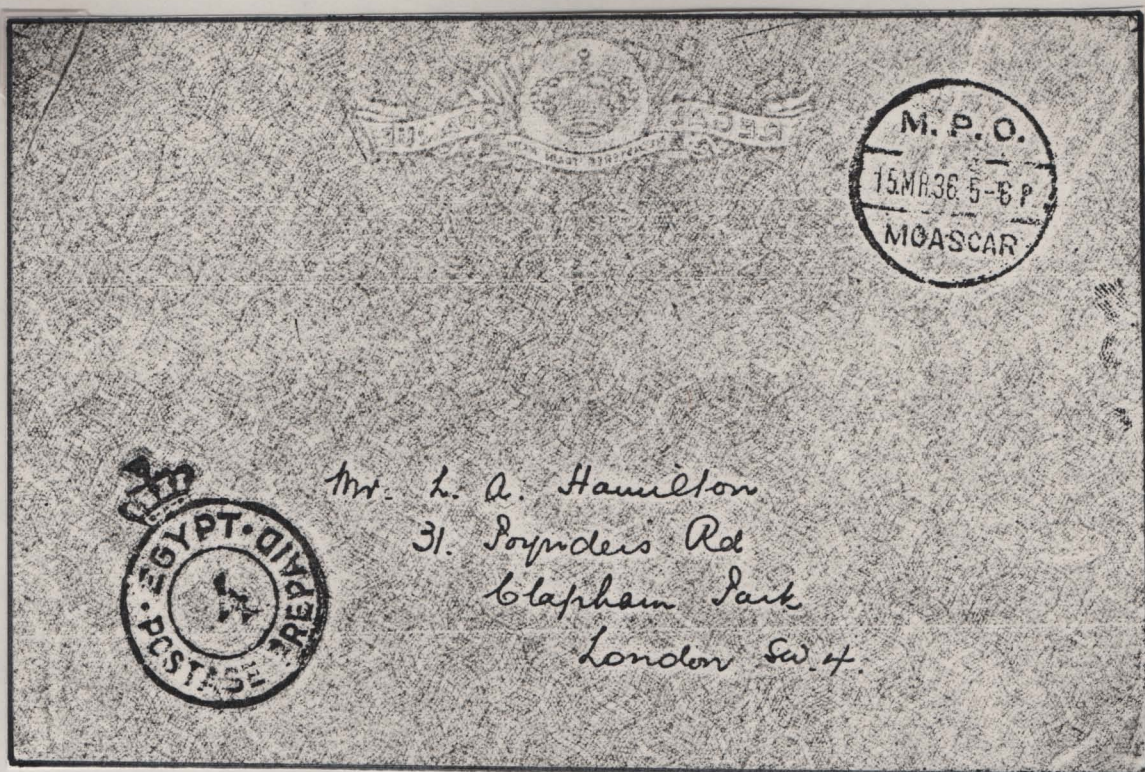
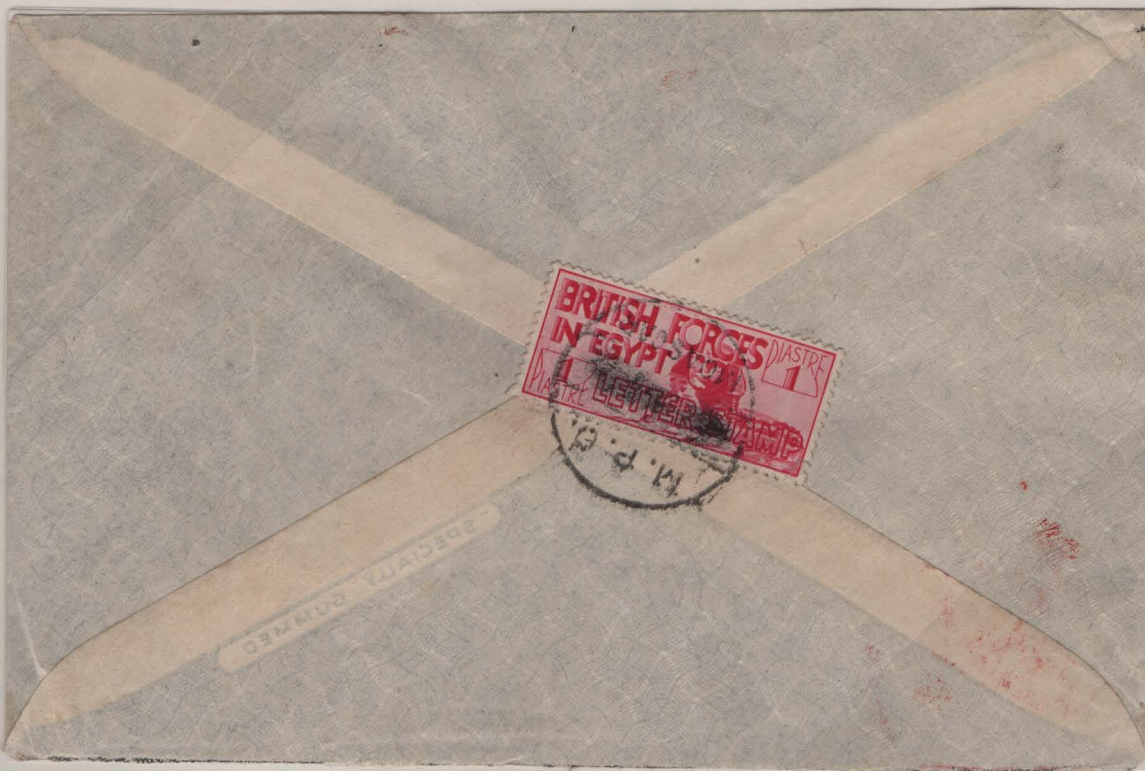
Very seldom seen strike of London NAAFI Store receiving mark dated December 30, 1935.

