

INDIA

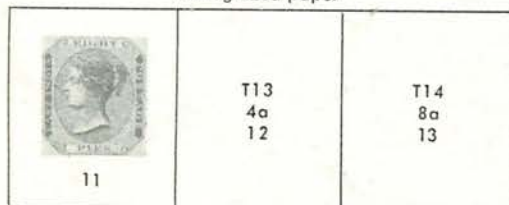
A subcontinent projecting from the mainland of Asia. Administered by the East India Company until 1858 when authority was transferred to the Crown. Empire from 1882 until 1947 when divided into the Dominions of India (Hindu) and Pakistan (Moslem). The Dominion of India became a self-governing republic within the British Commonwealth in 1950. Area 1,221,000 sq. mi.; pop.: about 357,000,000; cap.: New Delhi (277,000). Currency 12 Pies=1 Anna, 16 Annas=1 Rupee; 1957: 100 Naye paise=1 Rupee.
