This booklet was issued in March 1921. It contained five different booklet panes with advertising sheet interleaving. The booklet sold for eight marks. It contained ten 40 pfennig, ten 30 pfennig, and ten 10 pfennig germania stamps.



This booklet pane contains six 40 pfennig Michel #145 germania stamps.

This booklet pane contains four 40 pfennig, Michel #145 germania stamps and two 30 pfennig, Michel #144 germania stamps. Vertical and horizontal combinations of the two stamps are possible from this pane.



This booklet pane contains six 30 pfennig Michel #144 germania stamps.



This booklet pane contains four 10 pfennig Michel #141 germania stamps and two 30 pfennig Michel #144 germania stamps. Vertical and horizontal combinations of the two stamps are possible from this pane.



This booklet pane contains six 10 pfennig Michel #141 germania stamps. The selvedge of this pane includes the plate number H 7592.20.

### Combinations

These combinations of Michel # #144 and 145 show the right margin of the sheet that was used to make booklet pane H-Blatt 31. The sheet was 10 fields high by 21 fields wide for a total of 210 fields. The full sheet consisted of three panes of 60 stamps and 10 blank fields. The large sheet could be split into three counter panes with a column of blank fields on the left side. The blank fields allowed for the sheet to be split into booklet panes with the blank fields making up the left side of each pane that was stapled into the booklet. Each counter pane contained 10 booklet panes for a total of 30 booklet panes in the full sheet. Each counter sheet included tete-beche and vertical and horizontal varieties. These stamps are "flipped over" for display. They would actually appear upside down at the right side of the sheet.

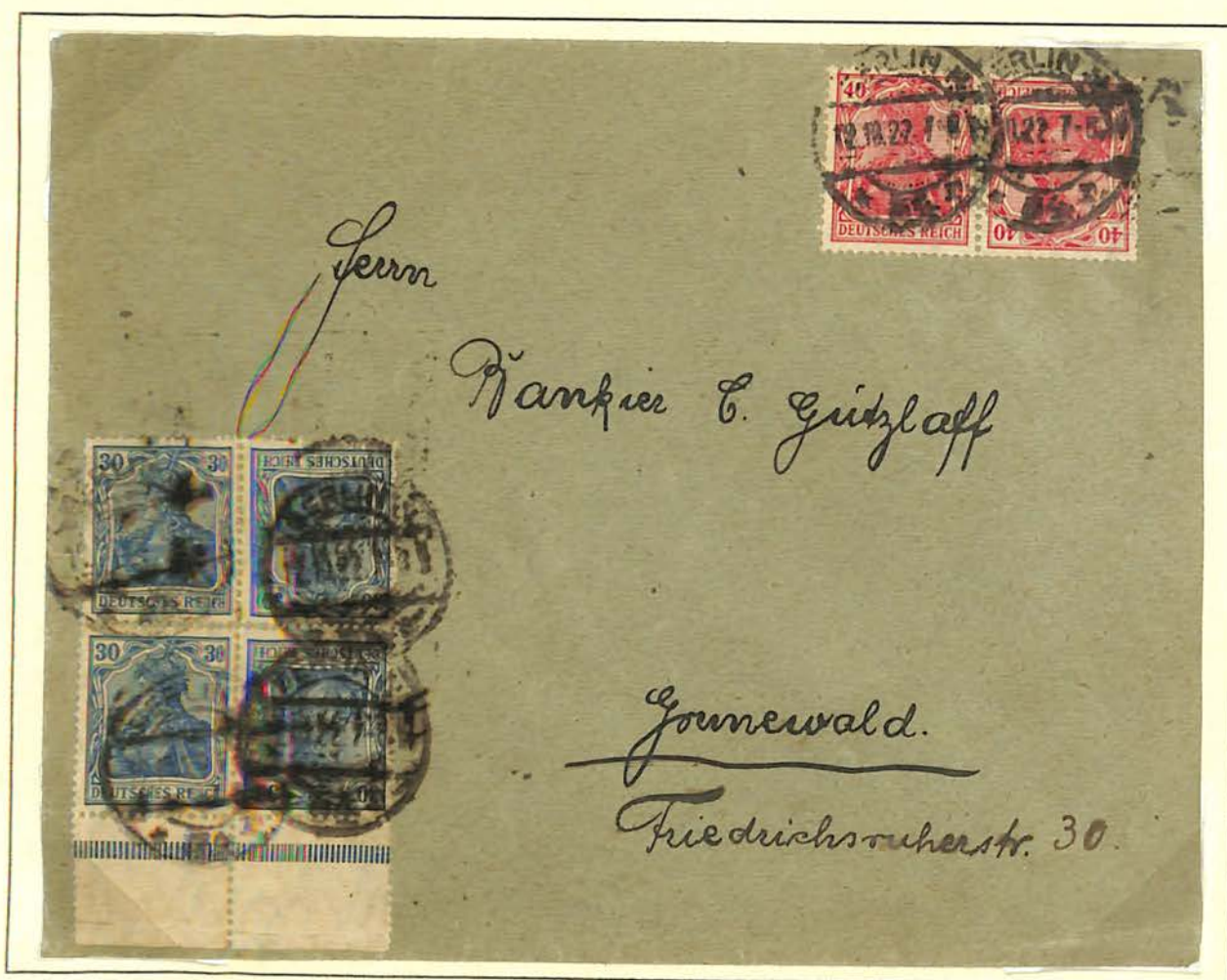
The panes for this booklet were cut from sheets of 180 stamps plus tabs. Each sheet was cut into 30 booklet panes. This example from the 40 pf germania, Mi # 145 sheet contains 42 stamps plus seven tabs with double red lines. The plate numbers for this sheet were H. 7592.20 and 3148.21

