ADDRESS - on the side bearing the stamp.
OPEN - - by tearing off the ends and breaking the perforated line on top.

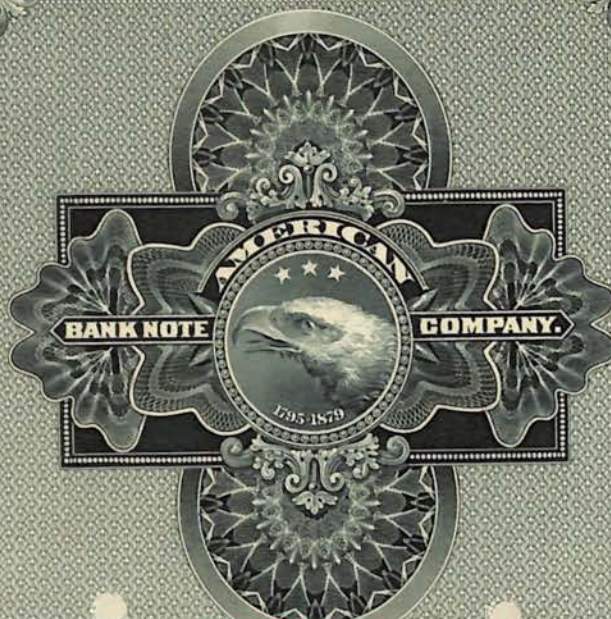
