NYC - FIRST IN THE USA!!!

ON MAY 6, 1840, AS GREAT BRITAIN ISSUED THE WORLD'S FIRST PREPAID ADHESIVE POSTAGE STAMPS, GOVERNMENTS AND POSTAL OFFICIALS WORLDWIDE WONDERED ABOUT COUNTERFEITING, AND THE PROGRAM'S ACCEPTANCE BY THE BRITISH PUBLIC. IN THE UNITED STATES, SEN. DANIEL WEBSTER OF MASSACHUSETTS PROPOSED IN 1840 A SIMILAR SYSTEM, AND CONGRESS ACCEDED SEVEN YEARS LATER.



IN THE MEANTIME, NEW YORK CITY POSTMASTER ROBERT H. MORRIS REQUESTED PERMISSION TO ISSUE THE NATION'S FIRST PROVISIONAL PREPAID STAMP. WITH MORRIS WILLING TO PAY FOR PRINTING AND HANDLING, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT APPROVED.



FEATURING A GILBERT STUART PORTRAIT OF GEORGE WASHINGTON AND PRINTED BY RAWDON, WRIGHT & HATCH, THE 5¢ BLACK STAMP WENT ON SALE IN 1845 FOR THE PUBLIC'S USE IN MAILING LETTERS AT POST OFFICES AND AREA MAILBOXES.



AS THE STAMPS BECAME POPULAR, MORRIS, WORRIED ABOUT FORGERIES, AUTHORIZED CLERKS TO INITIAL THE STAMPS FOR SECURITY PURPOSES WITH "ACM" FOR HIS BROTHER-IN-LAW, ALONZO CASTLE MONSON, AND "MMJR" FOR HIS SIBLING, MARCENA MONSON JR.



A COVER ADDRESSED TO OGDENSBURG, N.Y., BEARING A BLOCK OF NINE AND A STRIP OF THREE WAS DISCOVERED IN 1952 AND SOLD THAT YEAR AT AUCTION BY HARMER, ROOKE AND CO., FOR \$3,750 TO AN AGENT FOR RAYMOND H. WEILL CO.

OF THE 143,600 PROVISIONALS (3,590 SHEETS OF 40) DELIVERED TO THE NEW YORK POST OFFICE, IT IS ESTIMATED THAT 5,500 EXAMPLES SURVIVED, INCLUDING 500 UNCANCELLED, WITH MOST STAMPS BEARING THE INITIALS "ACM." THOSE WITH "MMJR" AND THE FEW SIGNED "RHM" BY MORRIS HIMSELF COMMAND HIGHER PRICES. THE 2011 SCOTT U.S. SPECIALIZED CATALOG VALUES SCOTT 9X1d — SIGNED RHM — UNUSED AT \$13,000, USED AT \$3,500, AND ON COVER FROM \$5,500 TO \$12,500.
