Double -ring handstamp at top reading "Nokhon/Talbokh" which is a POSTAGE DUE marking meaning "collect paymen". On reverse the Ulaanbaatar arrival postmark dated Oct. 27, 1960.

CANCELLED IN VIOLET WITH RARE DOUBLE-RING POSTMARK FROM ARKhangai as there was no post office in Khairhan village.

Arrival postmark on reverse from UB dated April 6th, 1961.

Sender is from the tiny village of **ULZIIT** in the **Dund-Gobi Aimag** and is addressed to the "UNEN" newspaper in Ulaanbaatar. As there was no post office in the village it was postmarked in **DUND-GOBI** and on reverse is the arrival postmark from "UB No. 40" dated Oct. 7, 1960. Very late usage of the 1t stamp and close inspection of the 15m stamp reveals that **IT WAS PREVIOUSLY CANCELLED AND HAS BEEN RE-USED ON THIS COVER.**

Large Ulaan-Baatar arrival postmark on reverse.

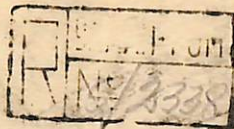

On reverse is a transit postmark from Ulaanbaatar dated May 22, 1960 indicating a 15-day travel time from the border town in the desert to the capital.

A very scarce stamp on cover and also a very rare origin - only two covers known from this town.

Very late usage of a scarce stamp on a cover from a scarce origin.

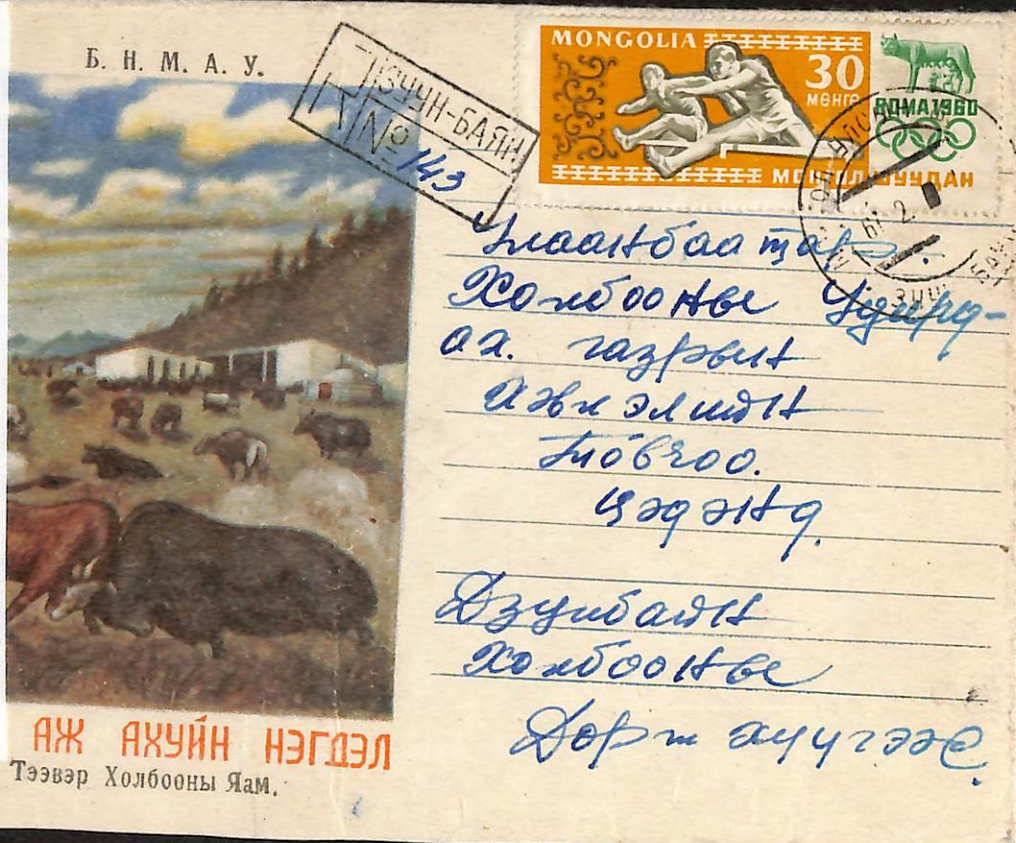

Postmark on front and back for Xar-Airag, together with similar postmark for arrival from Ulaanbaatar dated January 11, 1962.

Rare postmark and a very scarce origin, only 2 or 3 covers known.

Rare cacheted envelope from the Postal Ministry depicting Friendship between China and Mongolia. Postmarked from the very small city of Zamiin-Ude (Uud) in the Aimag (province) of Dorno-Gobi, in the extreme southeast corner of Mongolia.