Double, "simple" tete-beche of the 40 pf stamp, Michel # 145 used in the first booklet pane MH14 issued in March of 1921. This combination includes a gutter from the center of the sheet with two vertical red lines.



This cover is franked with a simple tete-beche of the 40 pf stamp, Michel #145 and a double tete-beche combination of the 30 pf, Michel # 144.. This letter is cancelled Berlin n on October 12, 1922.

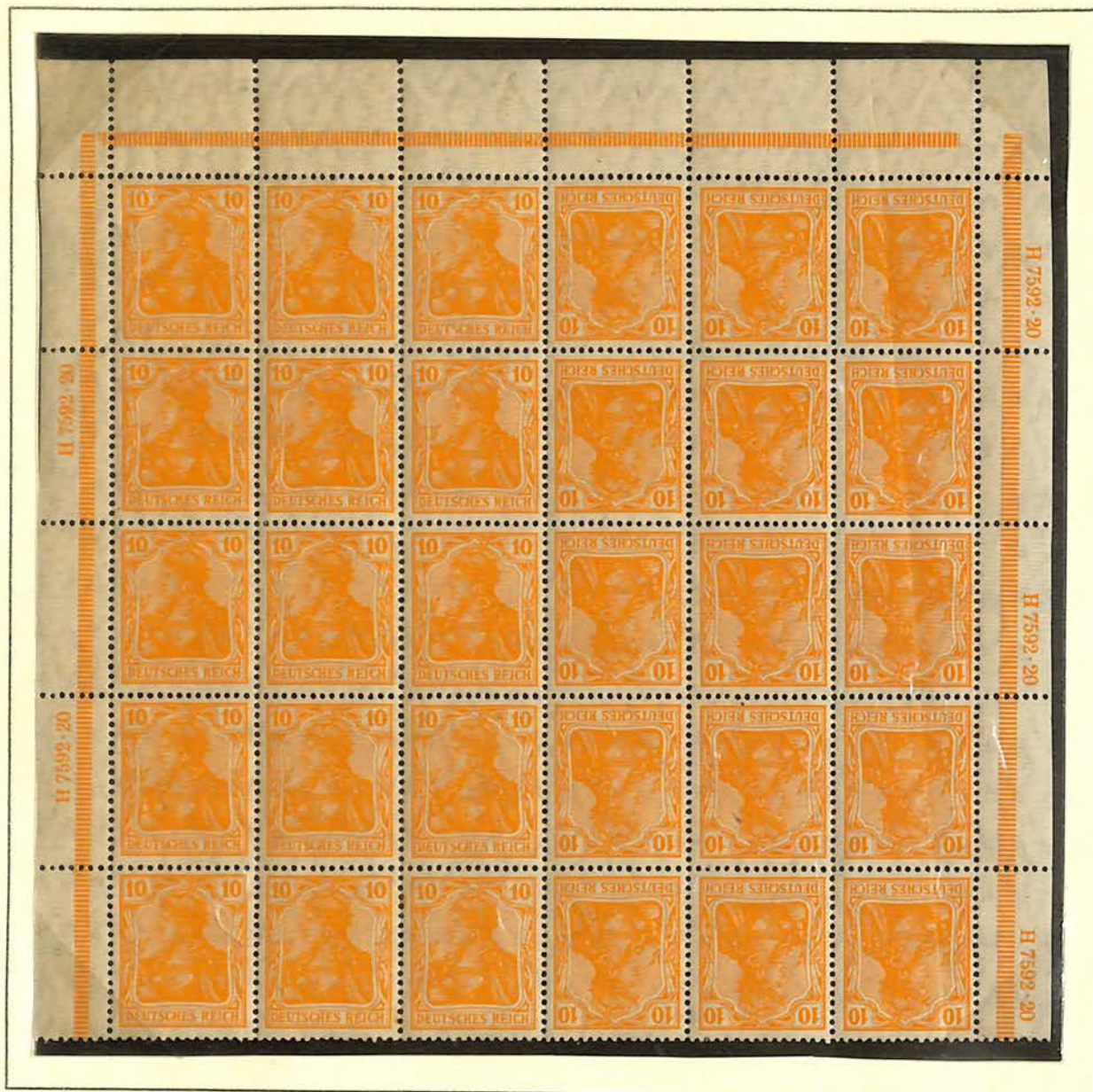

This cover is franked with combinations from Michel MHB 3 and MHB 4 issued in March of 1921. These are the 10 pfennig and 30 pfennig stamp combinations. This registered letter is cancelled Berlin Dahlem on March 10, 1921.

The panes for this booklet were cut from sheets of 180 stamps plus tabs. Each sheet was cut into 30 booklet panes. This example from the 10 pf germania, Mi # 141 sheet contains 30 stamps including five tete-beche pairs.. The plate number for this sheet was H. 7592.20. This sheet section could be broken into four booklet panes with plate numbers with one row "left over".

The panes for this booklet were cut from sheets of 180 stamps plus tabs. Each sheet was cut into 30 booklet panes. This example from the 10 pf germania, Mi # 141 sheet contains 18 stamps including three gutter pairs with plate number. The plate number for this sheet was H. 7592.20. To cut the booklet panes, the gutter would have been cut down the middle to create a selvage with one plate number for each pane.

The panes for this booklet were cut from sheets of 180 stamps plus tabs. Each sheet was cut into 30 booklet panes. This example from the 10 pf germania, Mi # 141 sheet contains 20 stamps including five tete-beche pairs.. The plate number for this sheet was H. 7592.20. This sheet portion is from the top left corner.

Booklet MH15 was issued in November of 1921. The booklet contains five different panes of germania and numeral stamps. The booklet sold for 12 Marks and included ten 40 pf germania stamps, ten of the 60 pf germania, five 10 pf numeral, and five 30 pf numeral stamps. Tissue paper interleaves separated the panes to prevent them from sticking together. Advertisements were printed on the interleaves.



