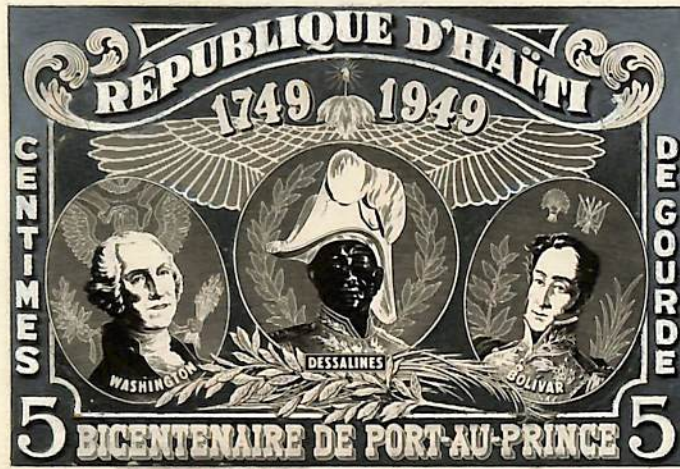

Mr. Schomp expressed a desire over the telephone, on April 4, to have the plate ready for printing by July 1st so that the stamps could be issued in July.

I told him that if we could start work just as soon as the model was furnished, without waiting for formal approval, that we could probably save two weeks from the promise. I pointed out that we were following closely to the customers sketch and that any change asked for would probably be a minor one that could be taken care of as the engraving was being made.

Mr. Schomp expressed the opinion that we could proceed without waiting approval and we are proceeding accordingly.
