TAFT, ALPHONSO, 1810-91, American jurist, father of WILLIAM HOWARD TAFT, was born in Townshend, Vt. Graduating from Yale College in 1829, he tutored there while preparing for the Connecticut bar, to which he was admitted in 1838. After building up a successful practice in Cincinnati and serving as Cincinnati superior court justice (1865-72), he was appointed secretary of war in the GRANT cabinet (1876). Three months later he became attorney general (1876-77), in which post he helped set up the Freedmen's Bureau, which helped to
