




SECRETARY OF STATE-1953-59

JOHN FOSTER DULLES

He was born in Washington, D.C. on February 25, 1888. He showed his interest in international politics by serving as delegation secretary at The Hague Peace Conference in 1907. After World War I, in which he served as major, became assistant to the chairman of the War Trade Board (1918), attended Paris Peace Conference on Reparations and Financial Matters. In 1938 he made a study of the Far Eastern economic situation. He was the foreign policy expert of the Republican party. Mr. Dulles had served the Truman administration as foreign advisor, Thomas E. Dewey appointed him (1950) United States Senator from New York to fill the unexpired term of Senator Robert F. Wagner but Mr. Dulles lost his seat in a special election to Herbert Lehman. In 1952, following the election of Dwight D. Eisenhower as president of the United States, Dulles was appointed Secretary of State. His "War or Peace," published in 1950, is a discussion of the cold war. He resigned on April 16, 1959, because of ill health. Mr. Dulles died within six weeks of cancer, May 24, 1959.
