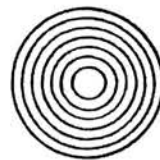

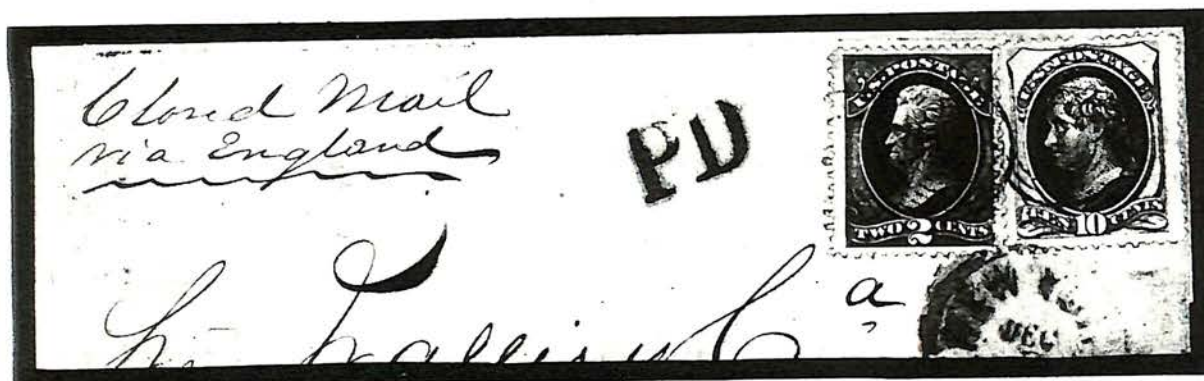

No proof has ever existed, in my mind, to justify the listing of TR-T-U1 as an NYFM, but previous students, perhaps based on the resemblance to TR-T2, felt it was, so we will continue listing it as an unproven type. To identify these two correctly, first count the rings. Both have seven, then check the diameter measurements as stated above. Be careful, as similar targets exist, although we have never seen any that conform exactly to TR-T2 both in rings and diameter.

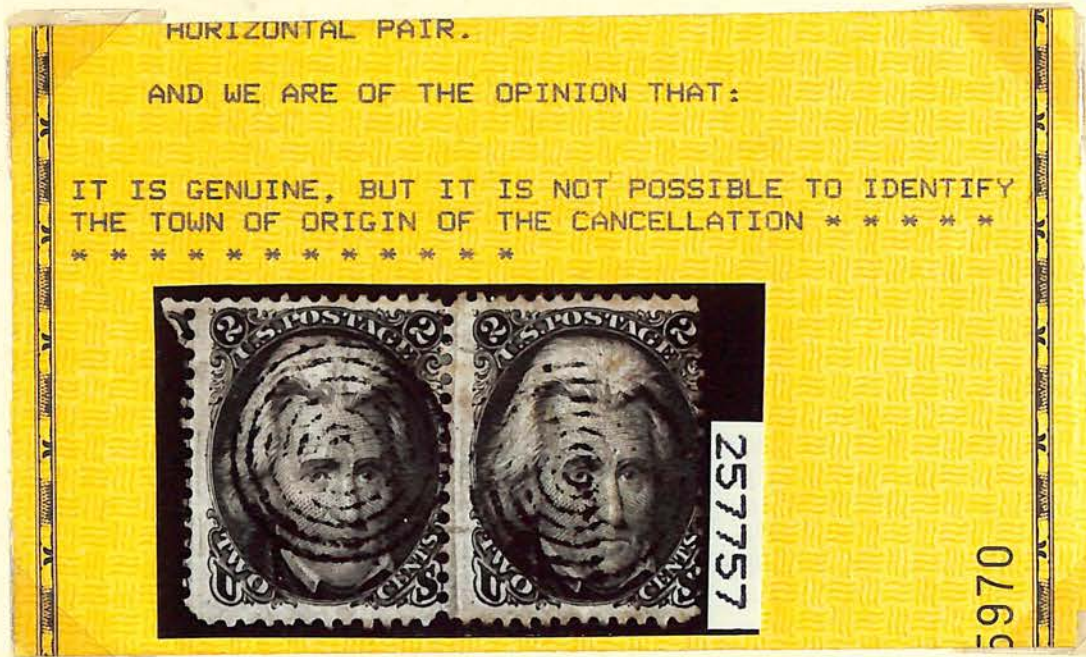
The 1874 date was noted by VW for the piece above, but be aware that it may just as well be 1873, for the 12¢ closed mail rate was in effect from 8/72; however, since the stamps are Continental an 1872 use is precluded.

Shown in *Figure 113A* is a used copy of the 16c Snuff Revenue Stamp, Series of 1875, on which is reproduced nearly the entire Dodge Painting. This was the last use of the Jackson likeness by Dodge on any kind of stamp, and was produced to pay the required tax on a pound of snuff. The stamp is handsomely engraved with much fine lathe work and is printed in black on green paper. It measures 35 x 300 millimeters, and was produced by the Continental Bank Note Company.
