THE CYPRUS 20m. PROVISIONAL IN TWO SHADES

The Cyprus 20m. surcharge, released on September 24th last, has appeared with a background in two distinct shades, the original brown and a strikingly lighter shade of brown. A close examination of the two shades has revealed that the basic stamp has been printed on two kinds of paper, the original shade on "wove" and the lighter shade on "laid" paper. A difference in the position of the watermark is also evident: the stamp with the original shade shows the map of Cyprus pointing upwards, whereas the one with the lighter shade has the map pointing downwards.

In view of the fact that the same variations have been detected on the unsurcharged 15m. stamps as well, it may be safely inferred that there were two separate printings of the basic stamp, hitherto unknown.—T. J. Fitikides.

CYPRUS RELIEF FUND SURCHARGES

With a view to reinforcing the Displaced Persons Relief Fund, the Cypriot Council of Ministers has approved the imposition of 10 mils on every postal item which is not duty-free. For this purpose the 5 mils definitive stamp is to be surcharged 10 mils and overprinted "Refugee Fund" in English, Greek and Turkish. Release date for the surcharged stamp was October 1st.

Approval has also been given for the overprinting of four values of the 1971 definitive issue—10, 40, 50 and 250 mils—on the occasion of the U.N. Security Council Resolution 353 on Cyprus, adopted on July 20th, 1974. Date of issue will be October 14th.

The overprints in both cases will be made at the Government Printing Press of the Republic of Cyprus in Nicosia.

The above issues are supplementary to those already assigned for the current year. T. J. FITIKIDES.