Franked on reverse with 60m correct rate and transit postmark from Ulaan Baatar using the scarce **machine cancel** with an inverted date, in use for only a short period. With Chifeng arrival postmark on reverse as well.

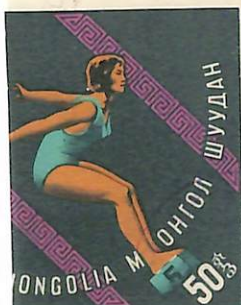

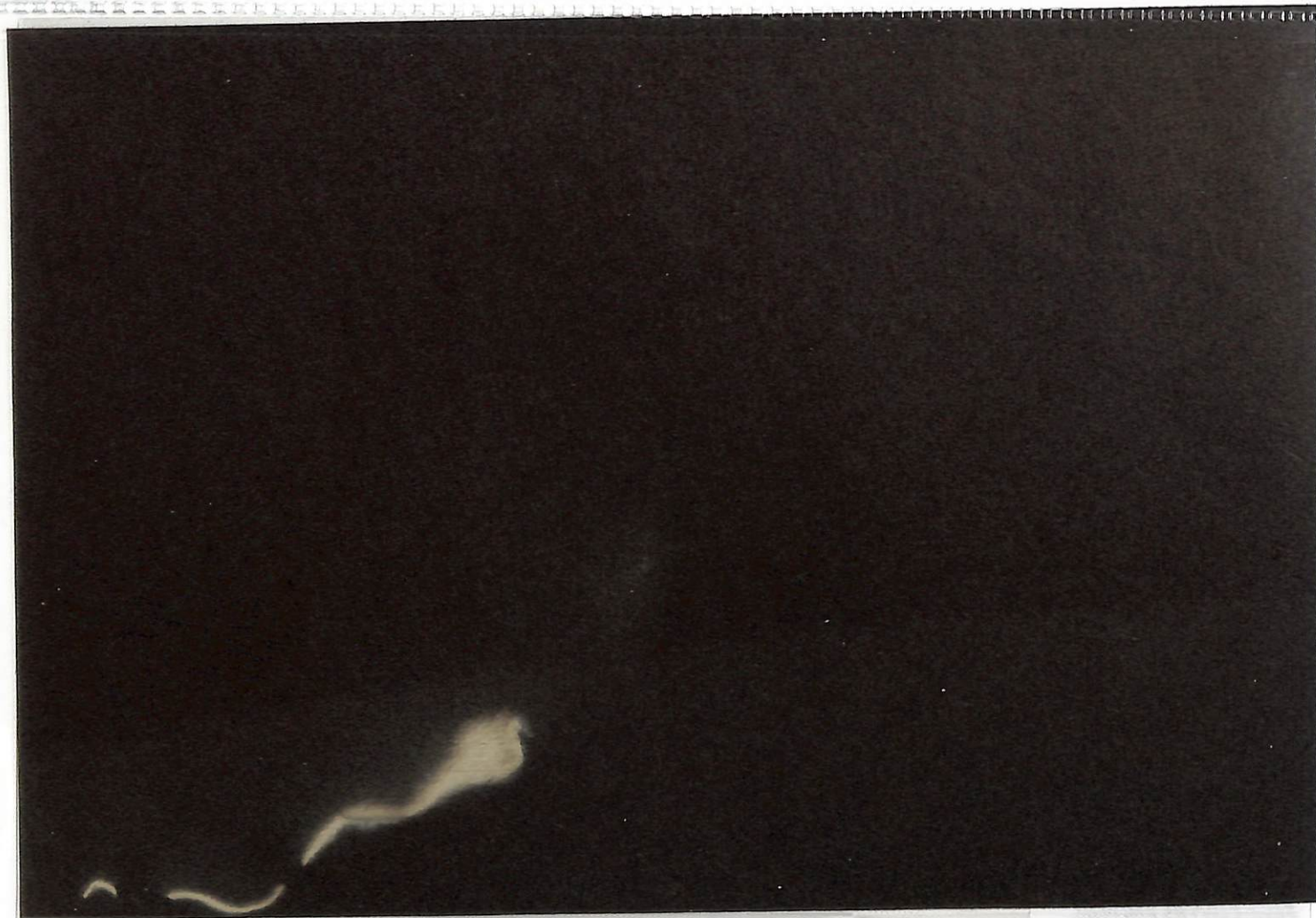

REGISTERED cover, unfranked, written by a washing worker who removes hair from skins of animals and addressed to the Mongolian Art Society in Ulaanbaatar.

Boxed Registry handstamp at right inscribed **"XATGAL"**

(KHATGAL) which is a tiny village in Hovsgol province. The village is next to the lake and where the reindeer people live.

On reverse is Ulaanbaatar arrival postmark as well as partial circular postmark reading "UGAP". Absence of stamps at the village postal center may explain why the cover is unfranked.
