The very rare "Austrian Ornamental Cancellation" is seen on the 5 soldi Lombardy-Venetian stamp (perf.  $9\frac{1}{2}$ ). This pmk. was used from Jan. 28, 1865 to Jan. 11, 1879.

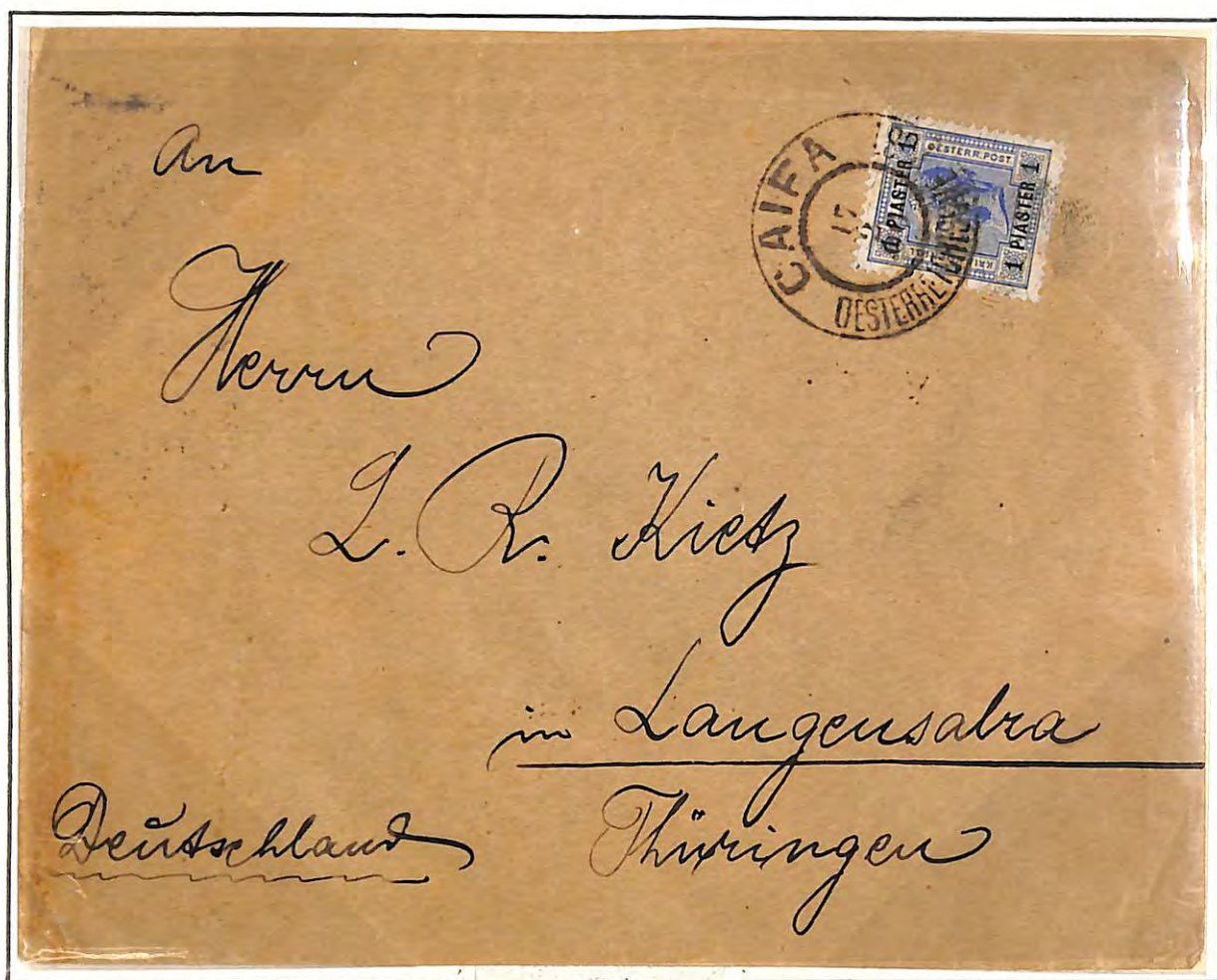

This cover bears the rare postmark " CAIFA " which was the Turkish name for Haifa. This Type 5 postmark was first known June 28, 1902 and ceased to be used by July 21, 1914. The reverse of the cover shows the arrival postmark in Germany on Feb. 28th.

