





The spaces provided on this page are for stamps originally prepared for sidewise rotary press coils, but due to short lengths and imperfect sheets these had been set aside as "waste." They had received the vertical 10 gauge perforations as part of the long roll. This "waste" was reclaimed and issued in sheet form by perforating horizontally on the flat plate machines then set at 11 gauge thus creating the 11 by 10 perforation for these stamps.



On April 21, 1923, the Post Office Department issued the one cent stamp of the 1922 Series in sheets run on the rotary presses. They were the first rotary press sheet stamps in this series so issued. The original intentions were to precancel all of rotary press printings by a special attachment that was possible on this type of press, but a cost analysis proved that the rotary press printings were far lower in cost than the flat press work and it was decided to produce the other denominations to 10c in both regular and precancelled form.




