Hejaz-Jiddah Provisionals

Jan. 1925 First Jiddah Provisionals 2 line Overprint
 Issued under siege. In October 1924, the Hashemite govt.
 retreated to Jiddah. King Hussain abdicated and King Ali
 ascended the Throne on October 4, 1924. Hejaz stamps were
 hastily overprinted to distinguish them from stamps which
 might have fallen into the hands of the advancing Nejd's
 under King Abdal Aziz of the Nejd.

1925, July 1 Commemoration of First Pilgrimage to Mecca under King Abdul Aziz. Mecca had been captured in December, 1924. Abdul Aziz' sovereignty was assured by his Sponsorship of the Hajj.
