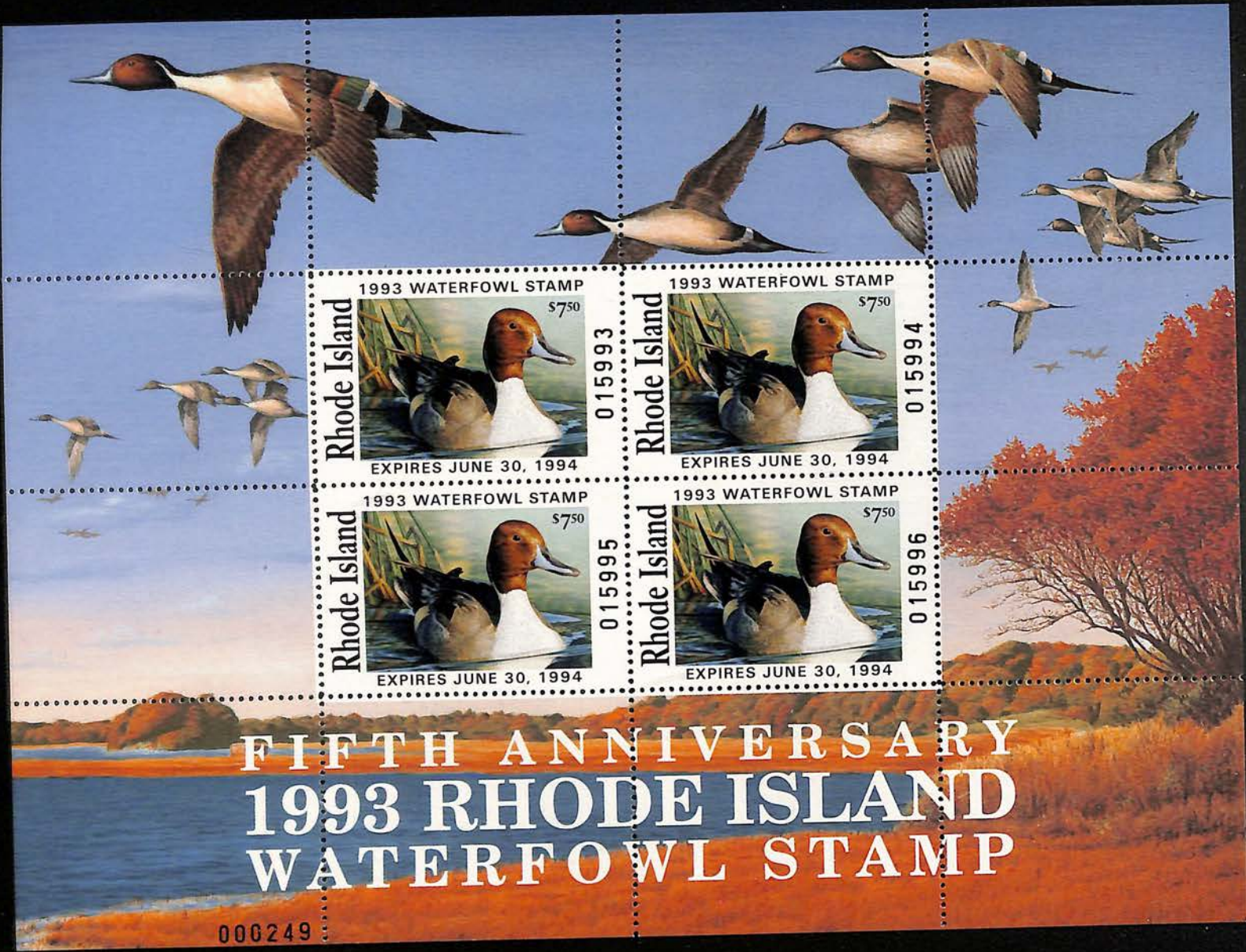

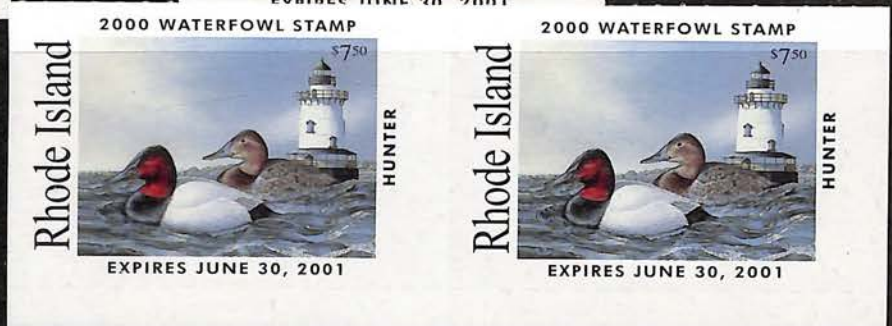
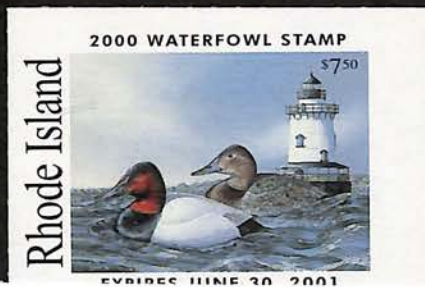

Robert Steiner's beautiful painting, "Canvasbacks at Pellaquamscutt Cove," has been chosen by the Rhode Island Division of Fish and Wildlife as the winning design for the 1989 Rhode Island "First of State" Duck Stamp and print. Revenues raised from the sale of these stamps and prints will be used to preserve precious waterfowl habitat. "First of State" prints have proven to be the best investment in wildlife art over the past 17 years. A complete collection of "First of State" prints would have cost approximately \$5,000 at issue prices and is now valued at over \$45,000.

First Ever Special "First of State" Governor's Edition

Rhode Island will be the first "First of State" with a Governor's Edition of stamps and prints personally signed by the governor. In 1987 New Hampshire inaugurated the first Governor's Edition of stamps and prints. Those \$50 stamps now sell for \$500 and the prints now sell for \$3,000 on the secondary market. A Governor's Edition stamp with any Rhode Island "First of State" print and mint

stamp would be your best investment and a beautiful way to help preserve our natural environment. The Governor's Edition prints will be signed by both the artist and Governor Edward D. DiPrete and include a signed Governor's Edition stamp and a special Governor's Edition silver-on-gold medallion. Governor's Edition prints are available with color or pencil marquee.

The Artist



Robert Steiner is one of the most renowned wildlife artists in America. He has designed more state duck stamps than any other artist: 1989 Rhode Island "First of State," 1989 Arizona, 1989 New Hampshire, 1989 California, 1988 New Hampshire, 1988 California, 1987 New Hampshire, 1987 California, 1986 Florida, 1985 Michigan, 1984 Nevada and 1981 California. Additionally, Mr. Steiner will be the artist for the 1990 through 1992 Rhode Island Duck Stamps!

The Prints