This booklet pane contains six 40 pfennig stamps, Michel #145. The panes were cut from larger sheets often resulting in straight edges, such as at the bottom of this pane. This pane was also used in an earlier booklet, MH14 issued in March 1921

This booklet pane contains six 60 pfennig, Michel #147 stamps. Note the straight line along two sides of the pane from cutting the stamps out of the sheet.



This booklet pane contains four 60 pfennig, Michel #147 stamps and two 40 pfennig, Michel #145, stamps. Vertical and horizontal combinations of the two stamps are possible from this booklet.

This booklet pane contains four 30 pfennig, Michel #162 numeral stamps and two 40 pfennig, Michel #145 germania stamps. Vertical and horizontal combinations of the two stamps are possible from this booklet.



This booklet pane contains five 10 pfennig Michel #159 numeral stamps and one 30 pfennig Michel #162 numeral stamp. The selvedge of this pane includes the plate number H 3148.21. Vertical and horizontal combinations of the two stamps are possible from this booklet.

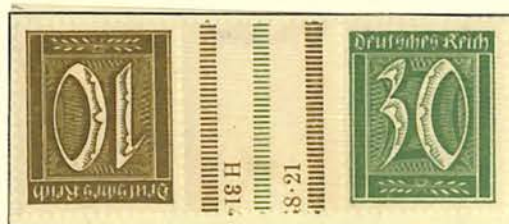

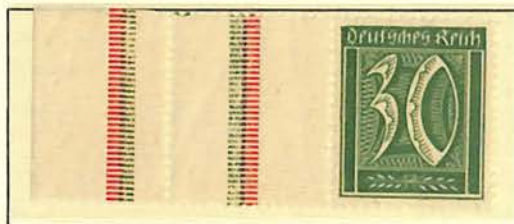

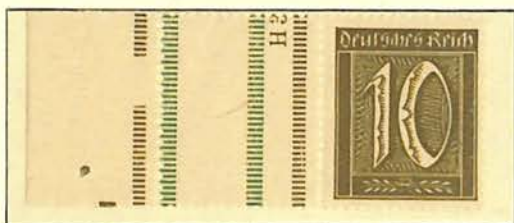

pairs, Michel #s K3 and K6.



