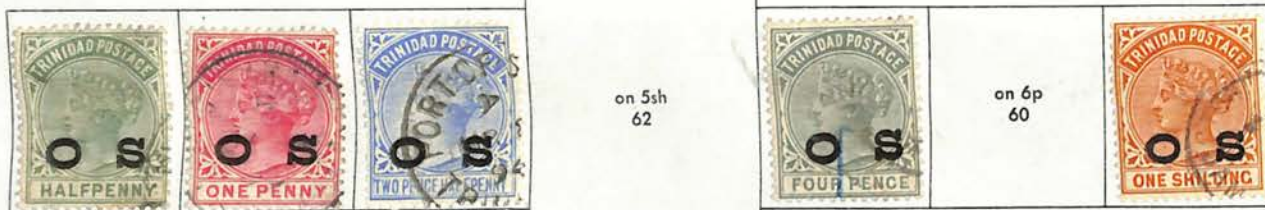



## TRINIDAD, 1852.

I have examined the postage stamp issued by the Colonial Administration of Trinidad in September of 1852, "**Britannia**" undenominated (one penny) blue, lithographed, imperforate, on medium white wove paper with vertical mesh, without watermark, of average thickness 0.105 mm., Scott Catalogue #9b; Stanley Gibbons #13, used, with the barred oval numeral cancellation "1" which corresponds to Port of Spain, a colour reproduction of which is below, magnified to 125% of true size, and am of the opinion that:

The stamp is **genuine**, postally used, with three good margins, just touching the design at the lower-right corner, and with a small thin spot.







