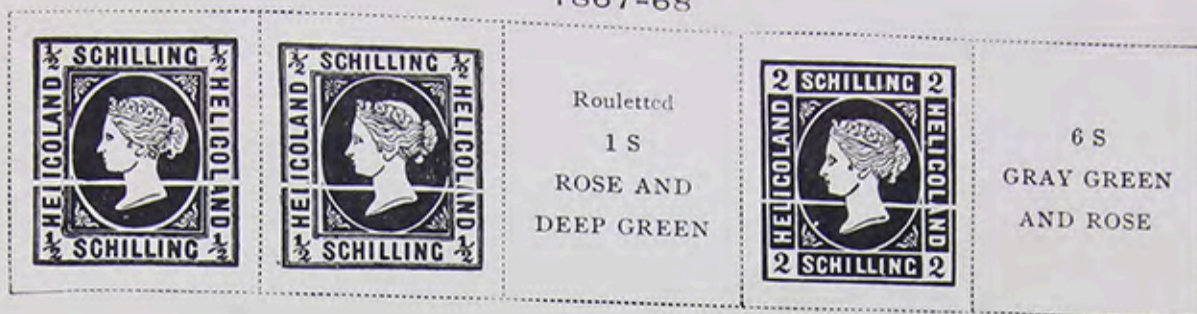

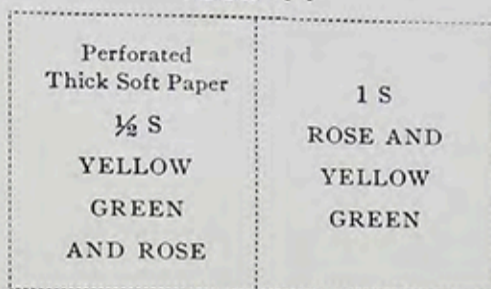
GOVERNMENT—A Danish possession ceded to the British in 1814. Until 1890 was a British colony. In that year it was formally ceded to Germany and since 1892 has formed a part of the Prussian province of Schleswig-Holstein. German stamps superseded those of Heligoland in 1890.

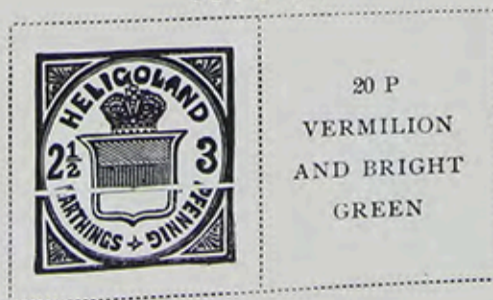

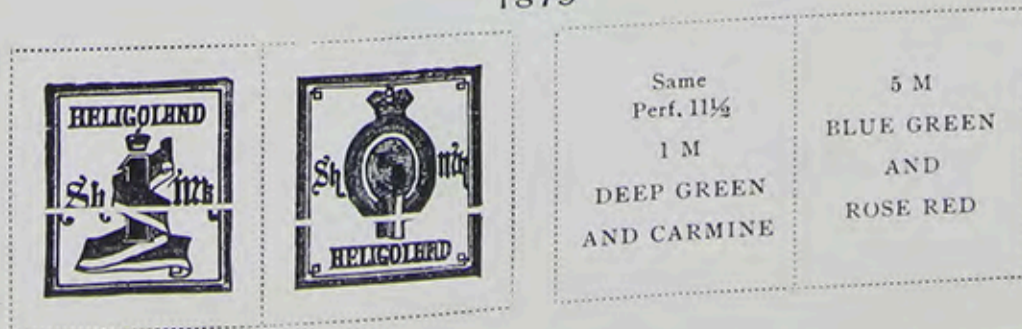

KIAUCHAU

GOVERNMENT—KIAUCHAU—Kiauchau Bay, a large inlet on the south side of the promontory of Shantung in China, was seized in 1897 by the German fleet, nominally to secure reparation for the murder of two German missionaries. In the negotiations that followed it was arranged that the bay and the land on both sides should be leased to Germany for 99 years. During the lease Germany was to exercise all rights of territorial sovereignty. In 1914 Kiauchow was occupied by Japan but in very recent negotiations it has once again reverted to its original country, China.

The United States portion of the group, with an area of about 95 square miles, is important principally as a naval base.

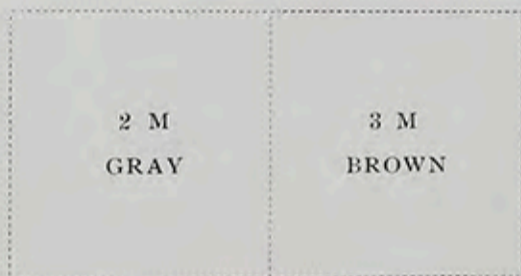