On front, red Numeral 13 frank and black Alexandria military post office cancellation of December 22, 1935.

Cover shows complete postal history of eight days for cover to go from Egypt to England, unusual to have such detailed documentation.



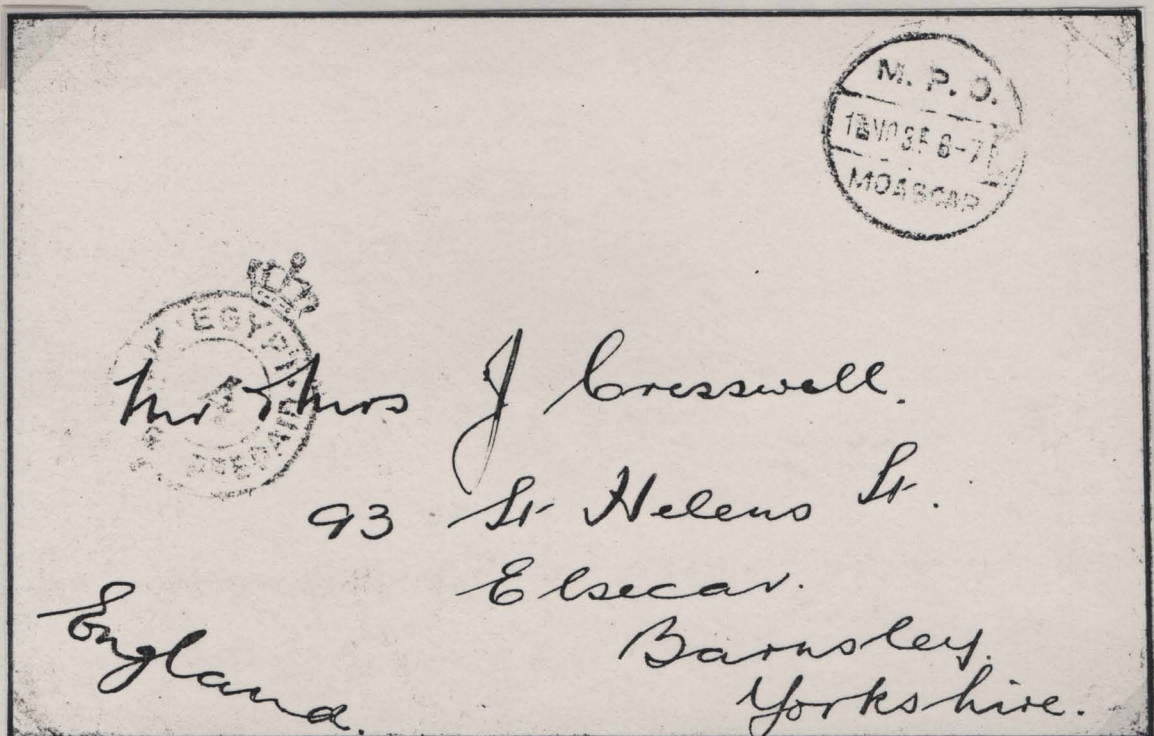
Last Day Cover And Irregular Compliance

Use of Moascar military post office cancellation to cancel adhesive rather than retta. On front, red Numeral 4 frank and black Moascar military post office cancellation of March 15, 1936, final day of concession.