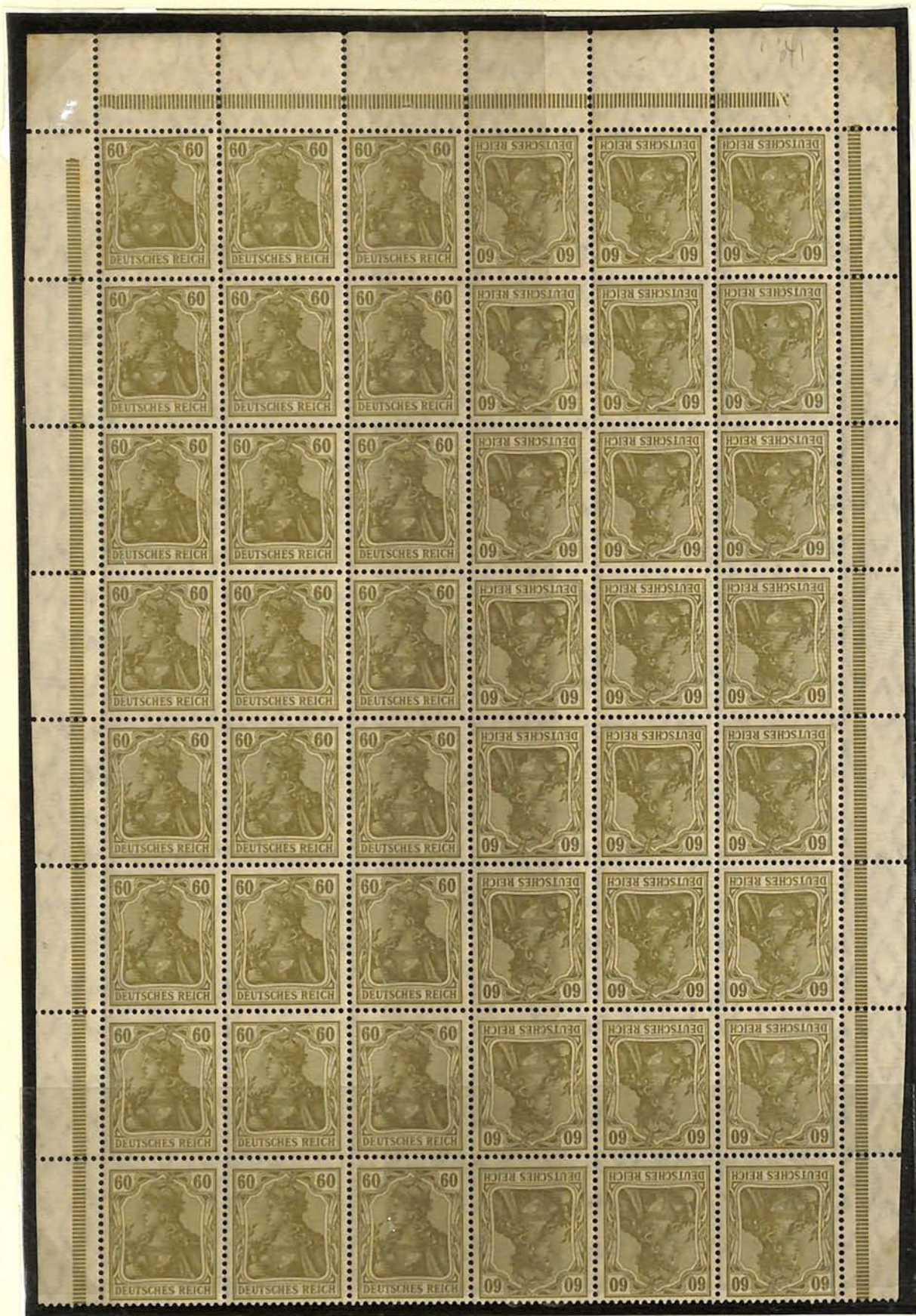

This airmail cover was mailed from Nuremberg to Tessin, Switzerland July 23, 1921. The stamps are cancelled with a special airmail cancel for the 27<sup>th</sup> German Stamp Collector's Day Philatelic Exhibition which was held from July 22-25, 1921 in Nuremberg. Postage includes a vertical combination pair, Michel # S27. The cover also has a Cinderella label for the exhibition.

