February 13, 1928

February 13th was the last day of Lindbergh's visit to Havana. Covers were prepared and supposed to have been flown by him back to Saint Louis.

But according to information available, there was a change in plans at the last minute and these covers were not flown by Lindbergh but were flown by regular Airmail to their destinations.

But this cover bears a handstamped cachet that is the only one we have ever seen.

It was applied very lightly in purple and a bit difficult to discern, but it reads inside the double-rim circle: **HABANA - CUBA - SERVICIO AEREO - FEBRO 13, 1928 - 6 AM** and between the two horizontal bars: **LINDBERGH - HABANA - ST LOUIS, MO**

Also, a **SAINT LOUIS, MO - FEB 13, 1928 - CENTRAL STA.** receiving mark was applied on the back. We wonder who could have taken this cover from Havana back to Saint Louis in 12 hours or less.

Is it possible that perhaps Lindbergh himself made an exception and took this cover with him, applying the handstamped cachet that was perhaps supposed to have been applied to all the February 13 mail, but was not since they were not carried by Lindbergh ?

This postcard was sent from Havana to Vermont about a month after Col Charles A. Lindbergh arrived in Havana on February 9th 1928 by someone who witnessed the landing. The sender of the postcard, Isabel, overpaid the 2 centavos postage required by this postcard by using, very fittingly, the 5 centavos Lindbergh stamps. The card reads:





