NEW SOUTH WALES



GOVERNMENT—A state of the Australian Commonwealth. Established as a penal settlement in 1788; was transformed into a colony between 1809-1820. At the time of settlement New South Wales comprised the entire continent of Australia. In 1825 Van Dieman's Land was a separate colony, followed in 1829 by West Australia, in 1836 by South Australia and in 1839 by New Zealand. In 1901 New South Wales came a part of the the Australian Commonwealth. CAPITAL—Sydney.