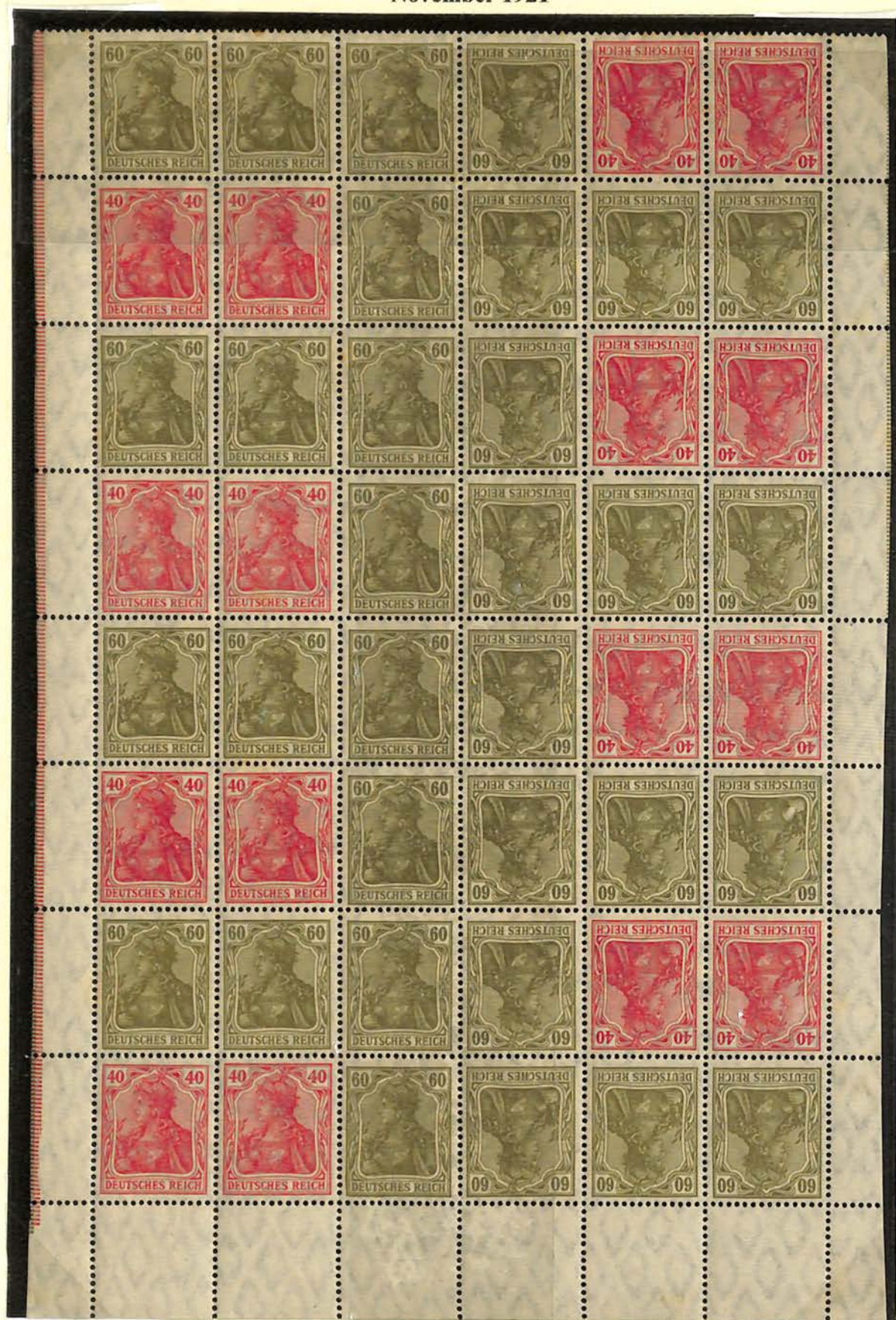

