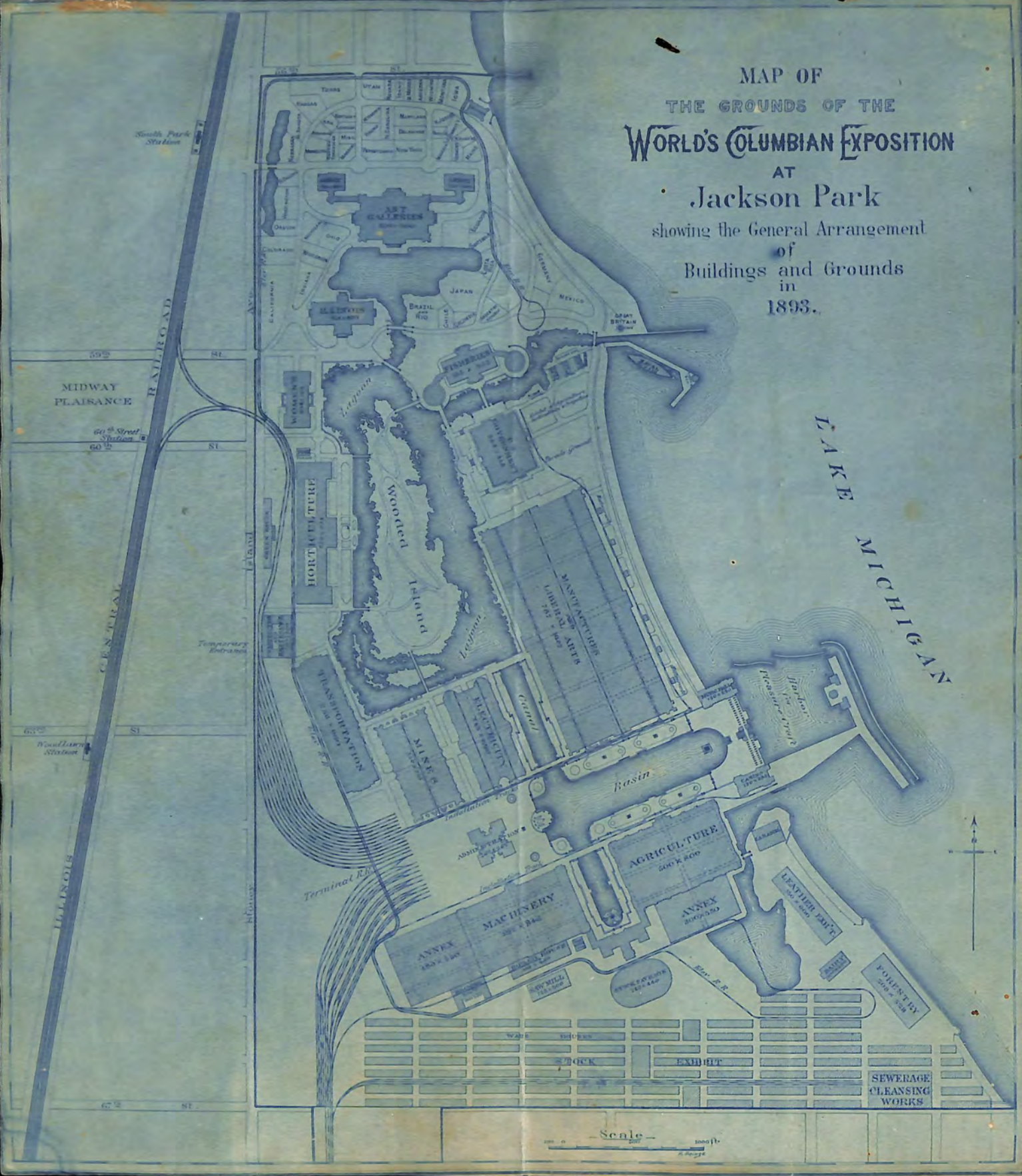

