

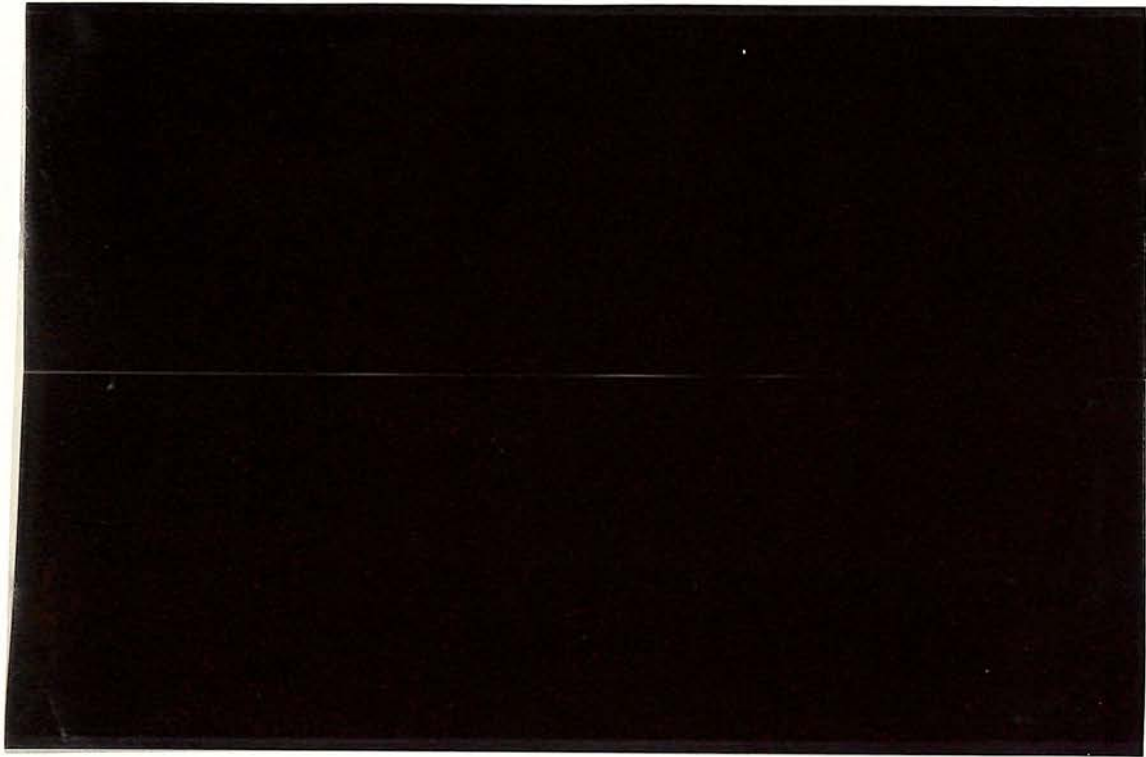

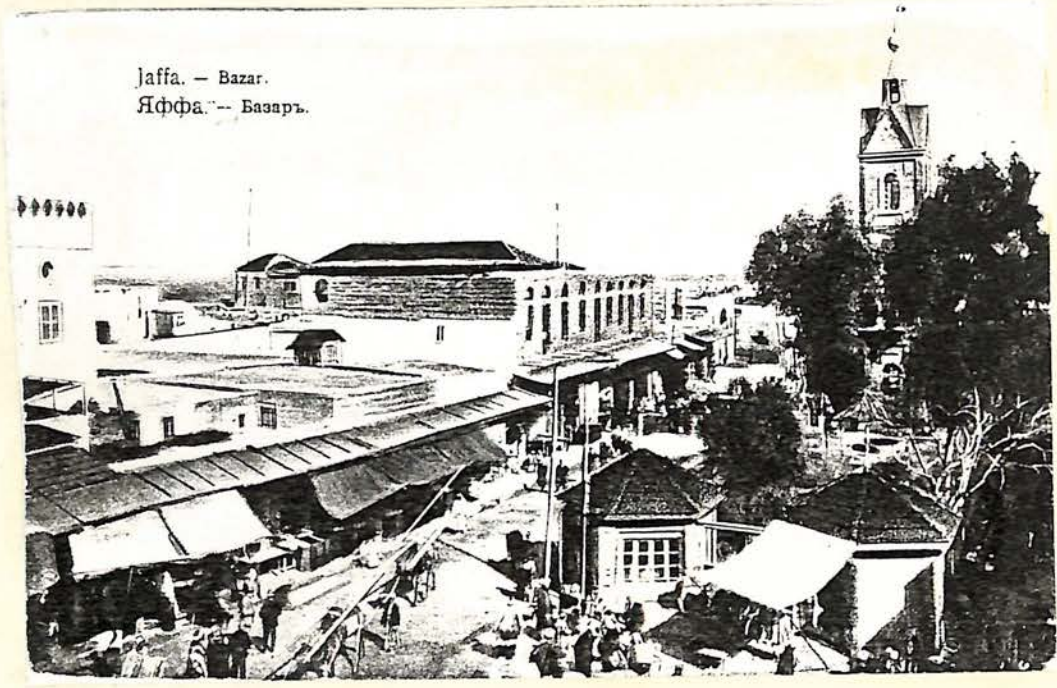

Envelope dated 23 April 1914 mailed from Jaffa and destined for Viron, France. Franked with a French Levant 25 centime and overprinted with 1 Piaster, is postmarked with dotted single ring date stamp in violet (Bale #315) x2. The receiver postmark is on the reverse dated 30 April 1914.

