THESE IMPERFORATE COIL STAMPS ARE OFTEN DIFFICULT OR IMPOSSIBLE TO DIFFERENTIATE FROM SHEET STAMPS BUT MANY HAVE BEEN AUTHENTICATED, ESPECIALLY AS PAIRS OR STRIPS AND SOME BEAR AUTHENTICATING MARKS OF CONTEMPORANEOUS EXPERTS. JOSEPH J. SCHERMACK (1876 – 1950) INVENTOR OF MAILING MACHINES, VENDING MACHINES AND OTHER DEVICES. HE FOUNDED THE SCHERMACK MAILING COMPANY IN 1906, LATER CALLED THE MAILOMETER COMPANY. HE WAS MOST ASSOCIATED WITH POSTAGE STAMP VENDING MACHINES AND PRIVATE STAMP PERFORATIONS MADE FOR USE IN HIS MACHINES.
