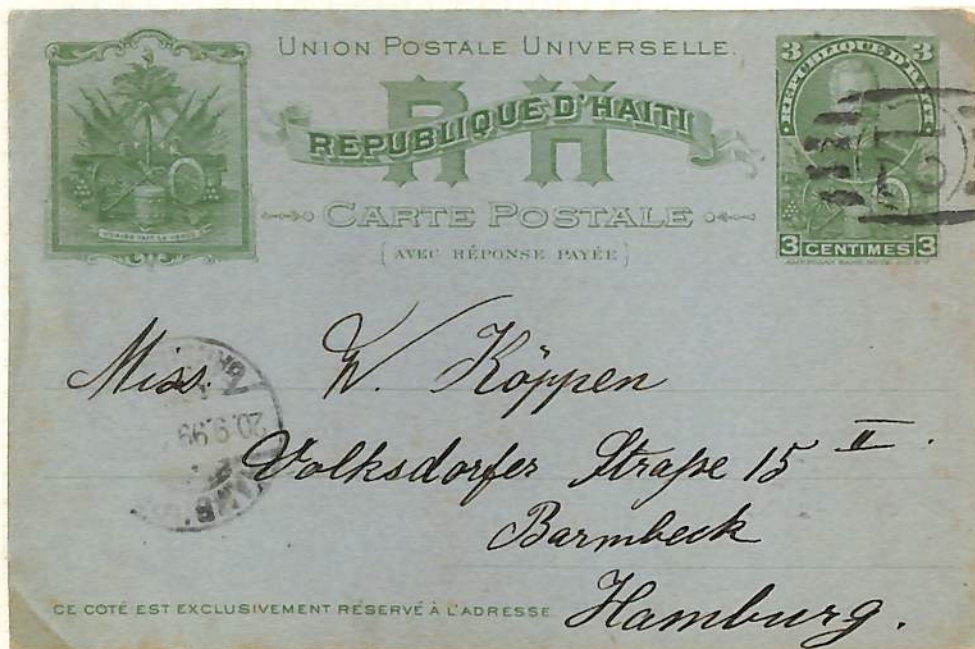

### New York Paquetbot Mail 1897-1906

ACCORDING TO UPU CONVENTION, MAIL POSTED ABOARD SHIP WAS TO RECEIVE A "PAQUETBOT" MARK AND/OR A REGULAR POSTMARK OF THE PORT OF ARRIVAL WHEN DEPOSITED IN THE POST OFFICE WHERE THE MAIL WAS FIRST DISEMBARKED.

FROM THE LATE 1890'S TO THE PRESENT DAY, A VARIETY OF NEW YORK PAQUETBOT AND INCOMING FOREIGN MAIL CANCELS ARE FOUND ON HAITIAN STAMPS. THESE MARKINGS WERE APPLIED TO MAIL DISEMBARKED FROM THE MANY SHIPS WHICH WERE IN SERVICE BETWEEN HAITI AND THE U.S.

THE EARLIEST OF THESE MARKINGS WAS A STRAIGHT LINE "PAQUETBOT" APPLIED BY THE NEW YORK 2ND DIVISION. THIS TYPE WAS USED FROM THE 1890'S TO ABOUT 1906.

