Right: *Mostar to Munich, Germany, 1908.* Franked with three copies of 10(H) and one copy of 5(H), perforated $12\frac{1}{2}$, making up a **35 heller registration rate to Germany**. Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST-AMT, MOSTAR, 27/5/08" (May 27, 1908).

UND K. MILIT. POST, MOSTAR, 5/5/09” (May 5, 1909).

Trebinje to Iglau (Moravia), 1911. Registered letter franked with seven copies of the 5(H), perforated $12\frac{1}{2}$, paying the 35 heller rate: 10 heller for letter weighing up to 20g + 25 heller for registration. Postmarked "K. UND K. MILIT. POST, TREBINJE, 27 VII. 11" (July 27, 1911).

Sarajevo to Leipzig, Germany, 1912. Registered, C.O.D. letter franked with 1(H) black (x6); 2(H) violet; 3(H) olive-yellow; and, 6(H) brown (x4); all perforated 12½. **Rate is 35 heller: 10 heller for letter to Germany plus 25 heller registration fee.** Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT POST, SARAJEVO 2, 24.I.12" (January 24, 1912).

B10c(5) • Letters: 45 Heller Registration Rate to Poland



Sarajevo to Polská Ostrava, 1906?. Franked with imperforate 45(H) dark brownish-red paying the **registration rate to Poland: 20 heller for letter weighing up to 20g + 25 heller registration fee**. Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST, SARAJEVO, 31 XII ... - 6" (December 31, 1906?).

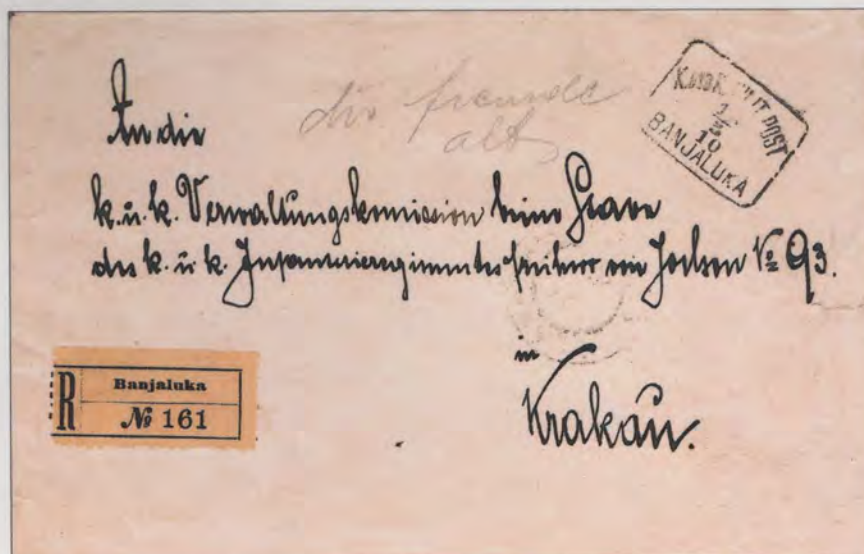

Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST, BANJALUKA, 13/3/10" (March 13, 1910).

B10c(5) • Letter: 45 Heller Registration Rate to Germany



Mostar to Leipzig, 1910. Franked with 40(H) orange, imperforate plus 2(H) and 3(H) making up the **45 heller registration rate to Germany: 15 heller letter rate + 5 heller for additional 20g + 25 heller registration fee**. Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST, MOSTAR, 8.VI.10..." (June 8, 1910).

Banjaluka to Constantinople, Turkey, 1907. Franked with imperforate 45(H) plus 1(H) and 2(H) pair, perforated 12½. Rate is 50 heller: 25 heller for single letter + 25 heller for registration. Canceled with rectangular "K. UND K. MILIT. POST/ BANJALUKA, 29/8/07" (August 29, 1907).

**B10c(6) • Foreign Registration
+ Multiple Letter Rate: 100 Heller**



Sarajevo to London, 1907. Multiple franking with 2(H), 6(H)x3, 20(H)x2 and 40(H) making up **100 heller registration rate to London, England: (25 heller registration and 75 heller triple letter rate.** All canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST / 04.VI.07" (June 4, 1907).

Registered Letter to China**



Zenica to Tientsin, China, 1909. One heller, 2(H), two copies of 3(H), 5(H), 6(H) and 20(H)—all perforated 12½—making up the **50 heller foreign letter registration rate to China**. Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST / ZENICA / 8.V.90" (May 8, 1909). Tientsin arrival, "24 5 09" (May 24, 1909).

B10c(6) • 50 Heller Single Frankings: Foreign Registration Rate



Top: Mostar to Pittsburg (Forwarded to Philadelphia), 1909. Franked with 50(H) purple-brown, perforated 12½. **Rate 50 heller: 25 heller for letter weighing up to 20g plus a 25 heller registration fee.** Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST / MOSTAR / 19/06/-09" (June 19, 1909).

Right: Mostar to Zürich, Switzerland, 1912. Franked with 50(H) purple-brown paying the **50 heller foreign registration rate.** Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST / MOSTAR / ??". Received Zurich, "-7.12.-12" (December 7, 1912).



**B10c(7) • Foreign Registration + Express Letter:
Emperor Franz Josef's Visit to Bosnia**



Sarajevo to Vienna, 1910. Franked with 30(H) green, imperforate with printer's dot in large bottom margin (position 48?), seven copies of 3(H) olive green, perforated 9¼, and two copies of 10(H) red. Canceled red(!) "K. UND K. MILIT. POST, SARAJEVO FILIALE, 2/6/10" (June 2, 1910).

Rate is 71 Heller: 10 heller single letter + 25 heller registration fee + 30 heller express letter fee (over-franked 6 heller).

B10c(7) • Registration + Express Letter



Kalinovik to Munich, Germany, 1912. Franked with one 30(H) green and one 35(H) blackish-green, all perforated $12\frac{1}{2}$. **Rate is 65 heller: 10 heller single letter + 25 heller registration fee + 30 heller express letter fee.** Canceled "K. UND K. MILIT. POST, KALINOVIK, 18/6/12" (June 18, 1912).
