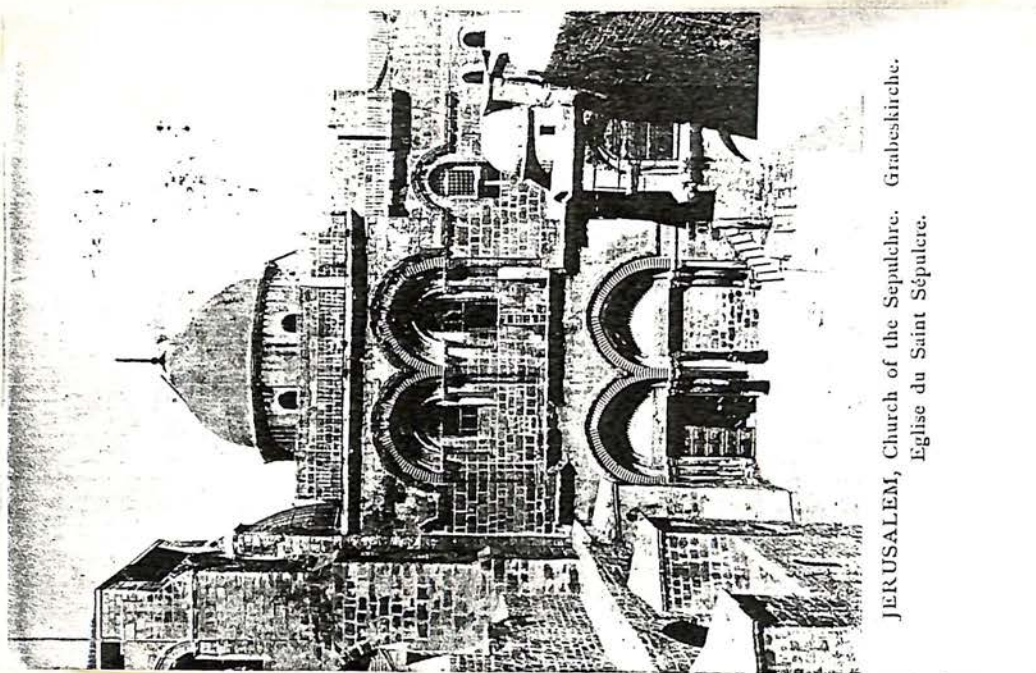
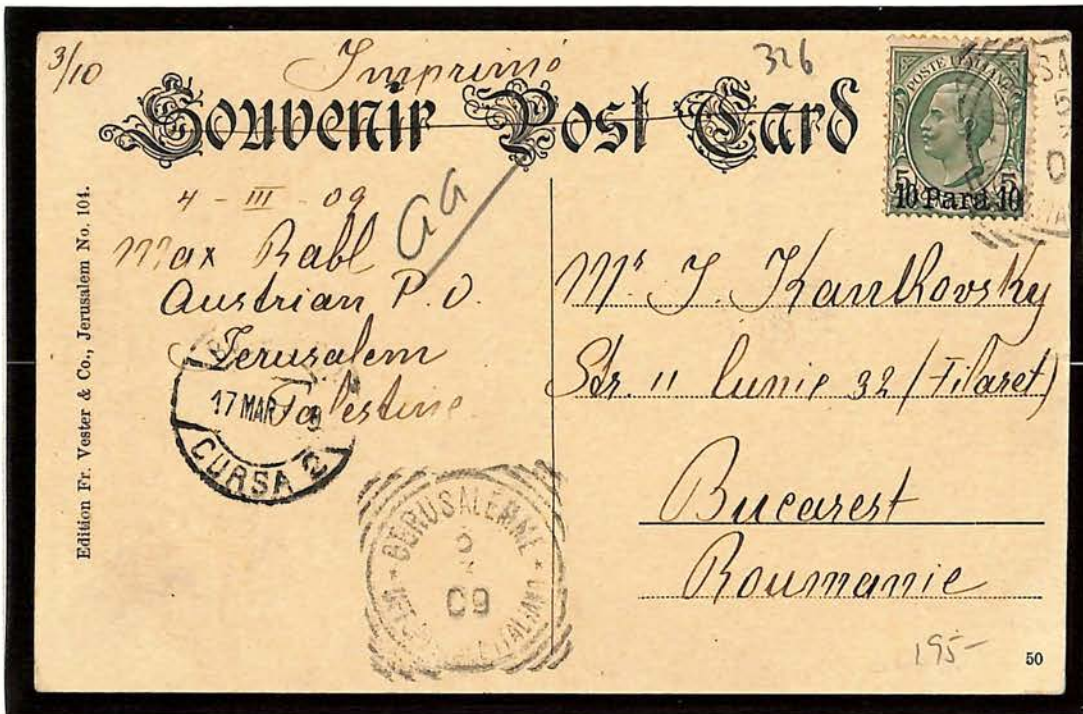
Picture postcard dated 17 December 1900 mailed from Jerusalem to Ascoli Piceno, Italy and franked with a 10 Centesimi Victor Emanuel III stamp overprinted 20 Para – Scott #2. The card is postmarked with Steichele #402. The arrival postmark is dated 23 Dec 08.

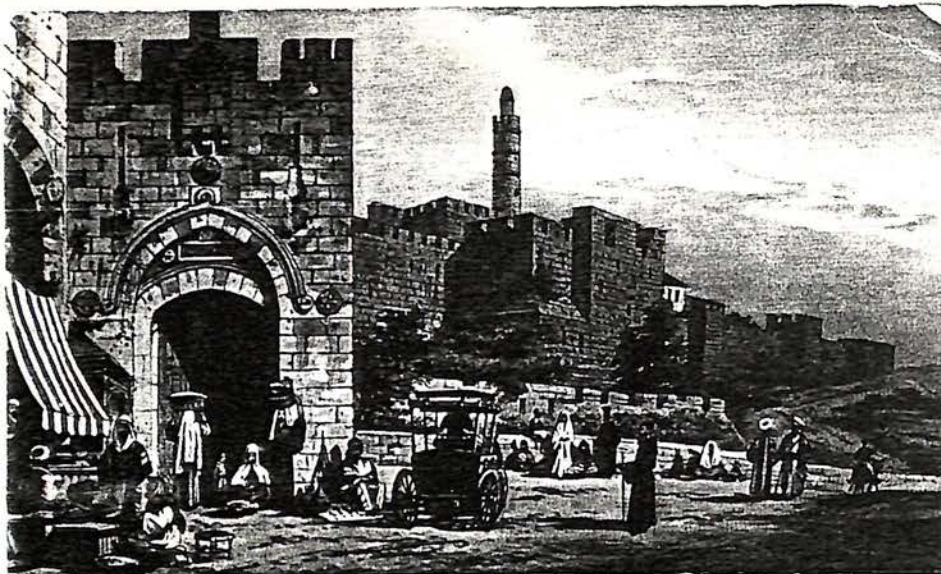

Postal card with color photo dated 16 April 1913 and mailed from Jerusalem destined for Stockholm, Sweden. The card is franked with 20 Centesimi Italian Victor Emanuel III overprinted Gerusalemme 20 Para and postmarked with Collins #401. The receiver postmark is dated 27 April 1913.

Postcard dated 23 April 1913 mailed from Jerusalem to Germany – with the Victor Emanuel III 10 Centesimi impression overprinted 20 Para 20 – is postmarked with Steichele #401. There is no arrival marking.

Envelope mailed from Berlin to Jerusalem addressed to Dr. Wallach was postmarked 2 August 1914, postmarked with a 5-pfenige stamp. (the correct rate for printed matter) and was received by the Italian post office on 3 September 1914. It is postmarked with Bale #501; Collins #402.