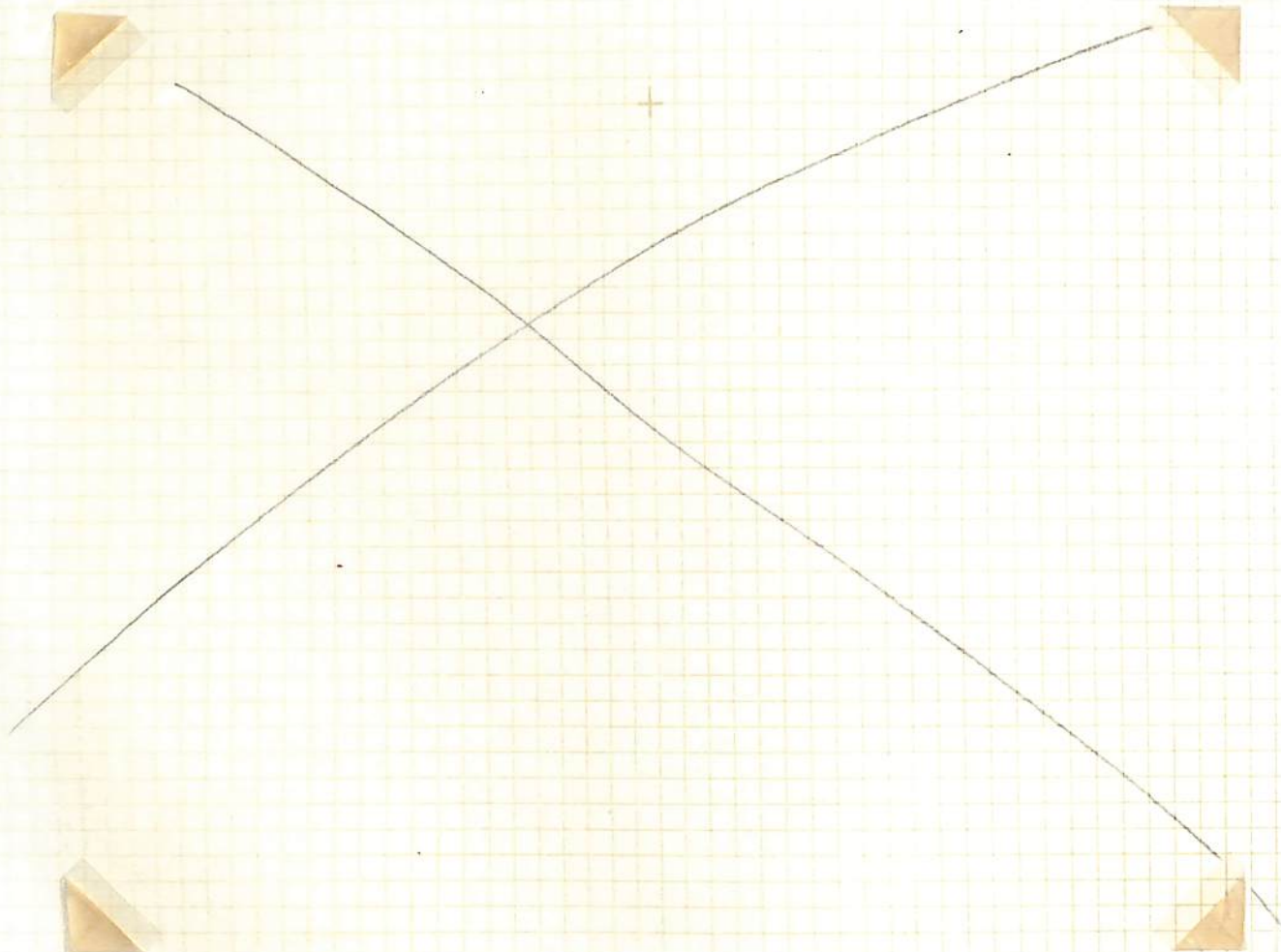

## New York Paquetbot Mail 1907-1915

A CIRCULAR TYPE OF PAQUETBOT MARKING WAS INTRODUCED ABOUT 1907 , READING "N.Y.P.O.—PAQUETBOT" AROUND THE CIRCLE AND WITH THE DATE IN THE CENTER . IT IS RATHER UNCOMMON .



AT ABOUT THIS SAME TIME ANOTHER CIRCULAR CANCEL WAS PUT INTO USE AT THE HUDSON TERMINAL STATION WHERE INCOMING SHIP MAIL WAS PROCESSED . IT READ "N.Y.P.O. HUD. TERM. STA.—PAQUETBOT" AROUND THE CIRCLE WITH DATE IN THE CENTER .

### New York Paquetbot Mail 1915

ANOTHER TYPE OF CIRCULAR CANCEL WAS USED AT THE HUDSON TERMINAL STATION BEGINNING ABOUT 1915. IN THIS DEVICE, WHICH COMPRISED A CIRCULAR CANCEL AND A KILLER, THE DESIGNATION OF THE TERMINAL WAS IN THE CENTER OF THE KILLER.