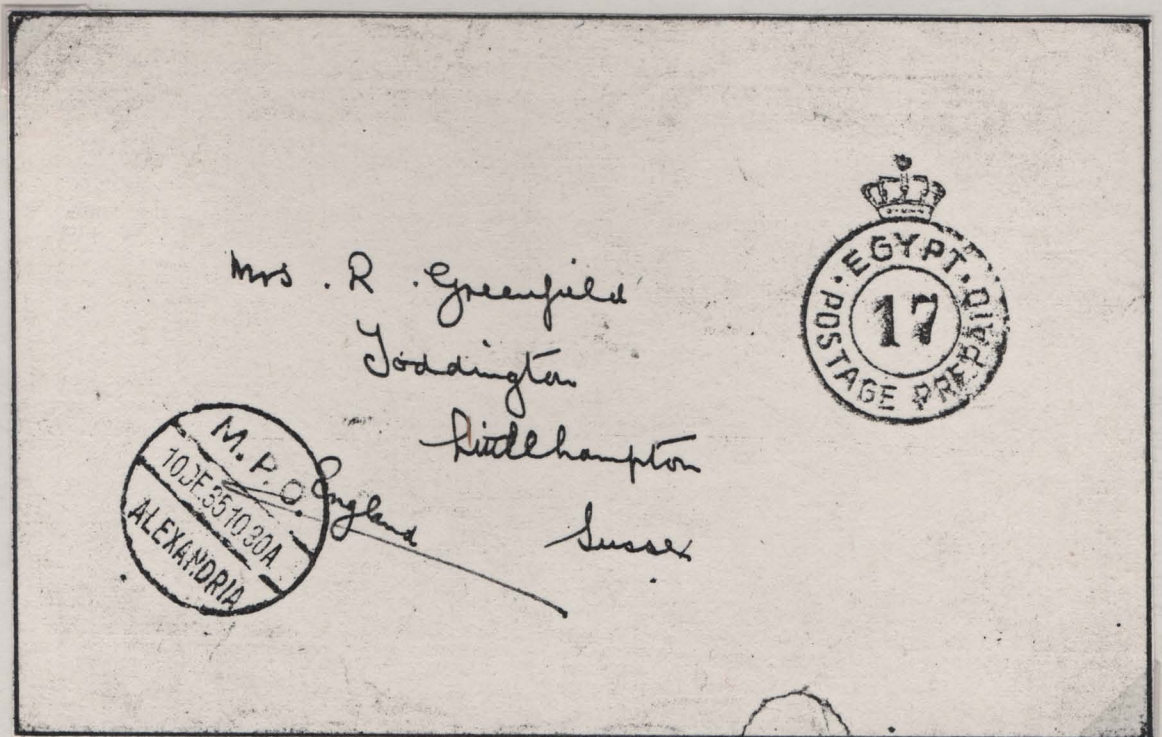

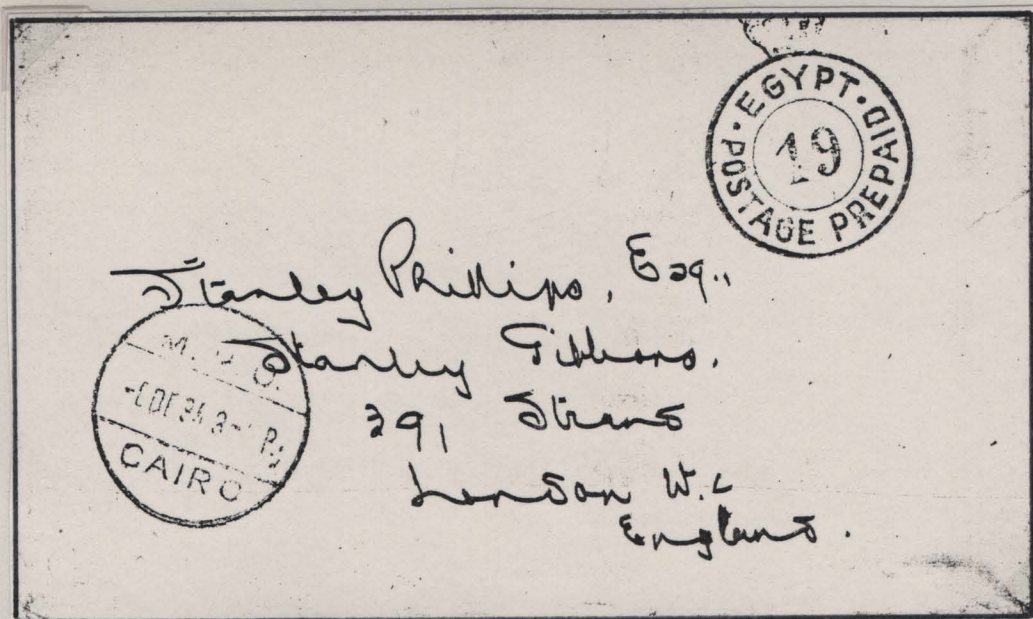

Of Military Mail System

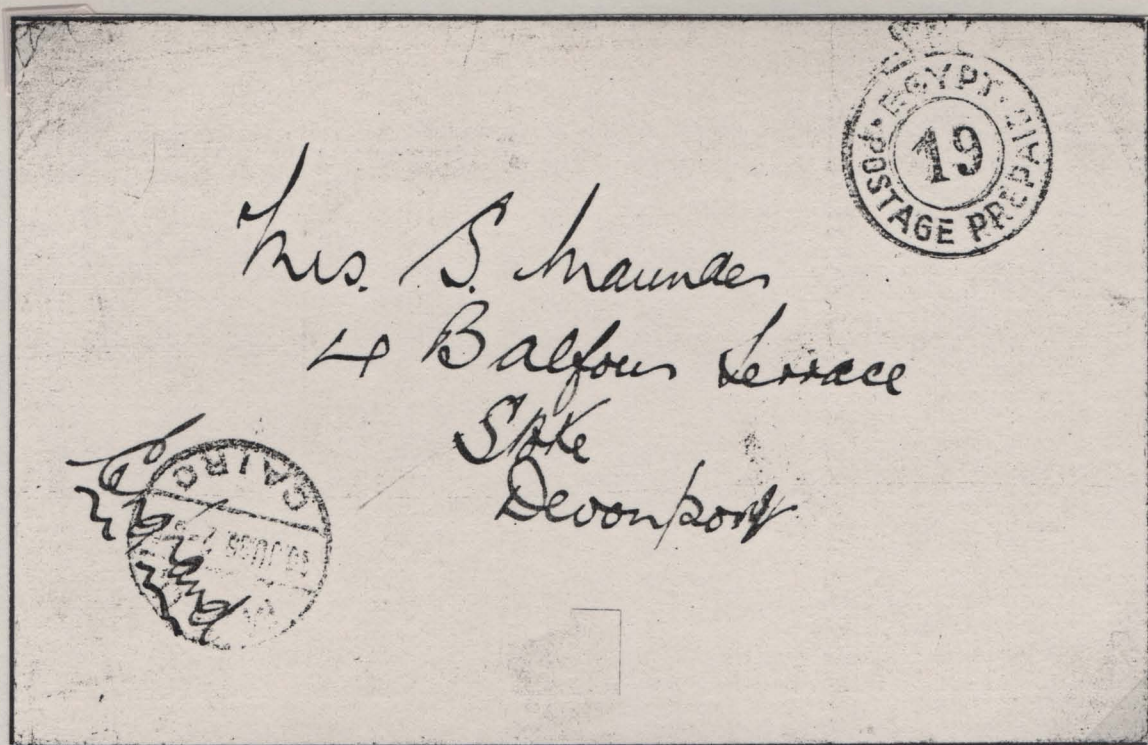


Black retta. On front, red Numeral 19 frank  
and black strike of July 10, 1935.

The violet oval DADOS mark is a despatching cachet commonly used by British official agencies during this period. The presence of that marking on this cover would indicate that the contents of the envelope justified use of military postal system.

Departure From Regulations Of Concession



Correct franking and application of markings; however, adhesive and retta applied to front, not back.

