The "Ark and the Dove", from a drawing, was used as the central theme for this stamp commemorating the 300th anniversary of the settlement of Maryland.



#### Geographic Globe

Specially issued for use on letters mailed thru the Little America post office in the territory of the South Pole. This stamp was sold officially at the Philatelic Agency, Washington, D. C., only.

#### MOTHERS DAY

1934

This stamp was issued as a tribute to the Mothers of America. To the right of the center, and facing left, is a reproduction of the painting by James McNeill Whistler, entitled "Portrait of my Mother." This design was printed by the flat plate process perforation 11, and rotary press perferation 11 x 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>.


# WISCONSIN