The 1989 Rhode Island "First of State" Duck Stamp print will be available in four editions: regular, medallion, Executive and Governor's. The regular and medallion edition sizes will be limited to the number of orders received by September 30. This ensures the integrity of the editions and that the prints will be on the secondary market after the cutoff date. Medallion edition prints have historically been excellent investments due to their beauty and limited edition size. Regular edition prints numbers one through 2,000 and medallion edition prints numbers one through 400 are reserved for Rhode Island residents and out-of-state collectors who wish to place a \$100 deposit (\$25 per year) for the first four years of the program. Mr. Steiner will be the artist for those four years. The theme of the program will be "Waterfowling in Rhode Island."

The Executive edition prints will be strictly limited to 300 prints. Each will include an original handcolored

etching and a silver-on-gold medallion.

The special Governor's Edition will be limited to only 600 prints. Each will be signed by the artist as well as Governor Edward D. DiPrete and include a silver-on-gold Governor's Edition medallion and a handsigned Governor's Edition stamp. The Governor's Edition is the only edition that will be available remarqued. Numbers one through 300 will only be available color remarqued. Numbers 301 through 600 will be available color remarqued, pencil remarqued, or without a remarque.

The Stamps

Rhode Island is the first "First of State" to issue a special \$57.50 face value Governor's Edition stamp. New Hampshire was the first state to issue a Governor's Edition stamp in 1987. Those \$50 stamps now sell for \$500! The 1989 Rhode Island "First of State" Governor's Edition stamps are sure to be even better investments. The 1989 Rhode Island Governor's Edition stamps will be limited to only 4,400 stamps as compared to 85,000 of the regular stamps. The first 600 Governor's Edition stamps will be handsigned by Governor DiPrete and will accompany the Governor's Edition prints. Only 3,800 Governor's Edition stamps will be available for hunters, print collectors and stamp collectors. The stamps will be valid for hunting in Rhode Island and will have the face value expressed as \$7.50 + \$50. A "First of State" Rhode Island Duck Stamp print with a mint stamp and a Governor's Edition stamp will be your best investment in wildlife art in 1989 and will help preserve our wetlands.
