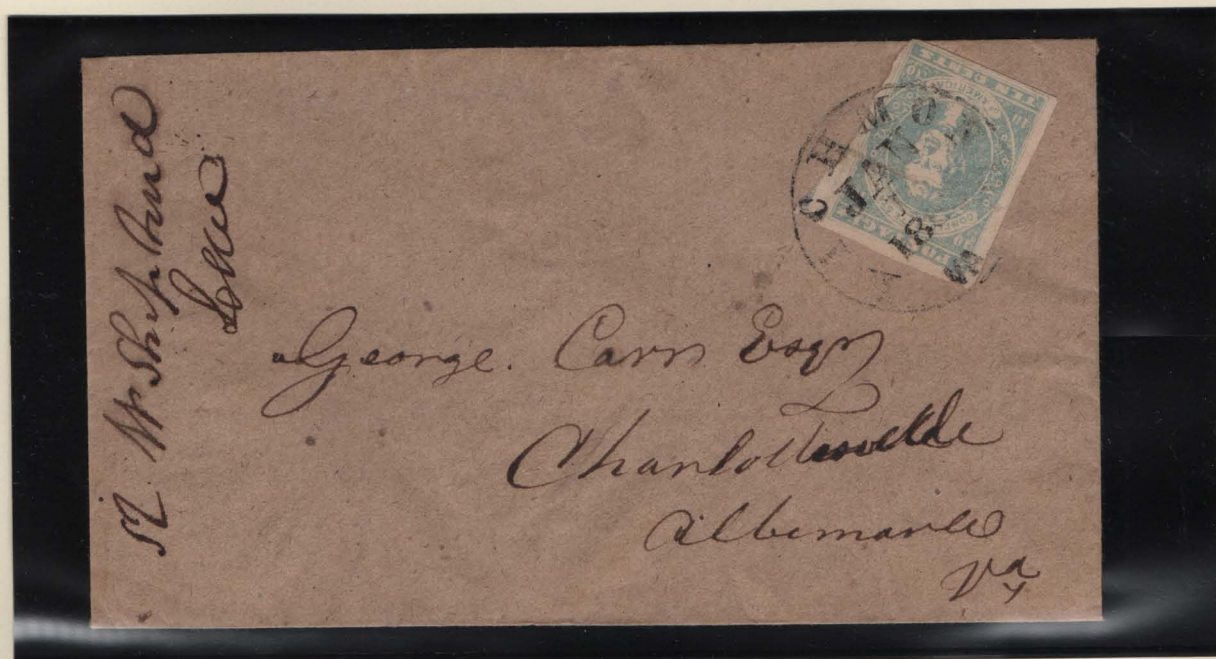


C.S.A. # 2 ON COVER

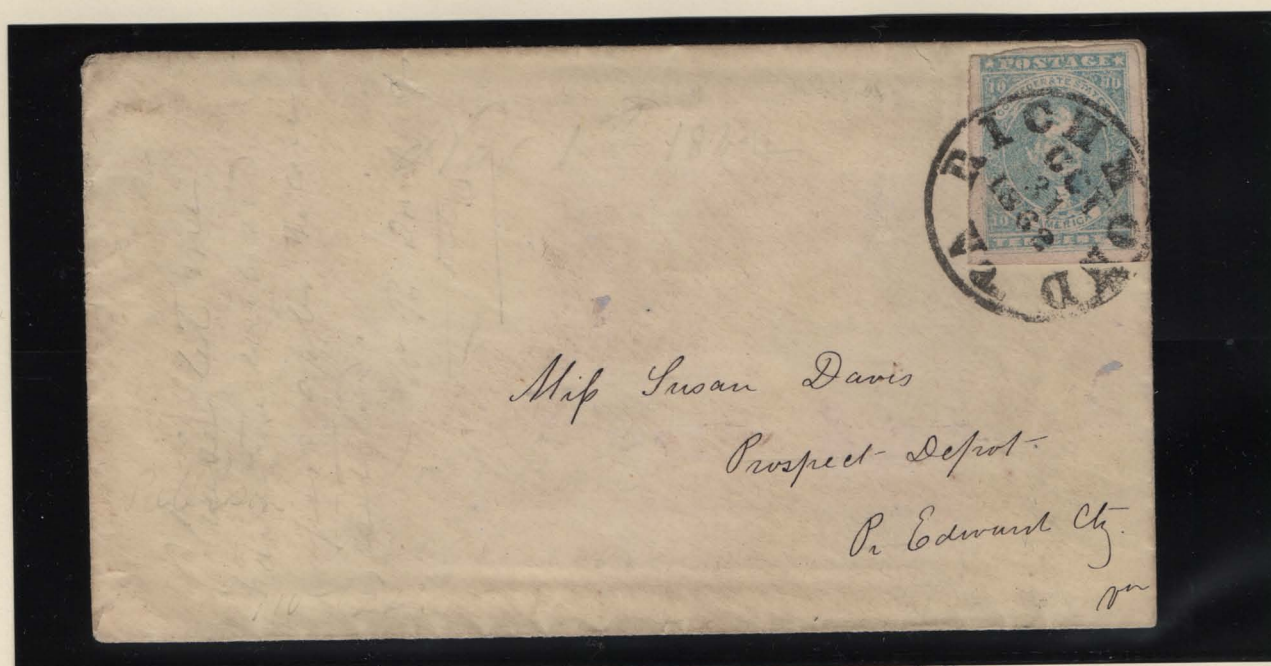

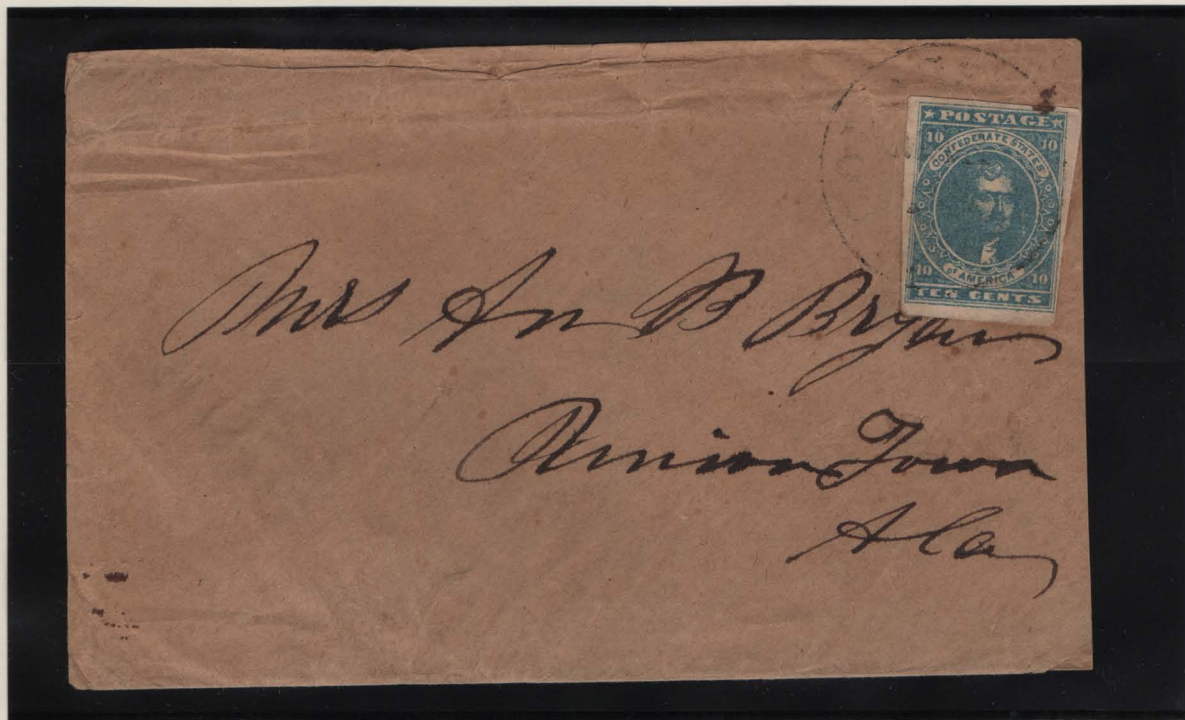

THE ENVELOPE IS OF A
QUALITY OF MANUFACTURE NOT
OFTEN SEEN ON CONFEDERATE