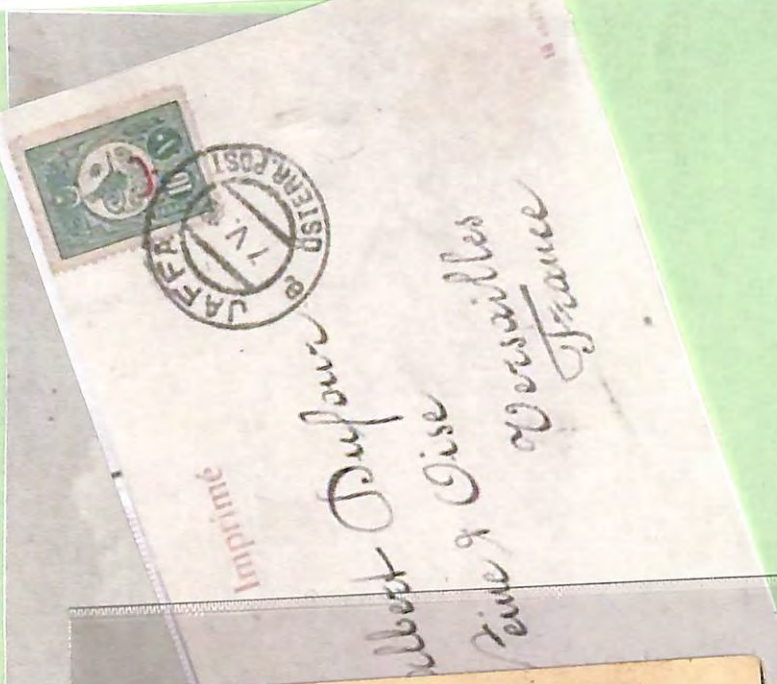

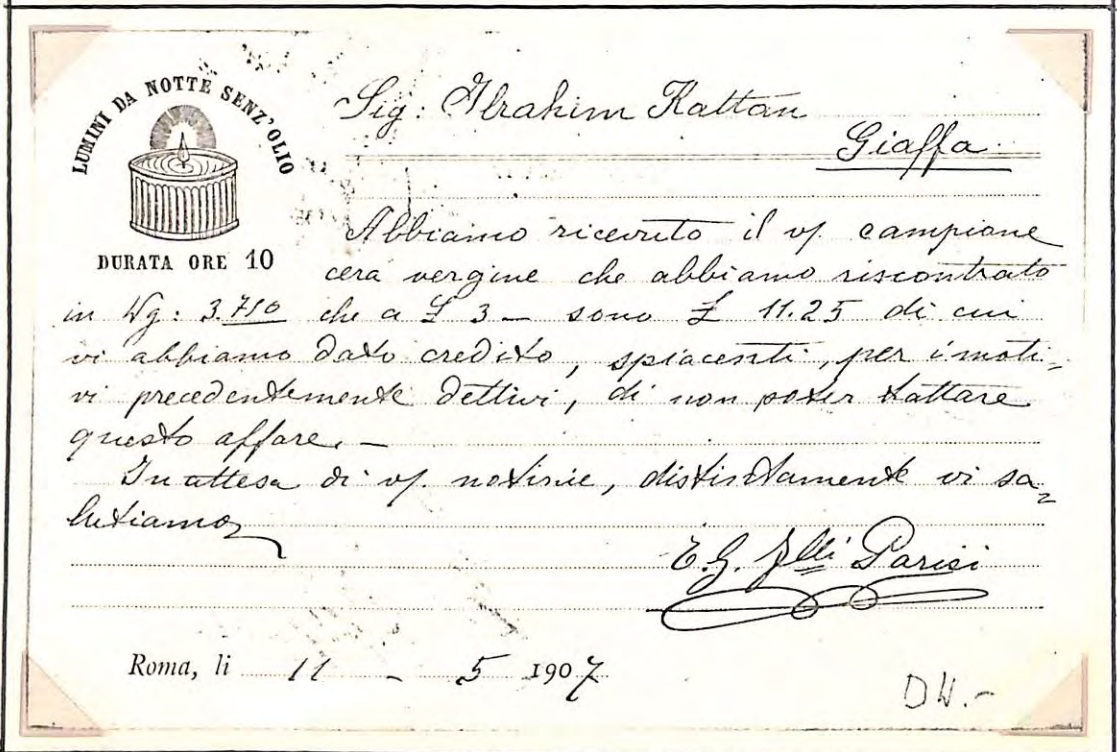

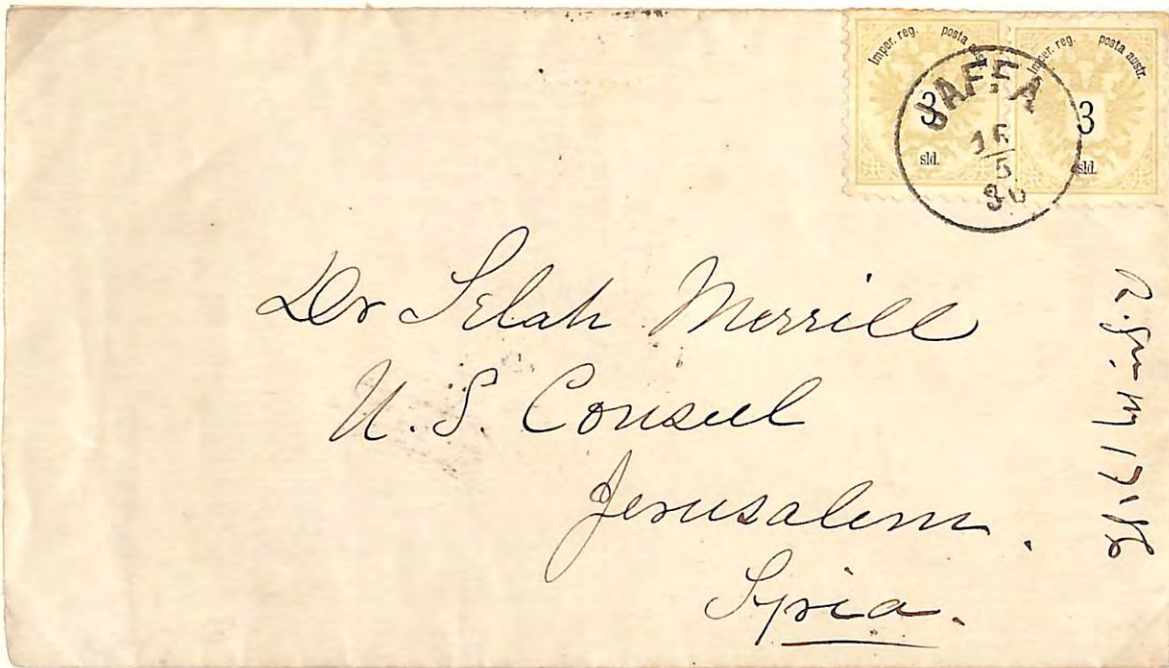

Dec. 11, 1883

This clearly marked card bears the third pmk. of Austrian Offices in Jerusalem in use from Oct. 25, 1882 to Apr. 28, 1887. Of further interest is the blue-green cachet of Rabbi I.L. Goldwicht of Jerusalem in the lower left corner.

Jerusalem to Strassburg

Oct. 31, 1898

This rare card depicts, on the reverse side, the Holy City of Jerusalem to which the German Emperor, Kaiser Wilhelm II, paid a visit and commemorates this occasion.

The departure postmark mentions the Austrian Post in Jerusalem while in the lower left is the destination postmark of Strassburg, Germany dated Nov. 16th. The Austrian stamp is surcharged in Turkish monetary units (Offices in Turkish Empire Sc# 22), and the card bears the postmark "JERUSALEM OESTERREICHISCHE POST" (double circle 28½/14 mm) which was used on this and other special occasions.

This colorful card depicts the "Letzte Christnacht on the reverse. The front of the card bears the violet stamping of "BETLEEM 24 XII 99", Christmas Eve in Bethlehem. The arrival pmk. (lower left corner) is dated Jan. 10, 1900.

Jerusalem to West Brookfield, Mass.

March 14, 1903

