THE ROYAL VISIT ISSUE OF 1939 SCOTT 246-248

ON THE 15TH OF MAY 1939 ON THE OCCASION OF THE ROYAL VISIT OF KING GEORGE VI AND QUEEN ELISABETH TO CANADA THREE BI-COLOURED STAMPS WERE RELEASED.

THESE WERE THE FIRST STAMPS OF MORE THAN ONE COLOR PRODUCED BY CANADA SINCE THE MAP STAMP OF 1898. IN EACH CASE THE CENTRE PORTION OF THE STAMP WAS BLACK AND THE FRAME AREA WAS THE USUAL COLOR FOR STAMPS OF THE VALUE USED: 1 CENT GREEN, 2 CENT BROWN AND 3 CENT CARMINE.

THE STAMPS HAD TO BE RUN THROUGH THE PRESSES TWICE. THEY WERE PRINTED FROM HARDENED STEEL PLATES OF 200 SUBJECTS AND CUT INTO POST OFFICE PANES OF 50 STAMPS. THERE WERE 2 NUMBERS ON EACH PANE; ONE WAS IN COLOR AND WAS KNOWN AS THE DUTY PLATE AND THE OTHER, IN BLACK, WAS THE HEAD PLATE.

THE IMPRINT WAS CONFINED TO THE 4 CORNERS AND READ "CANADIAN BANK NOTE CO. OTTAWA NO. -" UPRIGHT ACROSS THE TOP AND BOTTOM WITH "NO. -" AND THE PRINTING ORDER NUMBERS READING UP APPEARING ON THE LEFT HAND PLATE POSITION.



THE USE OF DUTY AND HEAD PLATE NUMBERS AND THEIR MUTATIONS PROVIDES OPPORTUNITIES FOR PLATE BLOCK COLLECTORS. THE 2 CENT VALUE IS THE SIMPLEST ONE OF THE SET WITH DUTY PLATE NUMBERS 1, 2 AND 3 EACH USING HEAD PLATE NUMBERS 1 AND 2. THUS THERE ARE 6 POSSIBLE PLATE POSITIONS IN EACH CORNER OF A SHEET, FOR A TOTAL OF 24. THE 1 CENT VALUE HAS A TOTAL OF 72 PLATE POSITIONS, AND THE 3 CENT VALUE HAS 80 POSSIBLE POSITIONS. SOME OF THE PLATE BLOCKS ARE QUITE RARE.
