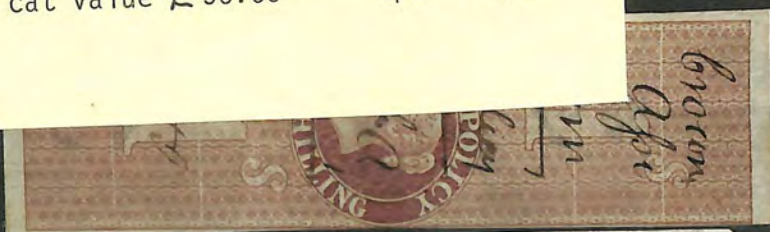

**Life Policy
Duty Stamps**
1853-1872

An Act of 1853 made life insurance policies liable to Stamp Duty. The life policy stamps issues are separated by printing dates & watermarks into five groups: 1853, 1860, 1865, 1869 & 1872.

Die 1:

The Line defining the Queen's nostril is almost a *straight line*.



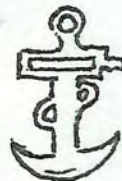

The Queen's nostril is defined by a *curved line*.

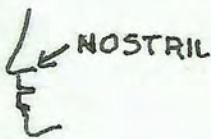
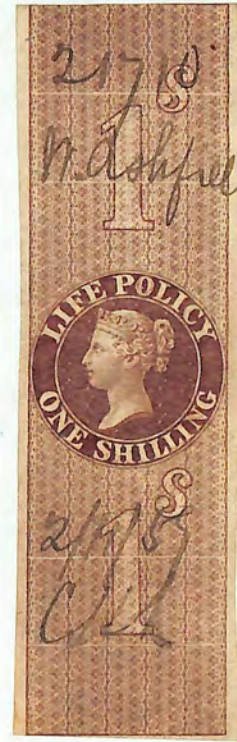
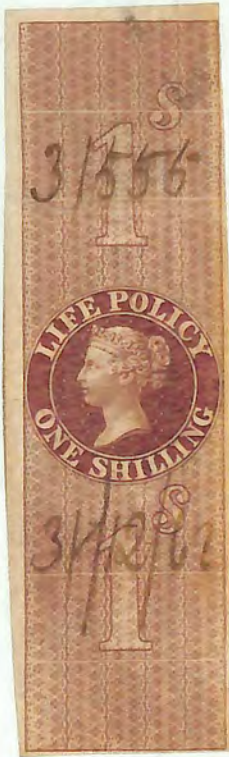
1853 Line engraved Printed by Perkins, Bacon & Co. on white wove paper. The watermark is a Cabled (Fouled) anchor with wooden stock.

The insurance policy stamp duty sliding scale,

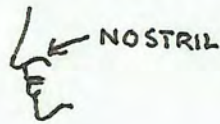
- 1) Where the sum insured did not exceed £10: duty 1d
- 2) Where the sum exceeded £10 but less than £25: duty 3d
- 3) Where the sum exceeded £25 but less than £500: 6d of every £50 or fraction thereof.
- 4) Where the sum exceeded £500, less than £1000: 1/ for each £100 or fraction thereof.
- 5) Where the sum exceeded £1000: 10/ for each £1000 or fraction thereof.

Inverted watermark

1853 Die 1, 1/ red brown, was registered November 3, 1853. Die 2, 1/ red brown, was registered February 16, 1859. The watermark Cabled (Fouled) anchor with wooden stock appears three times on each stamp and can be found inverted.

Inverted Watermark

1853 Pen cancelled copies are common; usually include policy number, insured's name, agents' signature/company name. Die 1, 2/, registered November 3, 1853. Die 2, 2/, February 16, 1859.

1860 Printed by Perkins Bacon on blued paper with a **new** watermark: Cabled (Fouled) Anchor with **single line wooden stock** appears three times per stamp and is found inverted.

1860 Accidental Death policy premiums were taxed at the following rates:
1d where premium did not exceed 2/6d, 3d where premium was over 2/6d but less than 5/,
3d when the premium exceeded 5/ or for any fraction thereof.

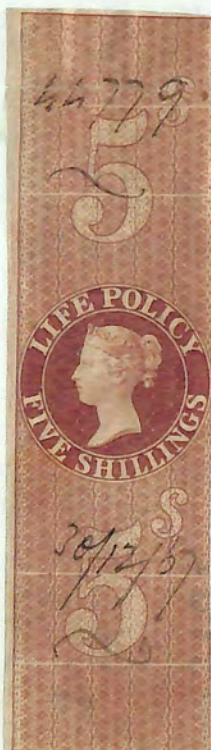
1865 All values of the 1/ & 2/ are Die 2. Lightly blued paper is not unusual. The Anchor watermark is 16mm long, which appears three times per stamp and is found inverted.

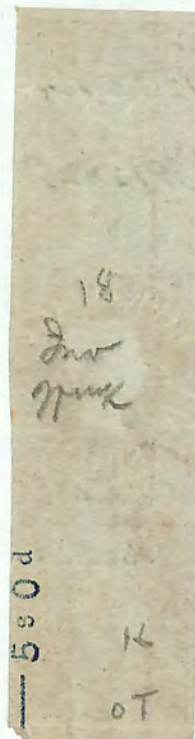

1865 The 2/6 values are Die 1 while the 5/ values are all Die 2. Lightly blued paper is considered somewhat scarce as are the inverted 16mm long Anchor watermarks.

1869 Printed by Perkins Bacon on white wove paper with a **new** watermark: Anchor 18mm single line slightly revised appearance and seen three times per stamp and found inverted.

1869 The design elements are basically the same as the 1865 issues, only the 2/6 values are Die 1 while all the other values Die 2. Lightly blued paper is considered somewhat scarce as are the inverted 18mm long Anchor watermarks.