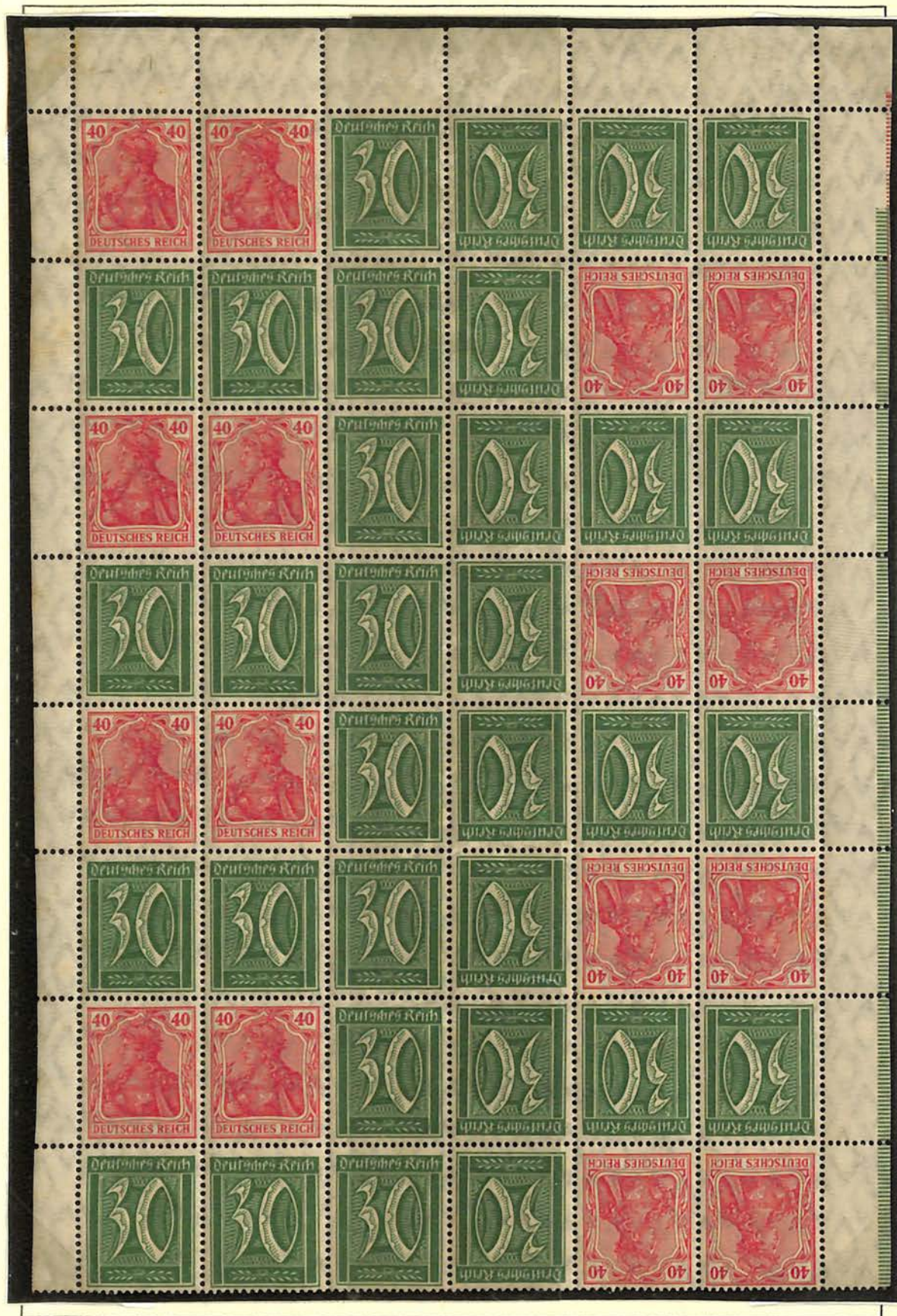

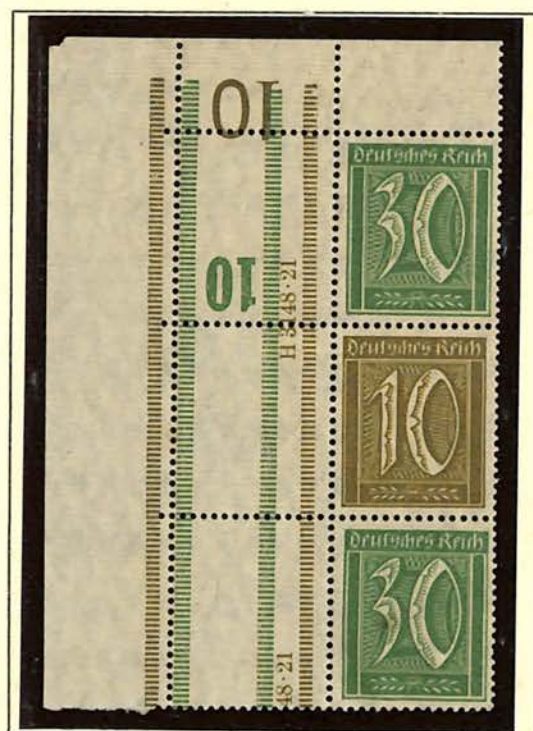