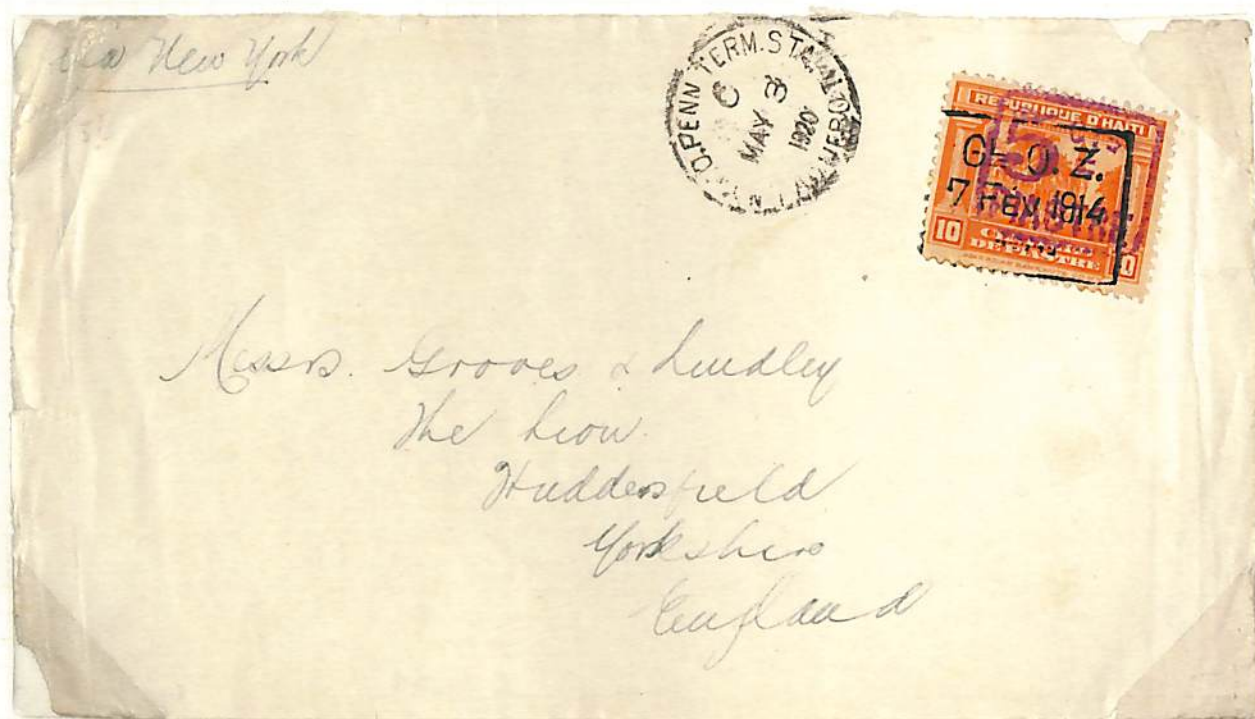

IN ABOUT 1923 ANOTHER CIRCULAR CANCEL AND KILLER DEVICE CAME INTO USE. THE DAY AND MONTH WERE SHOWN IN THE CIRCULAR CANCEL BUT THE YEAR WAS SHOWN OUTSIDE THE CIRCLE, BETWEEN IT AND THE KILLER AND WITH A LETTER ABOVE THE YEAR DATE.