This card was posted at the Austrian Post Office in Jerusalem, was carried by French Paquebot "Noumea to Marseille No. 4" on March 18th, and was received in West Brookfield on April 3rd. Of particular interest on the face of this card is the octagonal pmk. of the paquebot as well as the clarity of the receiptal pmk. in the U.S.A.

The stamp on this card is Austrian Offices in the Turkish Empire Sc# 33. The black pmk. in Jerusalem was in use from July 5, 1895 to Sept. 27, 1904.

The very rare violet label denotes that this card was dropped at a Letter Posting Box and was picked up for handling at the Austrian Post Office in Jaffa. The double-box stamping is extremely rare, and the cover bears Austrian stamps surcharged (Sc# 8a) for use in Offices in Crete and in the Offices of the Turkish Empire --- the stamps are rare in this condition. Of interest is that this card was being sent to "Richon Le Sion" (note the French spelling).

This well-marked card bears the Austrian stamp with the French surcharge of 10¢ on 10h rose (Sc# 2 - Austrian Offices in Crete and Turkish Empire).

It bears the violet rubber stamp of "RUCHEL MIZRUCHI" and the clear receival pmk. of Hoechberg, Germany (Bavaria), dated Sept. 10th. The Jerusalem pmk. is Type 12b. The reverse shows the signature of "Ruchel Mizruchy".

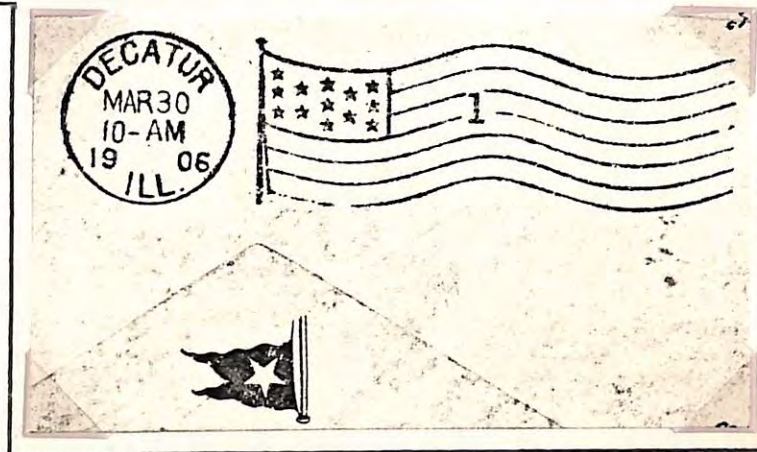
