The three centavos was used for the first time May 1, 1865. They were used in Mexico City only to pay the postage for letters at the rate of 3¢ for the first 25 gr. It was the first time that a metric system was used (reales before). Only 2,600 were printed of which 197 were returned to the Post Office.
