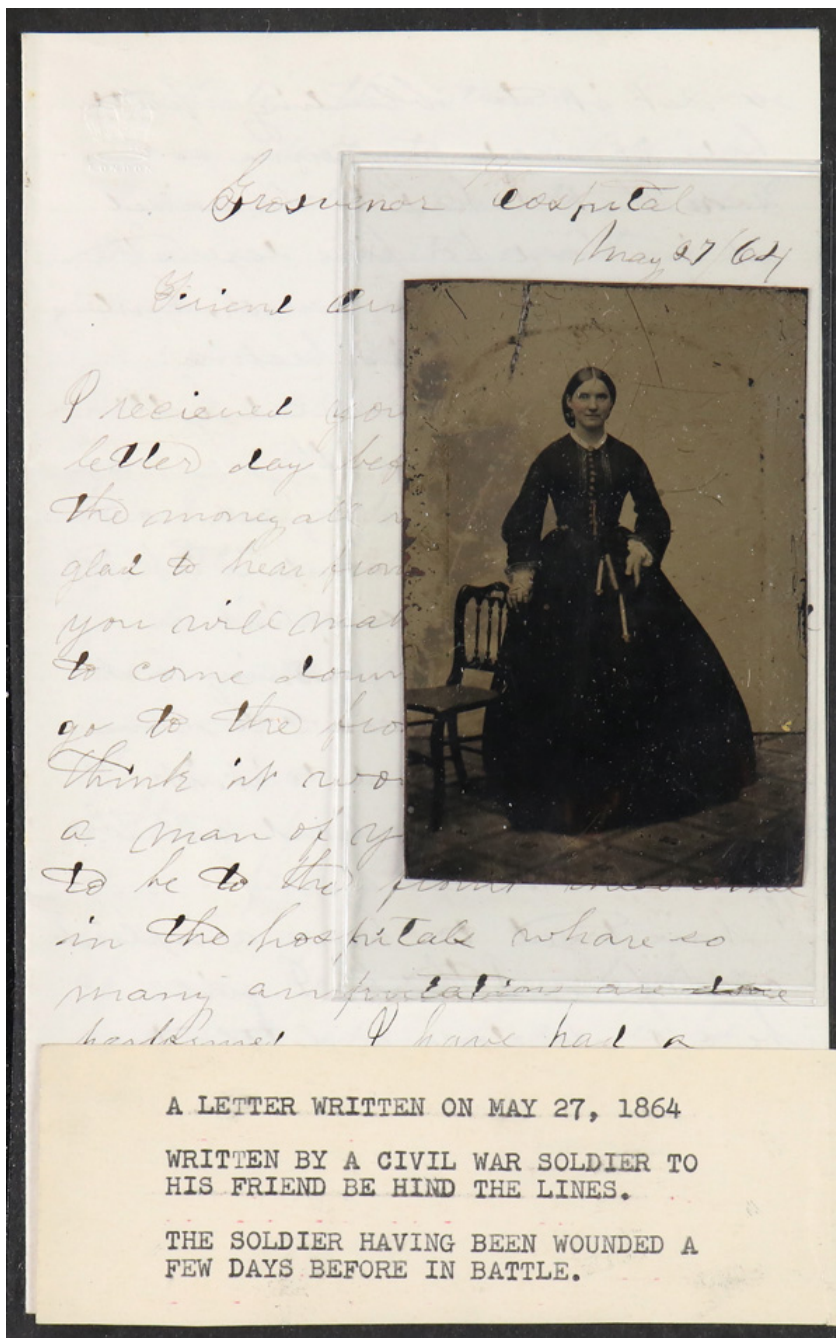

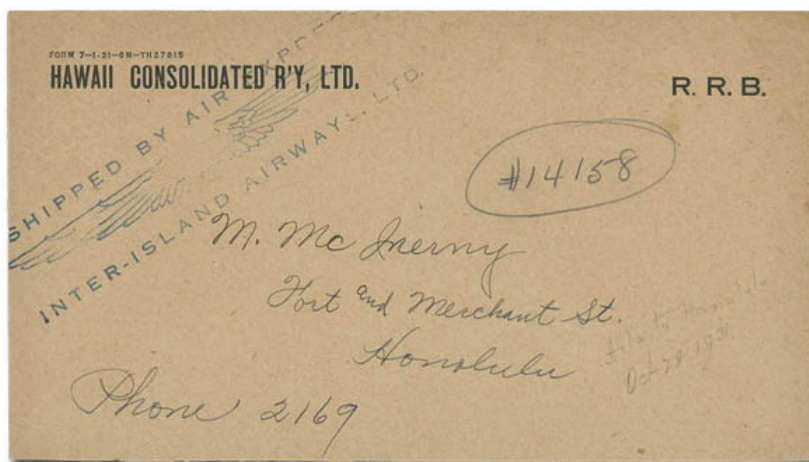

Type 1 is found on two covers: 1931 (Aug 11), Hilo to a haberdasher in Honolulu and 1931 (Oct 28), Hilo to Honolulu, docketed in pencil on a Railway Business envelope. A faint strike of Type two is found on a 1932 (Apr 2) Hilo to Honolulu cover tying 4¢ & 8¢ Washington Bicent., a bit tatty; another faint strike (date uncertain) on a Honolulu to Hilo cover with an additional straight-line "via Air Express" in purple, trimmed on left not affecting markings, and a perfect strike of Type 2 dated Mar 17, 1933, Hilo to Honolulu (probably philatelic). Also included, FF cover for AM Route 33 (revised) and lovely Inter-Island Airways baggage label. An extraordinary group of very rare covers, Very Fine.

(First Postal Reform)

By decree of the 27th October 1852, the Ministry of Commerce embarked upon a complete reform of the postal service, which contemplated the institution of 219 post offices, subdivided, according to their importance, into principal offices, directions and delegations or stations. The reform, which was effected some months later, coincided with the first issue of postage stamps, those of Donna Maria II. The individual offices were distinguished by a number, and it was these numbered chops that from the first served for the cancellation of Portuguese stamps.

The type of obliteration first adopted, which was of steel or iron, took the form of a circle of thin bars, with the number shown in the middle. At either side of the figure are seven or eight bars (Fig. 1). This type served only a short time, that is to say until 1856, perhaps because, owing to the narrowness of the bars, a clear mark, which did not spoil the stamp, seldom resulted.

With the 25 reis rose of Don Pedro V (1857 issue) appeared a new obliteration, with bars a little broader, and with three only at either side of the number (Fig. 2). Exceptionally various offices, besides the normal type, used for some time an obliteration of similar type, with four or five bars either side of the numeral (Fig. 3).