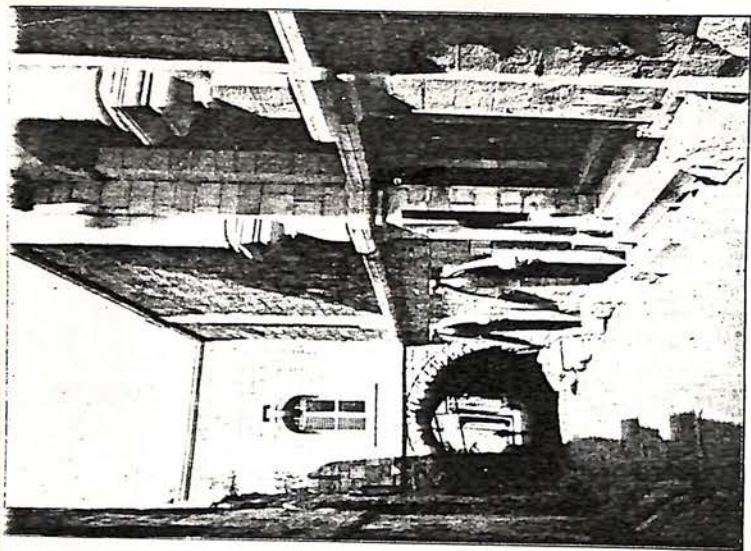

Picture post card mailed from Jerusalem to Munich, Germany post marked 18 March 1910; it is franked with three 1900 French Levant "blanc" stamps 2 Centimes, 3 Centimes and 5 Centimes. The stamps are postmarked with Bale #312 and the arrival postmark is dated 27 March 1910

