

This cover was sent unpaid from Centa with written note at lower left corner stating that:

"A su llegada se abonara el franqueo" (Payment will be made upon arrival)

"T", "1" and "N" in circle applied to front to indicate that postage was due on this cover and the amount.

A 10 cent postage due stamp applied to cover to pay for the amount of the deficient postage.
















