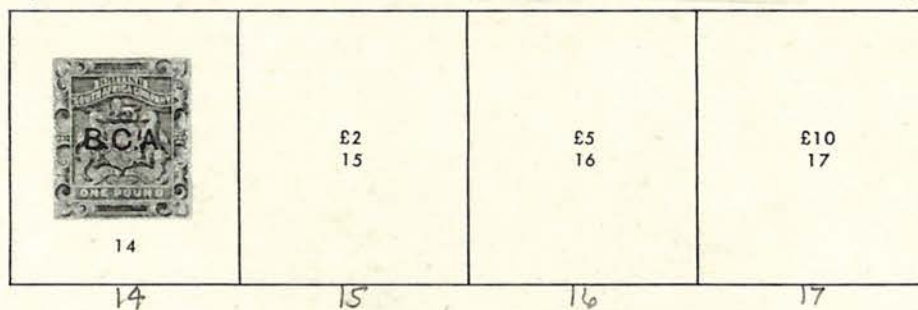
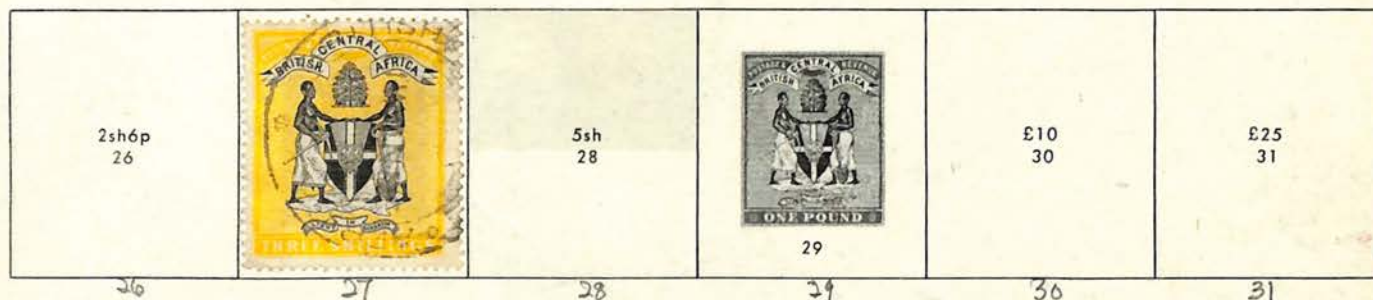


British Protectorate on the west shore of Lake Nyassa. Originally administered by the British South Africa Company, it became the Crown Colony of British Central Africa in 1894 and its name was altered to Nyasaland Protectorate in 1907. It joined the Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland in 1953. Area: 47,949 square miles: Population: 2,400,000 (approximate); Capital: Zomba. 12 Pence = 1 Shilling; 20 Shillings = 1 Pound.