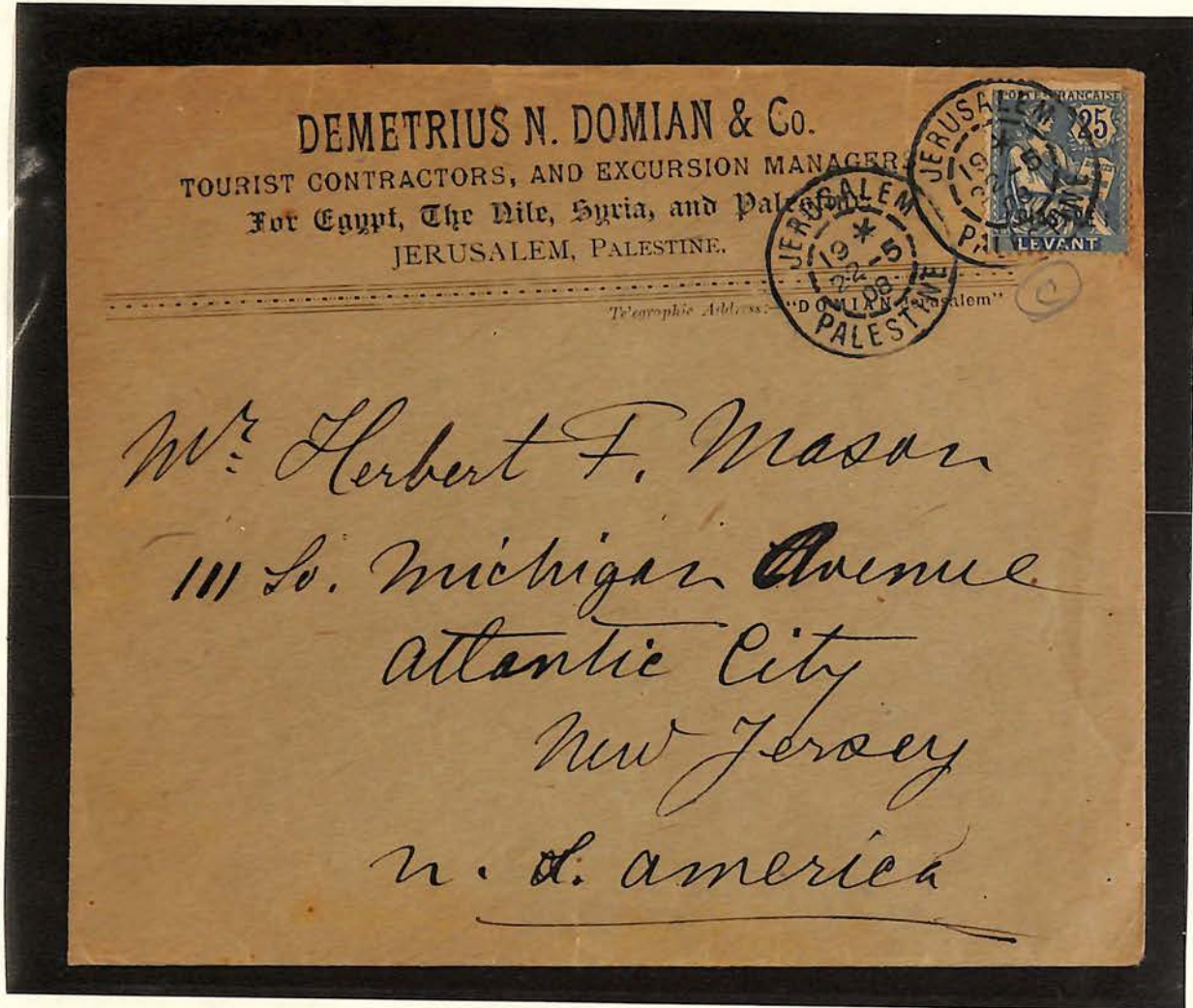

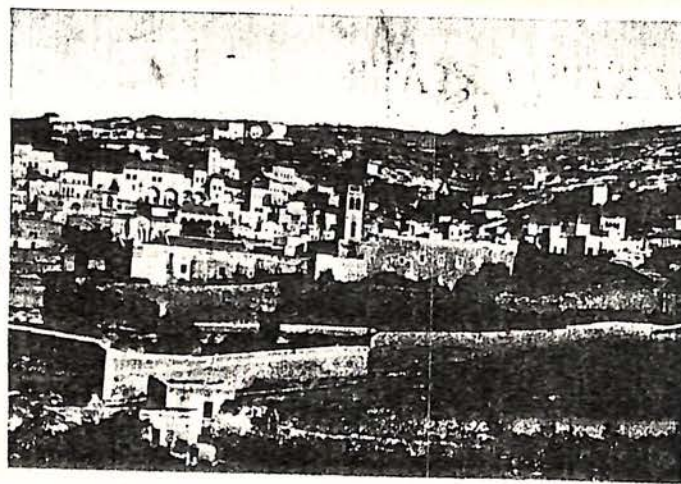
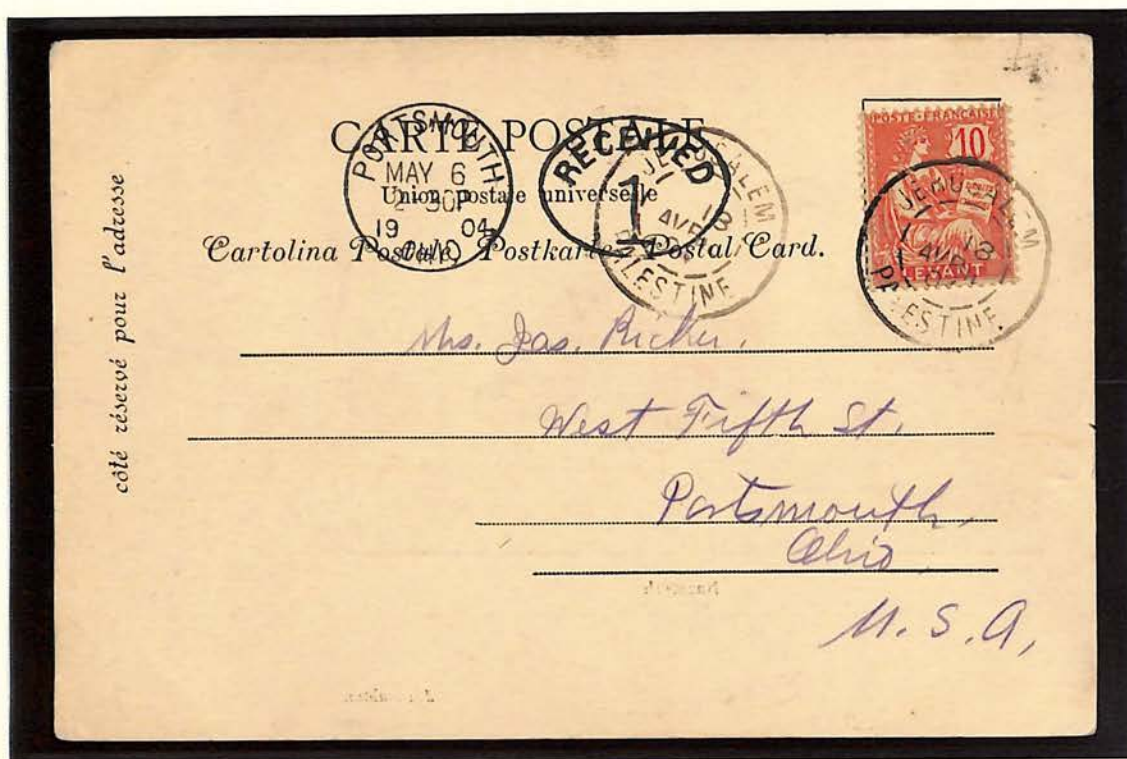