COVERS. NOTE THE DIAGONAL

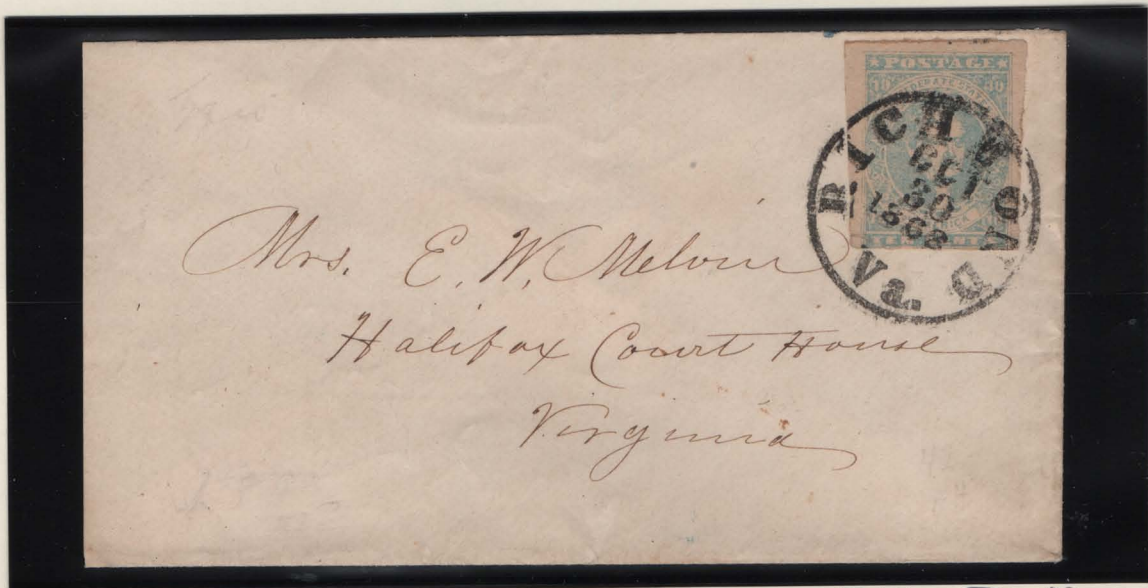

A LOVELY STRIKE OF THE RICHMOND TYPE III (DET2 P211) CANCEL TIES THIS STONE "4" TO AN EXCEPTIONALLY CLEAN COVER TO HALIFAX COURT HOUSE, VIRGINIA.