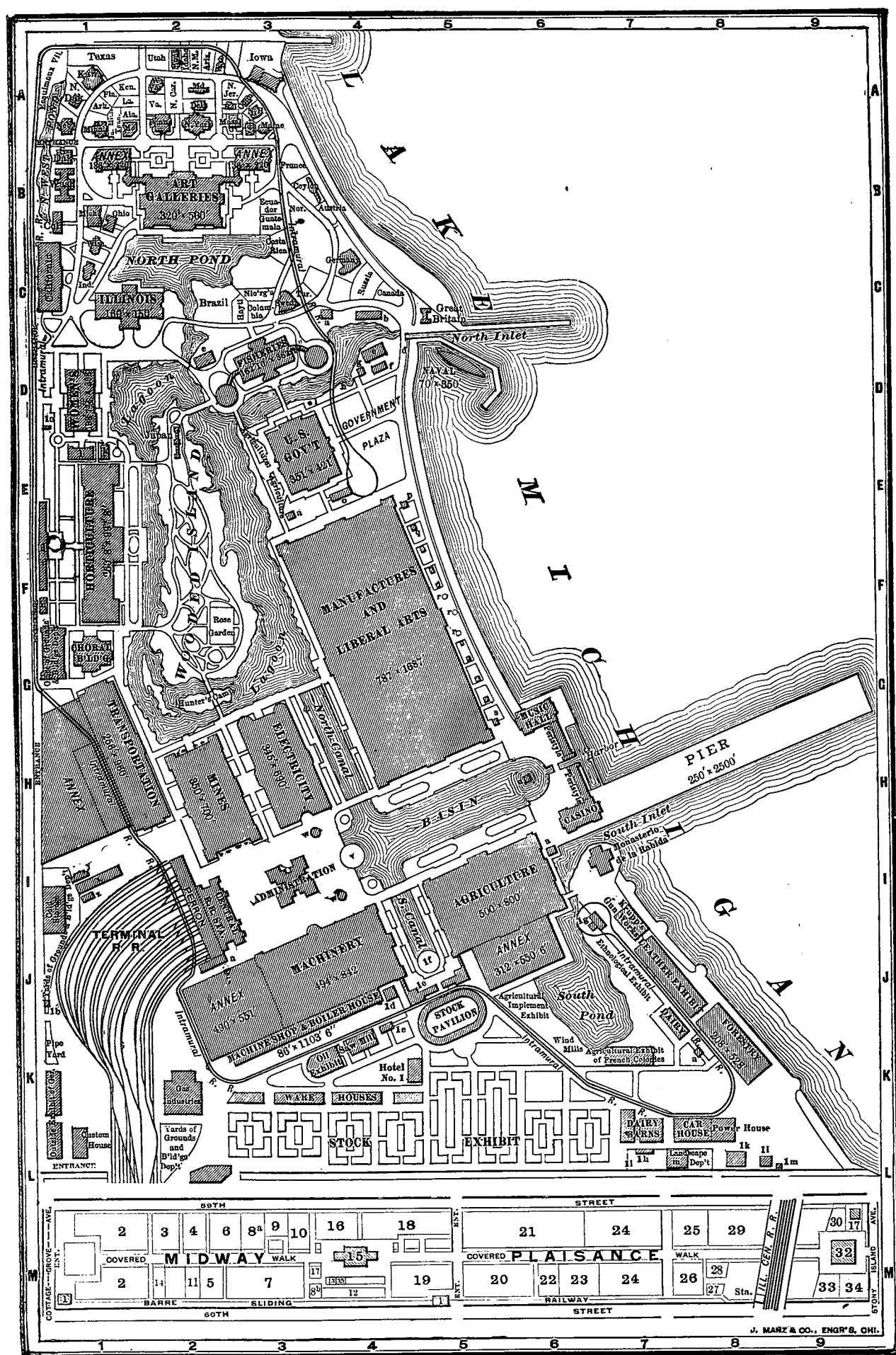

1893.





