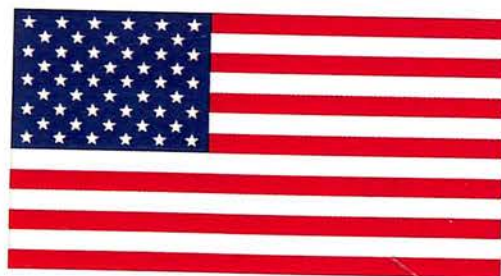

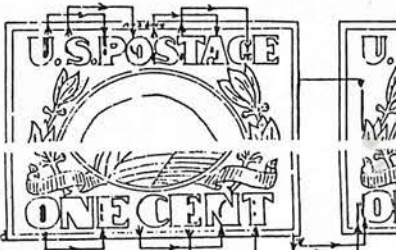

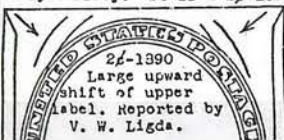


A Double Transfer or Reentry, so far removed from the normal position as to show in two adjacent stamps, is truly a novelty in plate varieties.

The illustration at the right shows a pair of the 1¢-1908-10 with the shift showing mostly in the left stamp but the right frame line of the misplaced entry shows in the left side of the right stamp. Both the normal and the shifted lines have been heavily inked and connected with bent arrows. Here is a study in shifts that is worthy of detailed attention. We might suggest that you "follow the arrows". To those not so familiar with shifts this diagram should be instructive in regard to how shifted lines often appear.



Now from a Shift that bridges across two stamps let us go to a stamp that bridges across two shifts (if such be a correct term). Dr. Gearhart is the lucky owner of this extraordinary variety. It is a 2¢-1890 which clearly shows the arch of the upper label from two previous entries, these two arches being normally spaced as for the stamps themselves. As recently published in the American Philatelist, there is such evidence of a reworked plate in this issue for a large number of enormous shifts have been found.

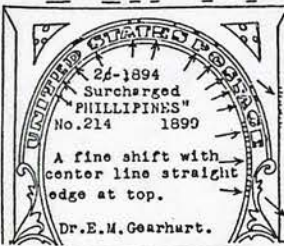


We cannot justly call this a triple transfer except in that three impressions from the same relief show on the one stamp. This is better described as a Double-Double Transfer, a shift to the East and a shift to the West and it sure is the King of all the double-doubles so far observed.

V.W. Ligda sends another of the large shifts on the 2¢-1890 as illustrated above. A collection of these major varieties would make an attractive display at any exhibition.

J.C. Schenk has the 1¢-1917 shift as illustrated at the upper left. Note the extra lines in the forehead of Washington. There are said to be several panes of this stamp that show many shifts in each pane.

In a recent report we mentioned the mis-alignment in a booklet pane from plate No. 10220 and several of the Shift Hunters have sent in their copies for illustration. This "plate variety" is "different" to say the least. If it had been discovered and corrected it would have resulted in what we call a "TWISTED SHIFT, Clockwise." Plate varieties on booklet panes are not often observed.



Dr. Gearhart finds the fine shift as shown at the lower left, on the 2¢-1894 with the "PHILLIPINE" surcharge and a centerline straight edge at the top. I once bought a straight edge shift from a dealer who offered to reperf the edge for me. He did not realize that Ashbrook records that shift as always showing the straight edge. Straight edges are an asset to the plate variety student and add rather than subtract from stamp values when present.

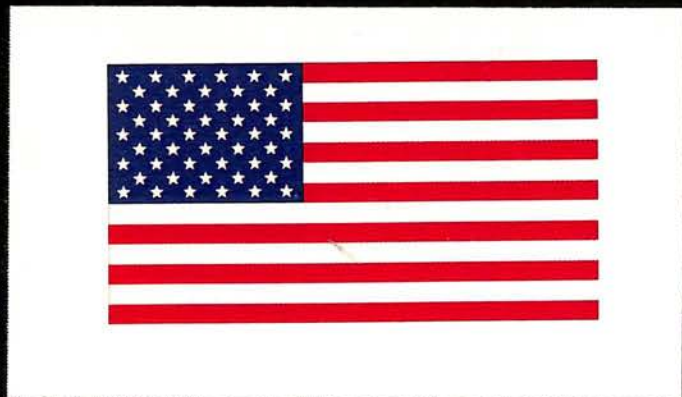
