





1987 TEXAS DUCK STAMP & PRINT by GARY MOSS



Gary Moss' elegant rendition of white-fronted geese joins what has quickly evolved into a fall classic for sportsmen and collectors — The Texas State Duck Stamp. Conceived in 1981, the Texas Duck Stamp and Print Program easily became the most successful of all state print programs. In all, 64,200 prints have been sold and yet these editions remain among the most collectible of all duck stamp prints. Texas Parks and Wildlife has received nearly \$3 million from the sale of its duck stamp prints, making the Texas program the envy of its peers.

For 1987. Gary Moss returned to a classic duck stamp style that features a pair of white-fronts strongly detailed in the foreground. Moss was 1986 Texas DU Artist of the Year. Best of Show in the wildlife category in 1982 at the National Wildlife

Art Collectors Society, and first place in the Minnesota Duck Stamp Contest in 1983. In 1982, Moss was listed in "Who's Who in American Art".

The image size of the signed and numbered limited edition is 6½" x 9": overall size 12½" x 14". The print will be \$125; the accompanying stamp \$5. The edition will be limited to wholesale orders received by July 31, 1987. There will be no remarques. Shipment is expected in fall of 1987.

A Ducks Unlimited 50th Anniversary Medallion Edition of 200 prints will be available through Texas Ducks Unlimited. A special Conservation Edition of 200 prints will be made available to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department. There will be 100 artist's proofs.







1989 TEXAS DUCK STAMP & PRINT



by DAVID MAASS

David A. Maass, mallards and the Texas State Duck Stamp are an unbeatable combination that promises to be a favorite with conservation stamp and print collectors. Maass' rendition of mallards on the wing is the ninth in what has proved to be the most successful of all state stamp and print programs.

Since 1981, over 77,000 prints have been sold and Texas has received nearly \$3.5 million for restoration of waterfowl habitat. State funds for waterfowl conservation have become increasingly vital as duck numbers in 1988 dropped to their second lowest level in recent times. Texas has spent its duck stamp money to acquire important habitat as well as improve existing habitat. Matching funds from Ducks Unlimited's MARSH (Matching Aid to Restore State Habitat) Program have amplified the impact of Texas Duck Stamp money.

Maass is one of the most prolific conservation stamp and print artists and is no stranger to Texas. His masterful wood duck design graces the 1984 Texas stamp art. In all, his credits include 27 conservation stamps and prints, 13 of which are duck stamps.

In the past 10 years. Maass has been named Artist of the Year by Ducks Unlimited, the National Wild Turkey Federation and the Minnesota Wildlife Heritage Foundation. In 1988, he was named Ducks Unlimited's First International Artist of the Year.

The image size of the signed and numbered limited edition is $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9", overall size $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14". The print will cost \$135, the accompanying stamp \$5. The edition will be limited to wholesale orders received by June 30, 1989. There will be no remarques. Shipment is expected by fall of 1989.

A special Conservation Edition of 400 prints will be made available to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department. There will be 100 artists proofs.

1989 TEXAS WILD TURKEY STAMP & PRINT by ELDRIDGE HARDIE



Eldridge Hardie's regal painting of Rio Grande gobblers represents the sixth in a continuing series of conservation prints that benefit the Texas Chapter of the National Wild Turkey Federation and, indirectly, Texas wild turkeys themselves.

The Texas Federation has been instrumental, along with the National Wild Turkey Federation and Texas Parks and Wildlife, in the eastern turkey restoration program in East Texas, the largest project of its kind yet attempted.

Proceeds from the Texas Wild Turkey Stamp and Print help to fund the eastern turkey restoration program and other turkey conservation projects. Hardie, a native of West Texas who now lives in Denver, was Trout Unlimited's First Artist of the Year in 1978. His paintings often appear in conservation magazines, especially *Ducks Unlimited*.

The 1989 Texas Wild Turkey Stamp will be published in an edition of 1500 signed and numbered prints. Image size is 6½" x 9": overall size 12½" x 14". The print will be \$125: the accompanying stamp is \$5. There will be an artist's proof edition of 150 prints and a Conservation Edition of 150 prints. Shipment is expected in the summer of 1989.



ROBERT BATEMAN



Born in Toronto, Robert Bateman was a keen artist and naturalist from his early days. Bateman painted wildlife and wilderness in a representational style until his teens when he began to interpret nature using a variety of contemporary styles.

In the early 60s, Bateman rediscovered realism and began to develop the style that would make him one of the foremost artists depicting the world of nature. In the 70s and early 80s, Bateman's work began to receive critical acclaim and to attract an enormous following.

Bateman's art reflects his commitments to ecology and preservation. Since the early 60s, he has been an active member of naturalist clubs and other conservation organizations. This involvement has increased in recent years and is now on a global scale. He has become a spokesman for many environmental and preservation issues and has used his artwork and limited edition prints in fund-raising efforts which have provided millions of dollars for these worthy causes.

Bateman says, "I can't conceive of anything being more varied and rich and handsome than the planet Earth. And its crowning beauty is the natural world. I want to soak it up, to understand it as well as I can, and to absorb it. And then I like to put it together and express it in my paintings. This is the way I want to dedicate my work."


In the 1994 Texas Waterfowl Stamp and Print art, Ken Carlson has captured the gaudy elegance of a shoveler drake in breeding plumage. The Texas Waterfowl Stamp series, now in its 14th year, is the most successful and the most collectible of all state waterfowl print programs. More than 100,000 prints and well over a million stamps have been sold to raise over \$10 million for Texas waterfowl and wetlands conservation.

Ken Carlson is a Texas resident who is recognized as one of America's leading wildlife artists. He painted the 1982 Texas Waterfowl Stamp, the 1984 Texas Chapter of the Wild Turkey Federation Turkey Stamp, the 1985 First Texas Nongame Stamp and the 1992 Texas Turkey Stamp.


