**THE ATOMIC BOMB**



THE MOST POWERFUL WEAPON OF WAR EVER DEvised BY MAN - THE ATOMIC BOMB WAS FIRST USED ON THE CITY OF HIROSHIMA, JAPAN, DROPPED BY A B-29 OF THE U.S.A.A.F. AUG. 5, 1945 (FIRST OFFICIALLY REPORTED AUG. 6th) ONE BOMB OBLITERATED THREE-FIFTHS OF THE CITY AND REPORTERLY KILLED 100,000 BY CONCUSSION, FIRE AND THE AFTER EFFECTS OF THE ATOMIC DISINTEGRATION.
