WWII Censored Mail

Small cover sent from the very scarce origin of **Petit Riviere des Nippes**. Postmark on stamp is illegible but origin can be verified from hand endorsement on reverse/address side. Excellent strike of Haitian censor control handstamp. Port-au-Prince transit postmark obscured by censor tape. **However, stamp is underpaid for the correct 60c rate.** Reason for the underpayment can be explained by fact that the 60c Madonna stamp and the 10c Statue of Liberty stamp are in identical colors and the postal clerk wrongly accepted the 10c stamp as the correct 60c rate stamp. See for comparison the correct 60c stamp on the similar cover from Cap-Hatien to New York.

Commercial cover, legal size from Port-au-Prince to New York dated Apr. 9, 1943. Correctly franked with 60c Madonna stamp paying the airmail rate. Note 'written in English' hand endorsement. #10 size envelopes are uncommon during the WWII censor period.

Correct 60c airmail rate paid by 60c Statue of Liberty stamp in olive-green color. With good strike of Haitian censor control handstamp and tape.

WWII Censored Mail

Jan. 22, 1944

Commercial cover from Cap-Hatien to New York. Transit postmark on reverse Port-au-Prince Jan. 24, 1944. With good strike of Haitian censor control handstamp and tape. *Postage is paid by 3x 60c chocolate-brown airmail stamp for a total of 1G 80c in effect paying the 60c airmail by 3x!* It is unclear as to why the cover is franked with 3x correct rate other than perhaps the sender was intending to the letter to be sent registered which it was not. See for comparison the adjacent cover paying the correct 60c rate with the stamp stamp used only once.
