2. Covers With Un-overprinted Jubilee Stamps

Sain

Saint Helena to Binfield, England
July 30, 1888 with original
contents of a family letter from
W. Grey Wilson, the Governor of
the Island, to his mother. The
letter is written on headed
notepaper of "The Castle, Saint
Helena" and mentions the mail
steamer H.M.S. Bramble and
Commander Harrison. It is seldom
that such senior diplomats' letters
are found, and an example from
St. Helena is even more
remarkable. The governor
initialed the bottom left corner of
the cover "W.G.W." (W. Grey
Wilson).

RATE: Sending in a diplomatic
bag was safer and the London
posting (1d) was less
expensive.
