GOVERNOR'S SIGNED STAMPS EXCLUSIVE

There will be a total of 1200 resident and 1200 non-resident stamps printed of the special Governor's Edition stamp of which 330 will be sold in matching numbers 1 through 330 with the print edition.

There will be a total of 300 signed Governor's Stamps (150 resident and 150 non-resident) which will be sold as sets in 5 lots of 30 Up sheets, exclusively by Direct Mail Auction. Each lot to consist of 30 resident (sheet) and 30 non-resident (sheet) matching numbered stamps.

The remaining 720 stamps in both resident and non-resident, or a total of 1440 stamps, will be sold by Mail Bid Auction in twenty-four (24) lots. Lots will consist of 2 sheets (one resident and one non-resident matching number stamps). (60 stamps).

NO GOVERNOR STAMPS WILL BE SOLD AS SEPARATE STAMPS - ONLY IN SHEET FORM (EXCEPT FOR THOSE SOLD W/PRINTS)

THE MAIL AUCTION will be conducted with advertising in philatelic magazines and other sources as well as dealer announcements. The date of the closing of the bids is Aug. 30, 1989. Winning bid to be announced Sept. 15, 1989.
