Burgoyne Campaign Issue

Issued to commemorate the Battles of Bennington, Oriskany, Fort Stanwix, and Saratoga.



Valley Forge Issue

Issued to commemorate the 150th anniversary of Washington's encampment at Valley Forge, Pa.



Battle of Monmouth Issue

Issued to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the Battle of Monmouth, N.J., and as a memorial to Molly Pitcher, the heroine of the battle.



Hawaii Sesquicentennial Issue

Issued to commemorate the Sesquicentennial Celebration of the discovery of the Hawaiian Islands.



Aeronautics Conference Issue

These stamps were issued to commemorate International Civil Aeronautics Conference at Washington, D. C., which took place December 12-14, 1928. It also commemorated the 25th anniversary of the first flight by the Wright brothers December 17, 1903.

George Rogers Clark Issue

This stamp was issued to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the surrender of Fort Sackville, the present site of Vincennes, Indiana, to George Rogers Clark.

This special issue produced by overprinting "Kans." and "Nebr." on stamps of the 1926-27 series. This special issue was authorized as a measure of preventing losses from post office burglaries. About a one year supply was issued to postmasters in Kansas and Nebraska. These overprinted stamps were discontinued when the supply was used.

Issued as a memorial to General Anthony Wayne and to commemorate the 135th anniversary of the Battle of Fallen Timbers, in which Wayne won an important victory over an Indian force during the American Revolution.



Ohio River Canalization Issue

Issued to commemorate the completion of the Ohio River Canalization Project, which connected Cairo, Illinois and Pittsburgh, Pa.

Issued to commemorate the 300th anniversary of the founding of the Massachusetts Bay Colony.



Carolina - Charleston Issue

Issued in commemoration of the 260th anniversary of the founding of the Province of Carolina and the 250th anniversary of the city of Charleston, S. C.
