Soon after July 1, 1863, the large double circle PHILADA. PA. POST OFFICE carrier markings, with or without date and containing 1st, 2nd, 3rd or 4th to indicate pickup or delivery, came into use. These are illustrated by tracings 1 and 2 in Figure 138. Subsequently other carrier markings, such as are illustrated by tracings 3 through 7 were used. Philadelphia sub-station markings contained the letter-designate of each, as for example, "G" for the Germantown station. Tracing 8, CARRIER in circle, is likewise from a Philadelphia local letter which bears no other marking except a quartered cork cancellation on the stamp. Markings similar to this were used in various other cities to indicate carrier service at various dates after June 30, 1863. The only other example

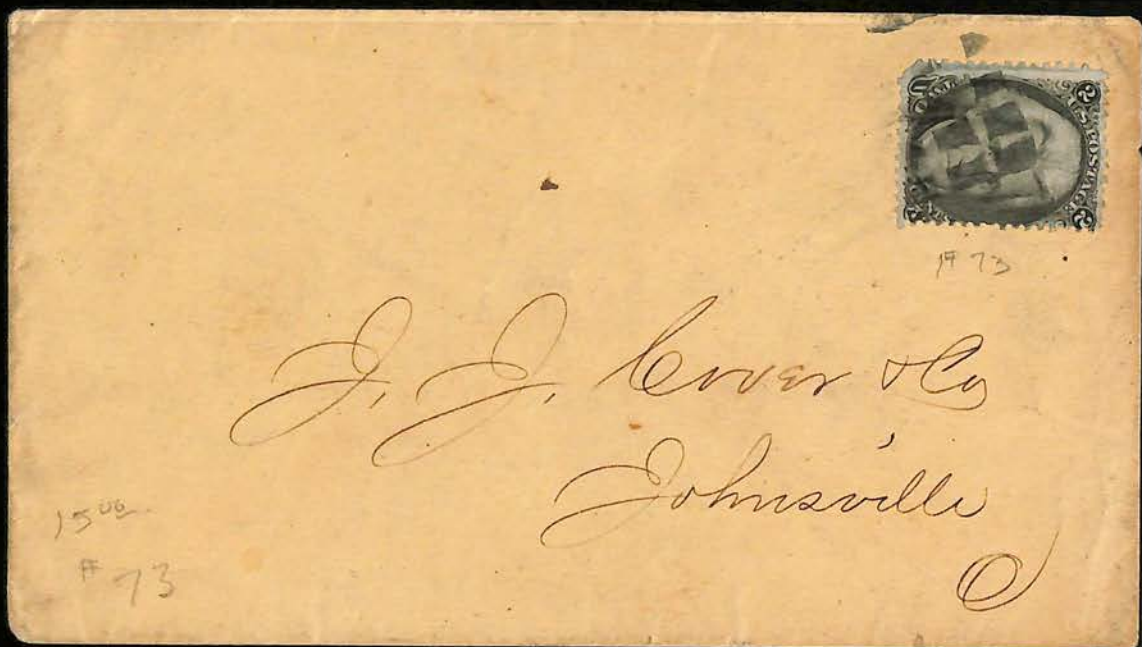

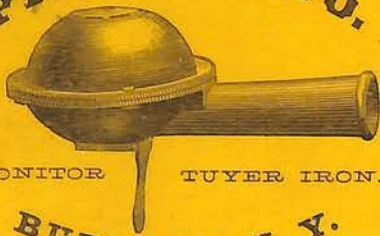
