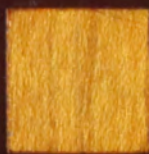

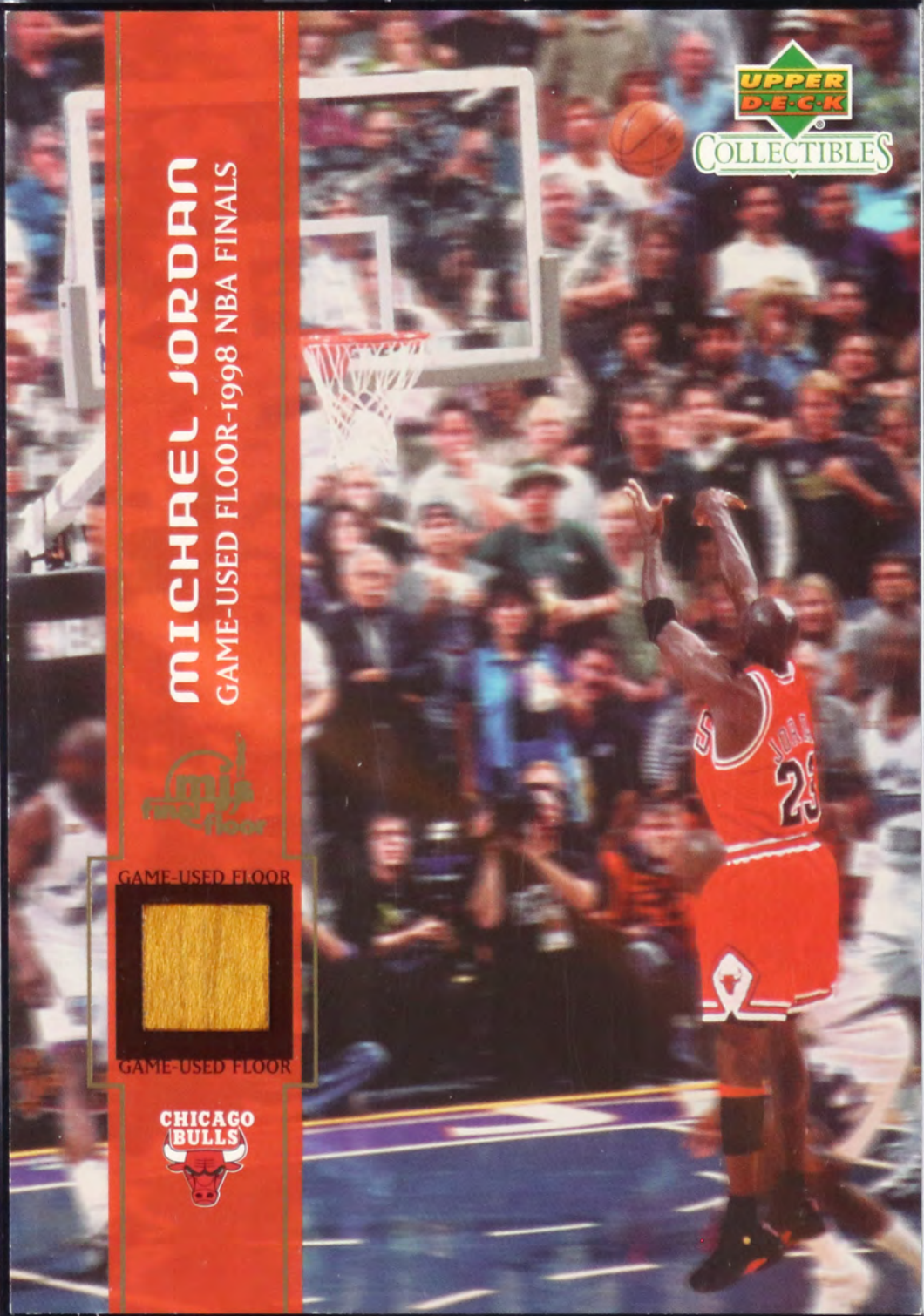

MICHAEL JORDAN SIXTH NBA CHAMPIONSHIP CARD

Led by the amazing Michael Jordan, the Chicago Bulls won their sixth NBA title in eight years with an 87-86 victory over the Utah Jazz in Game Six of the 1998 NBA Finals. The last NBA game for the incomparable Jordan, Michael rose to the occasion in the 4th quarter to seal the victory and solidify his place as one of the game's all-time greatest players.

Trailing the Jazz by 5 points after three quarters, Jordan scored 16 points in the 4th quarter, including the final 8 for the Bulls to finish with a game-high 45. In the final 41 seconds alone, Jordan slashed to the basket to cut the deficit to one point, stole the ball from Utah's Karl Malone and hit the game-winning jumper with 5.2 seconds to play. "Once it went in, I knew it was the game-winning basket," Jordan said. "All we had to do was play defense for 5.2 seconds, and I knew we could do that." It was a fitting ending for Jordan, who retired after the season at the top of his game.

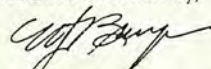

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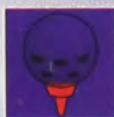
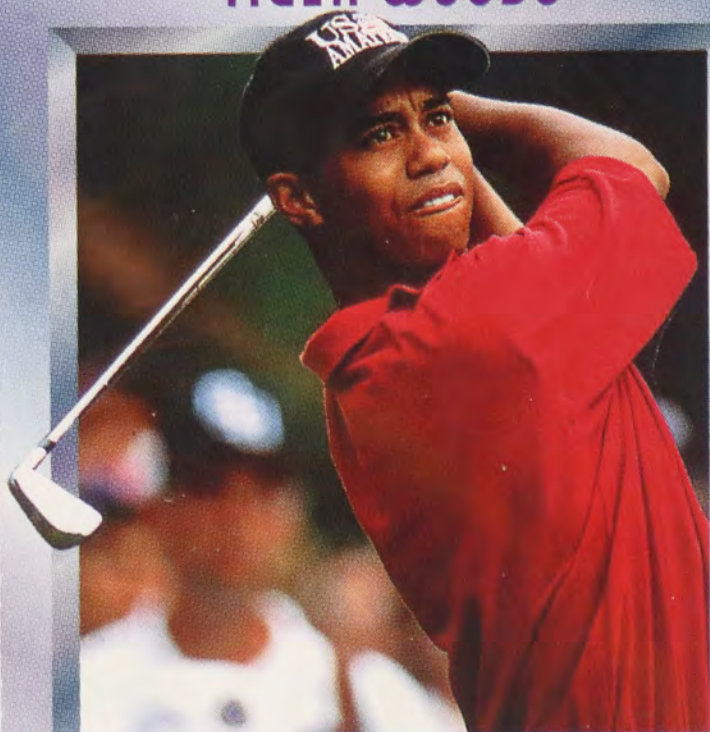
