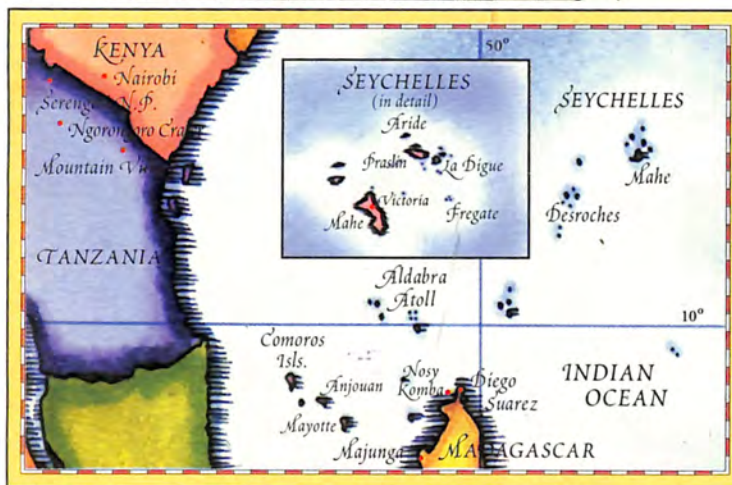
SEYCHELLES RURAL POSTS ISSUE, 1976
 SIR,—I received recently the Rural Posts set on cover direct from the G.P.O. Seychelles at Victoria. On looking closely at the R1 value, which shows the Northern half of Mahé, I was amazed to see that the designation of Victoria, Cascade and Bel Ombre are wrong! In saying this I might add that I have visited the island and, as I write, I also have before me a large scale map. I have personally visited all the places several times.

On the stamp map Bel Ombre is shown where Victoria is, Victoria in place of Cascade, and Cascade not marked at all. In fact, Bel Ombre is on the north-west corner adjoining Beau Vallon beach, a stretch of beach which must knock anything in Hawaii into a cocked hat!

It is amazing that this error went apparently unnoticed. On the 65c. value showing La Digue, the main community is shown as being at almost the southern extremity, whereas it is on the northern half of the west coast, with the Post Office at La Passe about a mile south of the most northerly point. This, however, is not very serious, whereas the titles on the Mahé map are actually wrong.