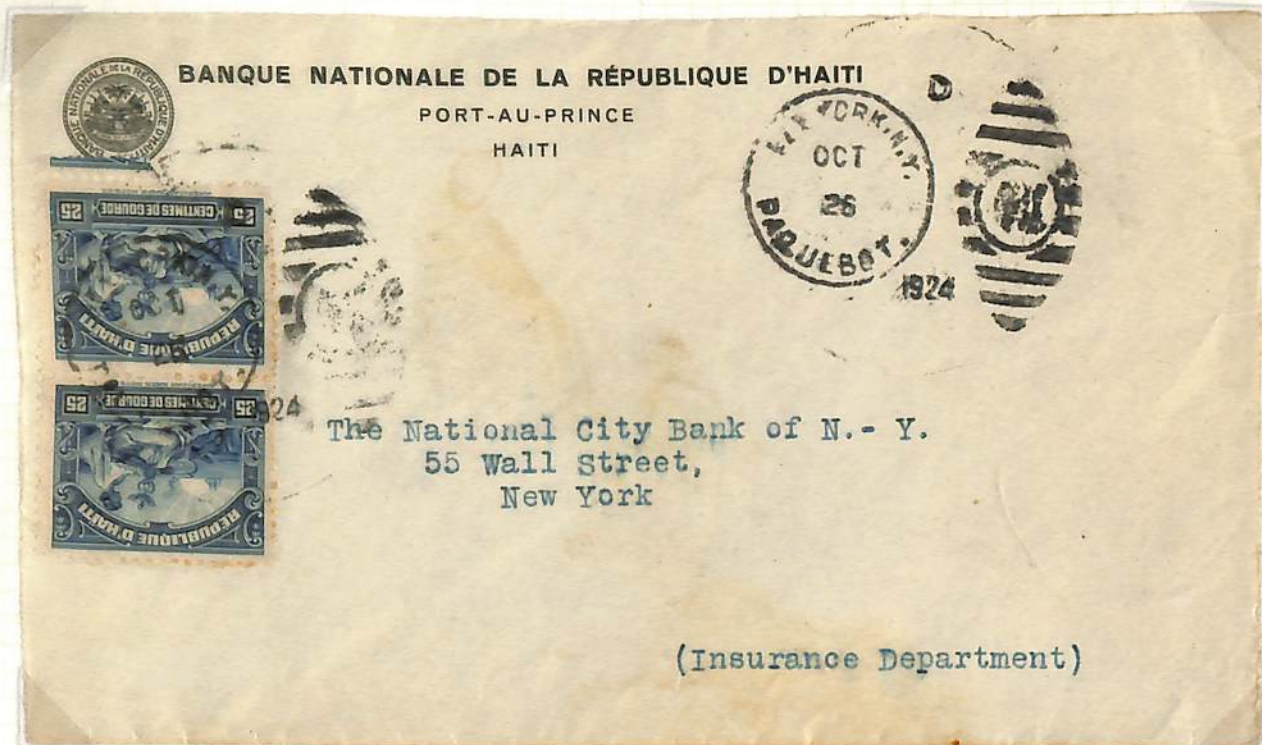

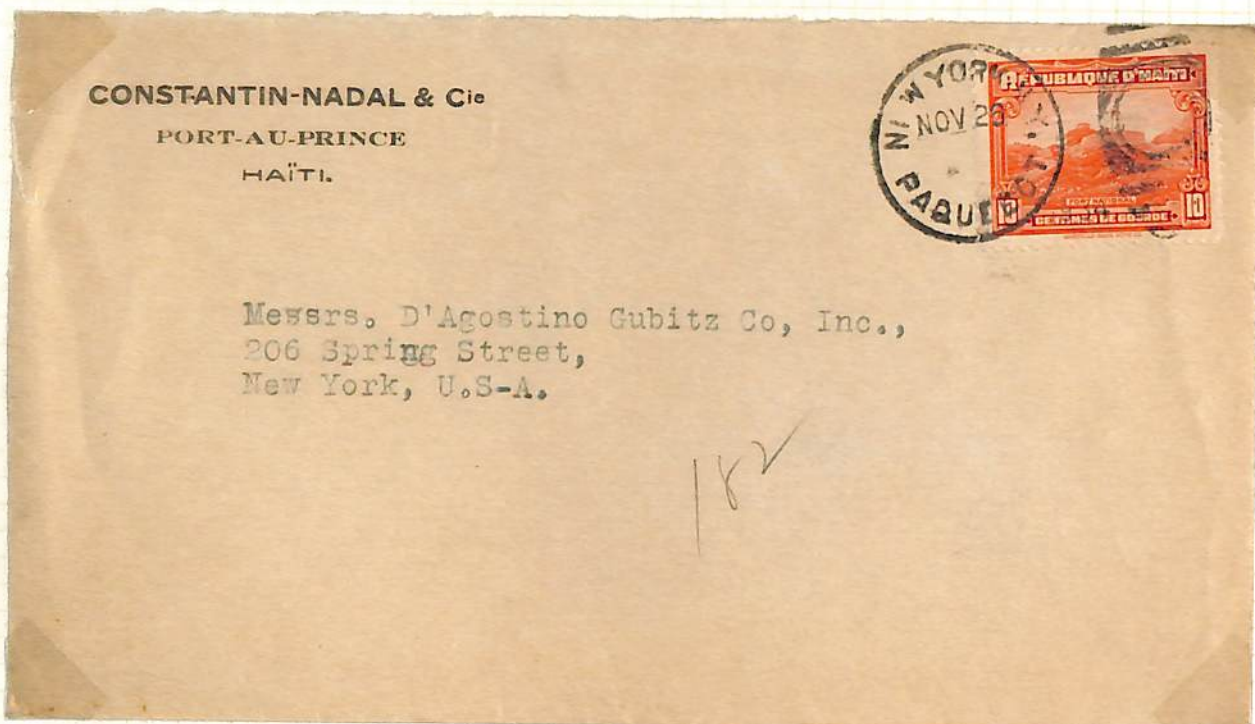
THE PREVIOUS CANCELLING DEVICE WAS SUPPLANTED IN ABOUT 1929 WITH A NEW ONE OF ALMOST IDENTICAL DESIGN. THE KILLER PORTION OF THE DEVICE IS SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT, THERE IS NO LETTER INDICATED ANYWHERE, AND THERE IS A SMALL RECTANGULAR INK BLOB IN THE LOWER LEFT PART OF THE CIRCULAR CANCEL.



The ink blob sometimes appears only partially or not at all.



Probably caused by ink in original opening in die for a year insert.