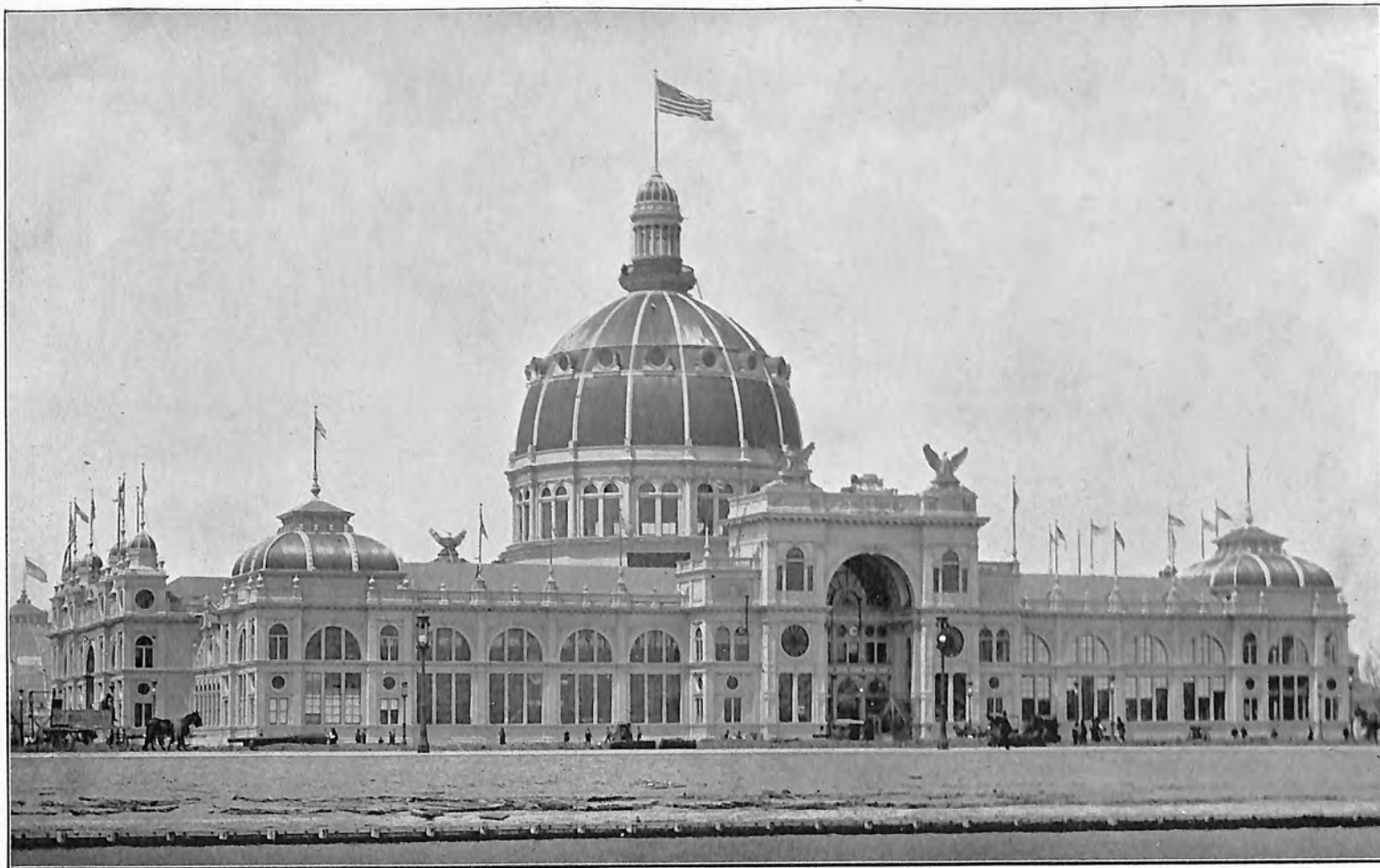
