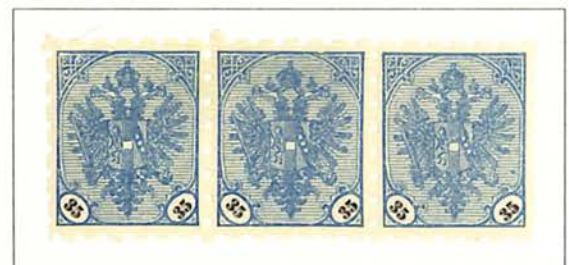

Right: Mostar to Vienna, 1906. Mixed issues pay **35 heller registration rate to Austria**. Franked with 20(H) red, perforated 12½, and previous 1900–01 issue. Postmarked "K. UND K. MILIT. POST-AMT, MOSTAR, 22/2/06" (February 22, 1906).
