# NEW CALEDONIA

## NEWFOUNDLAND

Issued 1919

Known as the "Hawker" stamp. 200 copies of this stamp were made by J. A. Robinson, then postmaster of Newfoundland. 95 copies were used for postage, 18 defective copies were destroyed, one copy was given to King George V, one copy to the Governor of Newfoundland, six to the aviators, two to the Castle Museum, one to the Aviation Club, and 76 were sold for the benefit of the "Aid to Marines Society." These stamps were for the attempted crossing of the Atlantic by H. G. Hawker and K. M. Grieve seeking the £10,000 prize offered for the first successful flight. The aviators left Newfoundland May 18, 1919. When 1100 miles out a break-down of the motor dropped the machine into the sea. The fliers were rescued by a steamer and landed in Scotland. The plane and a mail bag were later salvaged and taken to Falmouth, England.

Issued June 9, 1919

Known as the "Alcock-Brown." Anticipating future attempts to fly across the Atlantic, the postmaster caused this stamp to be surcharged in quantity of 10,000. Captain John Alcock and Lieutenant A. Whitton Brown left St. Johns on June 14, 1919 and flew across the Atlantic in 16 hours and 20 minutes, landing at Clifden, Ireland.



Issued November, 1921

Intended for flights between Botwood, Newfoundland, and Halifax, Nova Scotia. Bad weather destroyed the postal aeroplane and the attempt was abandoned.



Issued May 23, 1927

For Commander Francesco De Pinedo, who attempted a flight from Newfoundland to Rome. Within a few hundred miles of land his plane developed engine trouble, and he was forced to descend on the ocean, was rescued and towed to the Azores, from there resuming his flight by easy stages, reaching Rome on June 1, 1927.


