URUGUAY

Issued in 1921, 1922

Stamp with blue surcharge intended for use on line operating between Montevideo-Rocha. Stamp was also used in 1923 for Montevideo-Buenos Aires line. Stamps with red and green surcharges intended for use on line operating between Montevideo and Mercedes. Stamps have since been used on Montevideo-Buenos Aires line

Issued January 2, 1924

Aerial line between Montevideo and Buenos Aires. Service suspended March 27, 1924

Watermarked Republic O. Del Uruguay



These stamps were used only on day of issue, August 25, 1925, the centenary of the Assembly of Florida, on letters carried by aeroplane between Montevideo and Florida, and vice versa



Issued September 24, 1925

Used for franking letters carried by plane from Montevideo to Rincon de las Gallinas. Letters were handed in at post offices and the stamps affixed by clerks. Unused copies are not known



URUGUAY

Issued March 3, 1926

Aerial line Montevideo-Buenos Aires. First flight took place March 1, but stamps were not issued until March 3. The 25c was issued exclusively for the Montevideo-Rocha inland line. It was used on the first flight between Montevideo and Buenos Aires on July 16, 1926