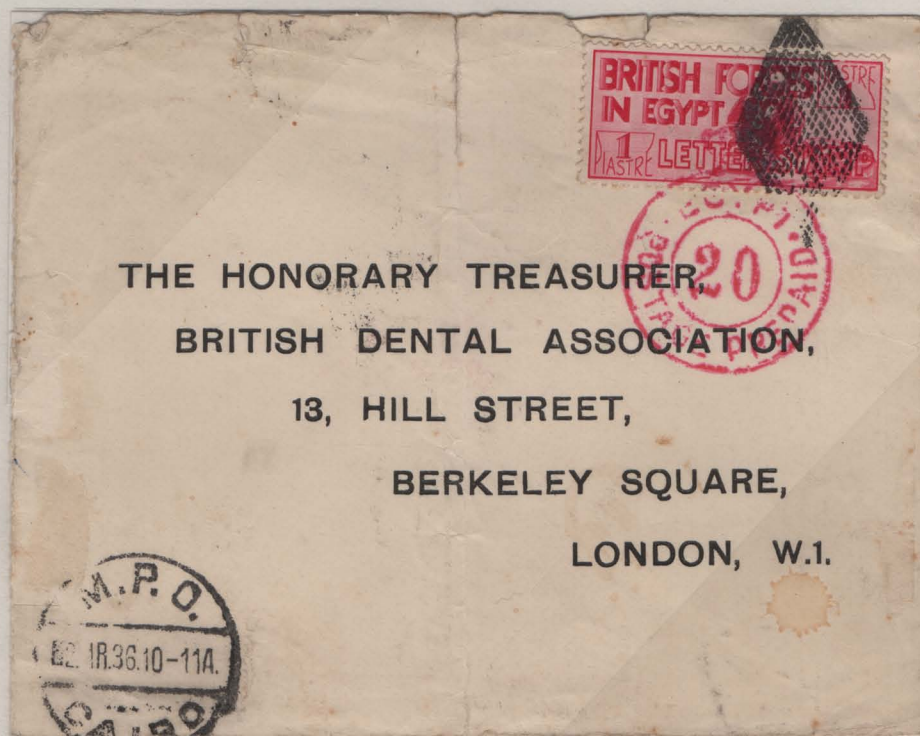

On front, red strike of Numeral 19 frank and black strike of straight-line Cairo military post office cancellation dated September 26, 1935.



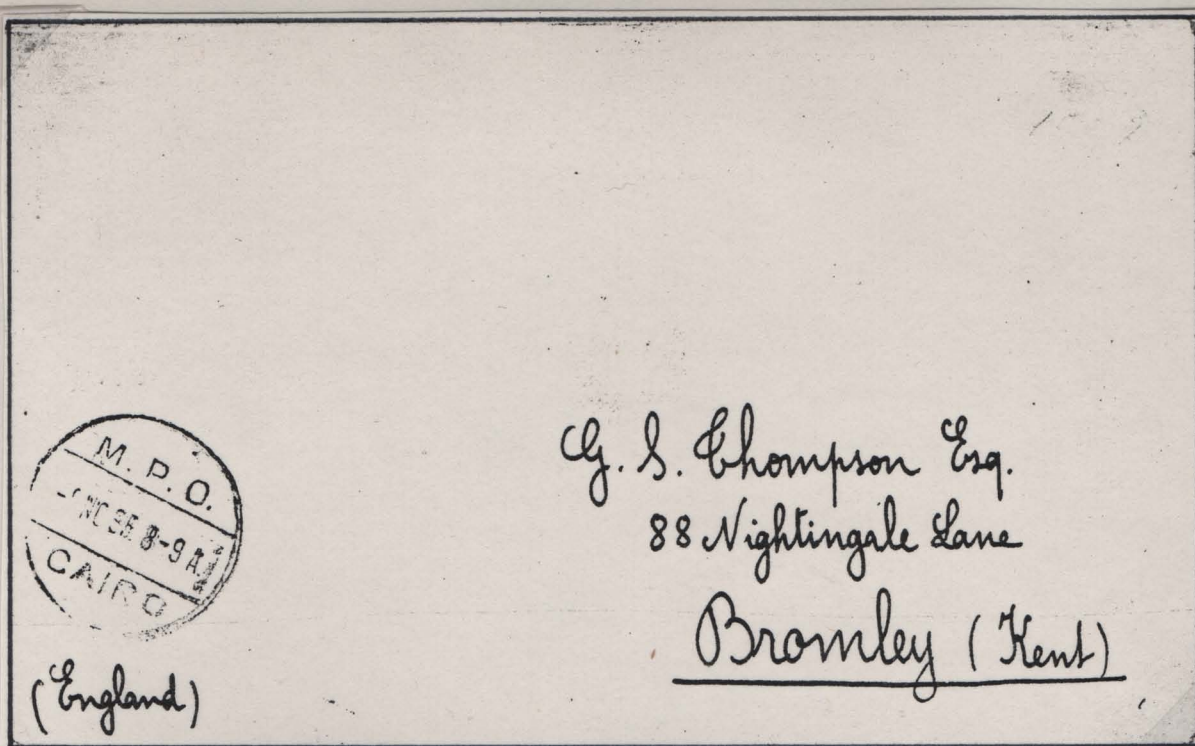
Departure From Regulations of Concession



Correct franking and markings but adhesive should have been applied to back of cover, not front. Numeral 11 frank and curved Cairo military post office cancellation dated March 2, 1936, a late usage in fact.



Absence of Numeral Frank



Black retta.

On front, straight-line Cairo military post office  
cancellation dated November 9, 1935.

The missing Numeral frank could have been any one  
of 1, 2, 5, 6, 8, 20, 21, 22, 24, and 25, all of  
which were in use at Cairo on the date mentioned.
