

Scott \$210. Estimate \$200 - 300



Exceptional Unused Perforated Type I 5¢ Red Brown



- 2511 (★)** 1857, 5¢ red brown, type I (28), expertly regummed, true rich sharp impression with brilliant rich unmistakable red brown color upon bright white paper, projections clear to touching but complete; one of the scarcest unused regularly issued stamps and missing from the most advanced mint collections, Very Fine, *rare*; 2014 P.S.E. certificate. Scott \$15,000. Estimate \$7,500 - 10,000

The delivery of imperforate stock of the 1851 issue provided the first examples to be introduced with perforations for the 1857 issue. Most of the examples extant are without gum, this being an incredibly fresh and choice example.
