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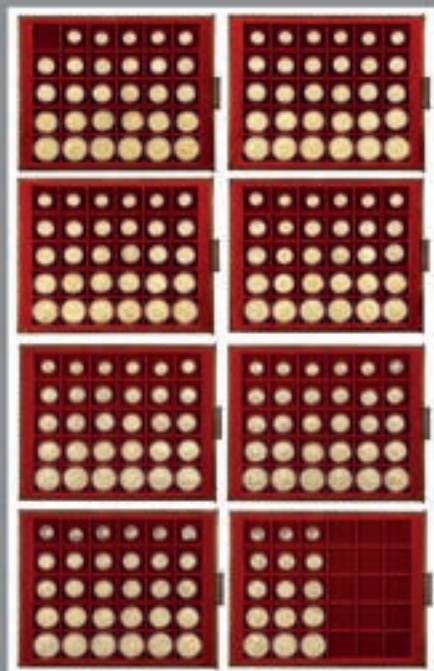

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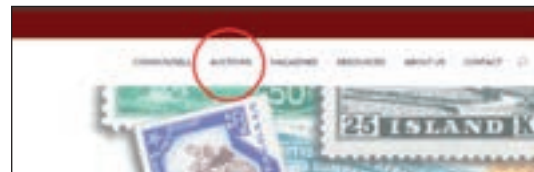
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Featured Biography

HENRY SIEGEL

PIONEER IN THE TV BUSINESS

In his 40-year career in advertising and television, Henry has been recognized as one of the most influential people in the field. He began his career as head of media at Grey Advertising in New York. Advertising Age designated him one of the 50 television pioneers in the first 50 years of television for his creation of barter TV syndication.

FOUNDED LBS – Sports and Entertainment Company

In 1976, following a 12-year career at Grey Advertising where he ran all media operations. Henry founded Lexington Broadcast Services (“LBS”).

At LBS, he pioneered the concept of barter TV syndication i.e. advertiser-supported television. In 1988, he and Warburg, Pinkus Capital Company bought out Grey’s interest in LBS. Henry and his twin brother, Paul, had a long career of producing and distributing live events and sports programming. They produced many live event programs including the first MTV Awards and created and produced the first ESPY Awards for ESPN and together they created a series of 10 different live events including Return to the Titanic, a two-hour prime time special that is the second highest rated special of all time – over 50 million people watched this special live. Also together they produced and distributed a number of TV series such as Fame, Family Feud and Baywatch. As well as children TV series Care Bears, Strawberry Shortcake, He-man and Inspector Gadget.

MERGED WITH SPORTS MARKETING COMPANY

In 1994, he established with his brother Seagull Entertainment, a television production and distribution Company. In 1996, Mr. Siegel merged Seagull Entertainment with Kaleidoscope Entertainment and Sports to form Kaleidoscope Media Group (“KMG”) where he served as chairman and chief executive officer through the Company’s 1997 initial public offering. In 1998, KMG sold its sports operation to Interpublic Group of Companies (“IPG”) after creating GM Event Works, a joint venture with General Motors, IPG’s largest client.

SPORTS TALK SHOW

In October 2001, Henry assisted his father-in-law, a well know sportscaster, Bill “the Amazin” Mazer, in moving his successful sports talk radio show to Whitney Broadcasting’s two stations in Westchester, New York. Where he assisted the day-to-day marketing of this daily Monday to Friday 3-hour sports talk radio program

INVESTMENT IN BOXING

In 2001, Henry began his involvement in the boxing business by making a financial interest in a group of fighters promoted by Banner Promotions, one of the leaders in the boxing business. Produced for ESPN BOXCINO boxing series with 5 major Latin American countries. Produced the finals on ESPN in Costa Rica.

8 Auctioneer reserves the right, at his sole discretion, (i) to accept or decline any bid, (ii) to accept or decline any challenge to any bid or bidding increment, (iii) to reduce any mail bid received, (iv) to open the bidding of a lot at any level deemed appropriate by the Auctioneer, and (v) to determine the prevailing bid.
