Annexation is not a party measure at all in the U.S. as you seemed to think- I do not know what Mr. Clay's views are- He is certainly to be the next president by a large majority- the popular current tends so strongly that way that the few demagogues who trail in the footsteps can't survive the storm. Even the Democrats of Ala. will be lukewarm in the approaching contest and I am not certain that their apathy will not give the vote of the state to Mr. Clay- so may it be.

I still reside in Greensboro practicing medicine- am getting tired of it- don't clear any money owing to slow pay and heavy expenses- want to get to the country- shall do so next year and dig the earth for a living have 8 or 10 likely hands which I hire out- a poor business this- my white family does not grow any nor do I know that it ever will hence I think I had just as well live easy while I do live, don't care to get rich.

Hugh and John I often hear from. H. has two children, a girl and boy- John is not married nor likely to be. He has talked of selling his prop has now declined- rightly I think for he has made money and can continue to do and that is as much as any can say and more than a great many. Our country is getting in a fine condition. The people out of debt and money becoming plenty. During the last three months I have seen more gold and silver than I ever saw in my life before- particularly the former. Benton's prediction is being verified. The people are becoming tired of its inconveniences and begin to be clamorous for a U.S. bank. Ala money has been at 2% discount this winter and now is only 8 to --- an unprecedented instance of non specie paying banks paper being worth so much.

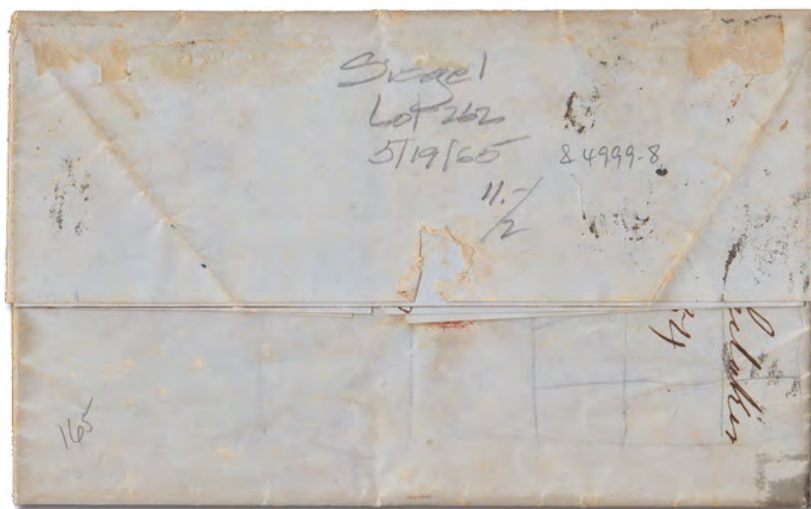
